## LOS ANGELES CHARGERS at GREEN BAY PACKERS





### FALL TO PACKERS IN GREEN BAY

The Los Angeles Chargers fell to the Green Bay Packers, 23-20, in Week 11. WR Keenan Allen, S Derwin James Jr., and DL Sebastian Joseph-Day were the game captains for the Chargers. The Bolts won the toss and deferred to the second half.

WR Keenan Allen led the offense with 10 receptions for 116 yards (11.6 avg.) and a touchdown, his second-straight outing with over 100 receiving yards, 10 catches and a receiving score, and his fourth 100-yard performance of the season. TE Donald Parham Jr., added a single-game career-high 57 yards on four receptions (14.3 avg.), as **TE Stone Smartt** secured his first-career touchdown, a 51-yard receiving score in the second quarter.

QB Justin Herbert completed 21-of-36 passes for 260 yards and two touchdowns with zero interceptions, registering a 99.3 passer rating. The fourth-year pro collected his 36th career game with multiple passing scores, the second-most by any quarterback in their first four professional seasons in league annals to Hall of Fame QB Dan Marino). Herbert's 51-yard touchdown to Smartt was the ninth 50-plus-yard touchdown pass of his career, tying for the fourth-most in the NFL since 2020. Herbert also led offense on the ground with 73 yards on eight carries (9.1 avg.), with a long tote of 28 yards. Since entering the league in 2020, Herbert has thrown 113 touchdowns, the third-most by any passer in their first four seasons in league history.

Defensively, the Bolts recorded seven total tackles for loss, the team's second-most in a game this season. Three of those were sacks, including two from OLB Khalil Mack that brought him to over 10 sacks on the season. DL Sebastian Joseph-Day recorded a five-yard sack in the second quarter, bringing him to three on the season to tie a career high.

**CB Michael Davis** appeared in his 100th career game as a member of the Chargers, while WR Alex Erickson made his Chargers debut and also appeared in his 100th career game.

With his 116-yard performance, WR Keenan Allen surpassed 1,000 receiving yards in a season for the sixth time in his career, which is tied for the most by any player in the NFL since 2017. Allen's six 1,000-yard seasons rank second all-time in Chargers history, training only Hall of Fame WR Lance Alworth's seven career 1,000-yard seasons, and tie for the most in the NFL among all pass-catchers since the 2017 season.

Allen is just the third player this season to have multiple games with 10 catches, 100 receiving yards and one receiving touchdown (Adam Thielen and CeeDee Lamb). By hitting those marks, Allen registered his 18th career game of recording double digit receptions and hitting the century mark in yardage, tied for the third-most by any player in NFL history.

Allen's 116 receiving yards marked the 37th 100-plus-yard outing of his career, which ties Chiefs TE Travis Kelce for the fifth-most by any player in the NFL since entering the league in 2013.
