LOS ANGELES CHARGERS vs. LAS VEGAS RAIDERS



Sunday, Nov. 30, 2025 | 1:25 p.m. PT | Inglewood, Calif.

CHARGERS TOPPLE RAIDERS, 31-14

The Los Angeles Chargers moved to 4-0 in AFC West play on Sunday when they downed the Las Vegas Raiders, 31-13, at SoFi Stadium.

The Bolts' rushing attack led the charge on Sunday, recording 192 net yards —the second highest total of the season. The defense limited the Raiders to 12 first downs and allowed them to convert just two-of-eight third downs (25 pct.).

QB Justin Herbert completed 15-of-20 passes for 151 yards, two touchdowns and an interception for a passer rating of 108.5 along with three carries for eight yards (2.7 avg.). Herbert heads into Week 14 with 23,935 passing yards and moves passed Hall of Fame QB Dan Marino for the third most passing yards by a player through the first six seasons of a career.

RB Kimani Vidal recorded career highs in carries (25) and rushing yards (126) while scoring the longest rushing touchdown of his career (59 yards) and longest by a Chargers player since RB Austin Ekeler found paydirt on a 72-yard scamper in 2022.

WR Quentin Johnston totaled three receptions for 23 yards (7.7 avg) including a 20-yard touchdown grab from Herbert to open scoring in the first quarter. **WR Ladd McConkey** totaled four receptions for 39 yards (9.8 avg.) with a seven-yard touchdown reception in the third quarter.

WR Keenan Allen wrapped up the day with four receptions for 30 yards (7.5 avg.) with all four of his receptions coming on third down.

OLB Tuli Tuipulotu ended the game with six tackles, a pair of sacks, four tackles for loss, a pair of QB hits and a pass defended. The third-year outside linebacker moves to 10.0 sacks on the season, a single season career high. **OLB Bud Dupree** recorded a pair of solo tackles, a sack, a tackle for loss and a QB hit while **OLB Khalil Mack**, **S Derwin James Jr.**, **LB Daiyan Henley** and **DL Da'Shawn Hand** each added a half sack.

S Tony Jefferson recorded an interception off a tip from **CB Donte Jackson**, his third of the season.

REMEMBER REMEMBER TULI IN NOVEMBER

OLB Tuli Tuipulotu ended the game with six tackles, a pair of sacks, four tackles for loss, a pair of QB hits and a pass defended. The third-year outside linebacker moves to 10.0 sacks on the season, a single season career high and becomes the 12th Chargers player to record a 10-sack season since sacks became an official statistic in 1982.

With his performance today, he becomes one of just six players to record at least four tackles for loss, multiple sacks and a pass defended in a single game since Tuipulotu entered the NFL in 2023.

VIDAL REACHES CENTURY MARK ... AGAIN

RB Kimani Vidal recorded career highs in carries (25) and rushing yards (126) while scoring the longest rushing touchdown of his career (59 yards) and longest by a Chargers player since RB Austin Ekeler found paydirt on a 72-yard scamper in 2022.

Sunday marked the third 100-yard rushing game of Vidal's career, joining RB Melvin Gordon as the only Bolts players to record at least three 100-yard rushing games in a single season since 2015.

BIG GUYS STAND GROUND

The defense held firm on third down, recording a sack on four of the Raiders eight third down attempts.

The Bolts' four third down sacks are tied for the most in a single game in the NFL this season and were the most by a Bolts defense since Nov. 6, 2024 at the New York Jets when they recorded six sacks on third down.

The Chargers have recorded 16 sacks on third down in 2025, tied for the third highest of such in the NFL this season.
