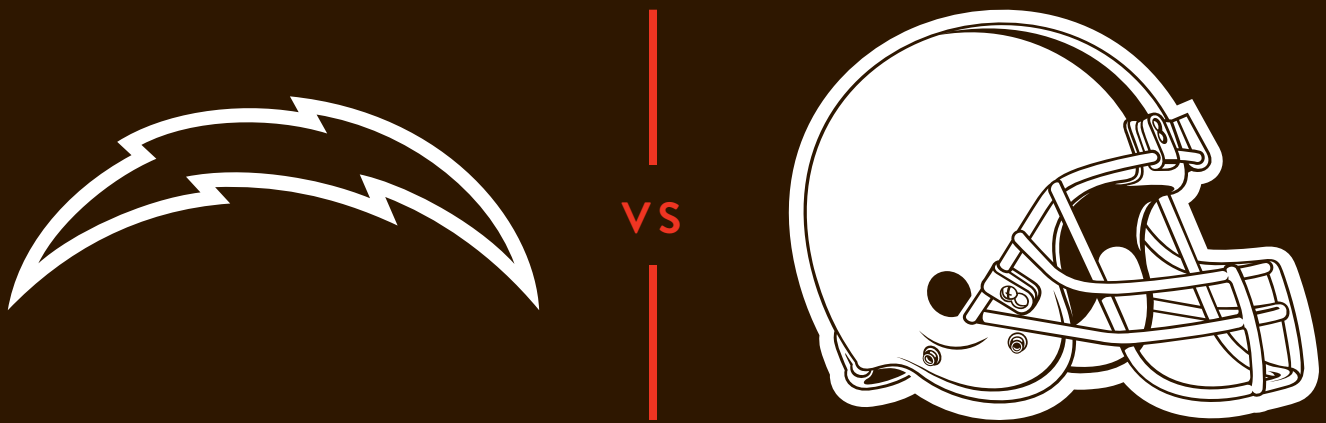

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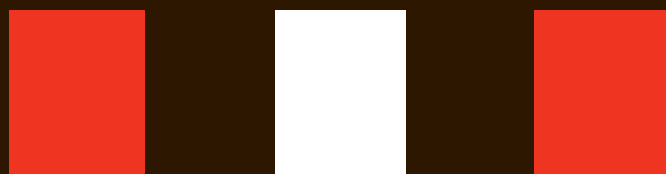

## NOTABLE STORYLINES

• Last week, the Browns topped the Baltimore Ravens, 29-24, at Huntington Bank Field. The Browns totaled a season-high 401 net yards on offense, while limiting the Ravens to 2-for-10 on third down attempts. Trailing 24-23 with 2:36 remaining, QB Jameis Winston engineered a 9-play, 69-yard drive that culminated with a 38-yard touchdown pass to WR Cedric Tillman with 1:04 remaining. On the game-winning drive, Winston completed 6 of 9 passes for 74 yards with a touchdown.

• Making his first start since Sept. 25, 2022, QB Jameis Winston threw for 334 yards, three touchdowns and a 115.3 rating. It marked his 29th career 300-yard passing game and his first game with at least three touchdown passes since totaling five on Sept. 12, 2021. Among the 39 quarterbacks who have started for the Browns since the team's return in 1999, Winston's 334 passing yards were the most in a player's first start with the team.

• WR Cedric Tillman recorded seven receptions for 99 yards and two touchdowns. The touchdowns were the first of his career. Among all NFL wide receivers the past two weeks, Tillman ranks tied for first in touchdown catches (two), tied for second in receptions (15), sixth in receiving yards (180) and tied for fifth in first downs (eight).

• Appearing in his 100th career regular season game, TE David Njoku recorded five receptions for 61 yards and a touchdown. He passed WR Reggie Rucker for the sixth-most receptions in Browns history. Njoku (312) now trails WR Kevin Johnson (315), WR Brian Brennan (315) and RB Greg Pruitt (323) on the list.

• RB Nick Chubb, who made his 2024 season debut two weeks ago, rushed for 52 yards against the Ravens. He passed Mike Pruitt for the third-most rushing yards in franchise history.

• DE Za'Darius Smith recorded his team-leading fifth sack of the season last week. He has at least one sack in every home game this season and has 65 career sacks.

• DE Myles Garrett has recorded four sacks and two forced fumbles this season. Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 14 sacks in each of the past three seasons (2021-23) and the only player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past six seasons (2018-23). Garrett is the Browns all-time sack leader with 92.5.

• LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah is leading the Browns with 60 tackles, while adding three sacks, one interception, three passes defended and one forced fumble. He is tied for second in the league with 10 tackles for a loss this season. Owusu-Koramoah inked a three-year extension with the club in August.

• CB Denzel Ward is leading the NFL with 12 passes defended this season. He is the only NFL player to record at least 10 passes defended in each of the past seven seasons (2018-24). Since entering the league as a first-round pick in 2018, Ward is second in the NFL with 88 passes defended, trailing only James Bradberry's 92.

• S Rodney McLeod has scored two touchdowns this season. He returned a blocked field goal 50-yards for a touchdown at Philadelphia (10/13). It was the Browns first blocked field goal returned for a touchdown since Leigh Bodden on Nov. 13, 2005. He also returned a fumble 25-yards for a score at Las Vegas (9/29). McLeod and Minnesota LB Andrew Van Ginkel are the only defensive players this season to score two touchdowns.

• P Corey Bojorquez is leading the NFL with 10 punts inside the 10-yard line and is tied for first in the league with 20 inside the 20-yard line. His 51.9 punt average ranks third in the league.

• K Dustin Hopkins is 13-for-16 on field goal attempts this season, including four from 50-plus yards. Since joining the Browns via trade prior to the start of last season, his 12 field goals from 50-plus yards are the second-most all-time by a Brown. He inked a three-year contract extension in July.

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

#### TEAM

- The team looks for their first back-to-back wins at home since winning three consecutive last season (Weeks 11, 14 and 17).
- The team looks for their first back-to-back wins against the AFC since Weeks 16 and 17 of last season.
- The team can improve to 26-13 (.667) at home under Kevin Stefanski.

#### RB NICK CHUBB

- One rushing score shy of 50 for his career.

#### TE DAVID NJOKU

- Three catches from tying Kevin Johnson and Brian Brennan (315) for the fourth most by a Brown. Those three receptions also tie Kevin Johnson for the most by a Brown since the team returned to Cleveland in 1999.
- Aims for fourth consecutive game with five-or-more catches.
- Aims for ninth home game in a row with four-or-more catches.

#### QB JAMEIS WINSTON

- Winston looks for consecutive 300-yard passing games for the first time since 2019, when he accomplished the feat in three straight games (Weeks 14-16).

#### DE ZA'DARIUS SMITH

- Looks to continue stretch of recording a sack in every home game this season.

## IN LOVING MEMORY OF JIM DONOVAN



1956-2024

On Saturday, Oct. 26, Jim Donovan, "The Voice of the Cleveland Browns," passed away at the age of 68 after battling chronic lymphocytic leukemia. Donovan served as the radio voice of the Browns for 25 seasons, starting with the team's return in 1999.

"He touched the lives of our fans each and every Sunday with his love for the Browns and his brilliance at his craft," said Dee and Jimmy Haslam. "He will be greatly missed, but he cemented a legacy that will live on forever."

Over the course of his storied career, Donovan had signature calls that highlighted his career and are permanently etched in Browns lore. Donovan was inducted into the 2024 Class of Browns Legends on Sept. 22.

## BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with “Browns Give Back” that extends throughout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, COO David Jenkins, EVP/GM Andrew Berry and Head Coach Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: **EDUCATION, YOUTH FOOTBALL** and **SOCIAL JUSTICE**.

### PLAY LIKE A GIRL!

Bridgestone, the Cleveland Browns and nonprofit organization Play Like a Girl!® welcomed local high school girls flag football teams for a Field Day.

High school players ran flag football drills with Browns QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson and took part in a panel discussion featuring female leaders from the three organizers. Since 2021, the Browns have worked with Northeast Ohio Flag Football to elevate girls flag football to promote equality in high school sports. Over the past four seasons, the number of Northeast Ohio high schools with teams has grown from two to 51. The Browns are focused on pushing girls high school flag football to become a sanctioned varsity sport under the Ohio High School Athletic Association.



### HALLOWEEN FASHION SHOW

The Cleveland Browns hosted the annual Halloween Fashion Show to benefit kids served by The Littlest Heroes and University Hospitals Rainbow Babies & Children's, in celebration of Crucial Catch. Browns players paired up with a child battling cancer to walk down the runway in their spookiest Halloween costumes.



The Stay in the Game! Attendance Network works to campaign, connect and convene with experts and supporters to dramatically improve attendance for Ohio students. The Network was launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, and is now managed by Battelle. For the 2024-25 school year, the Network has partnered with **100+ school districts** to positively impact the lives of **400k+ students**.

### MEIJER GYM CLASS TAKEOVER

On Tuesday, October 15, the Cleveland Browns and RB Pierre Strong Jr. hosted a Gym Class Takeover presented by Meijer at Stephanie Tubbs Jones School as a celebration for students having a strong commitment to school attendance.

Meijer, the presenting partner for the Gym Class Takeover, donated \$2,500 to the Cleveland Metropolitan School District, a SITG! Attendance Network school district.



## THE HEAD COACHES

### BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win season becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania.

### CHARGERS HEAD COACH JIM HARBAUGH



Jim Harbaugh was appointed the 19th head coach of the Chargers franchise on Jan. 24, 2024. He began his NFL coaching career with the Raiders serving as a QBs coach from 2002-03. Harbaugh spent time as part of the 49ers organization from 2011-14 (HC). During his tenure with San Francisco, Harbaugh led them three playoff berths in four seasons including a Super Bowl XLVII appearance in 2012. Harbaugh also has experience coaching at the collegiate level. He started as an Offensive Consultant at Western Kentucky from 1994-2001, San Diego from 2004-06 (HC) and more recently the University of Michigan from 2015-23 (HC). At Michigan, Harbaugh led the team to three consecutive Big Ten Conference titles, including berths in the College Football Playoffs in 2021-22, eventually winning the national championship in 2023. Harbaugh played football for the University of Michigan as well from 1983-87 and led Michigan to the 1987 Rose Bowl while coming in third as a finalist for the Heisman Trophy. He was drafted in the first round (26) of the 1987 NFL Draft to the Chicago Bears. He spent time as a Quarterback with the Bears (1987-93), Colts (1994-97), Ravens (1998), Chargers (1999-2000), Lions (2001) and Panthers (2001).

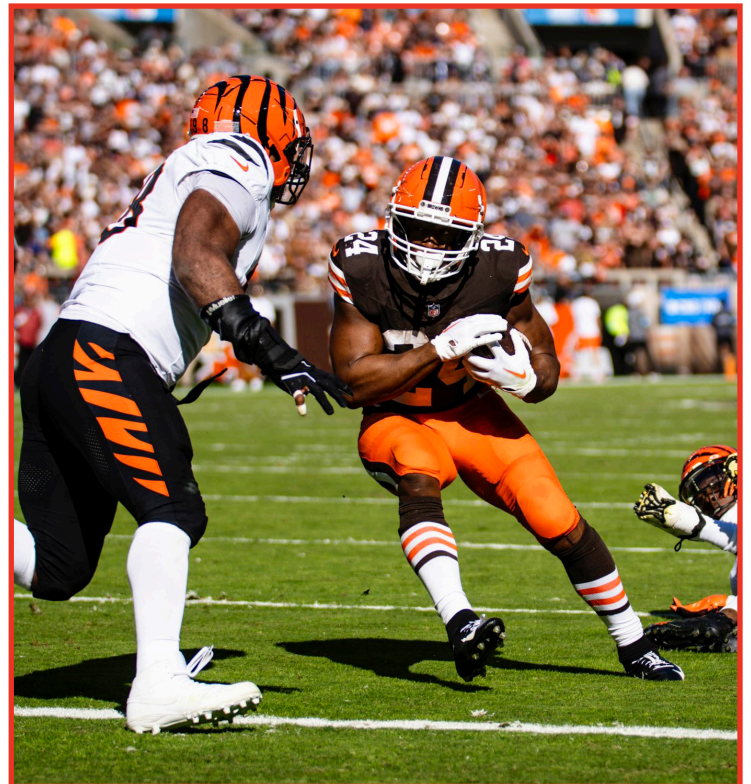

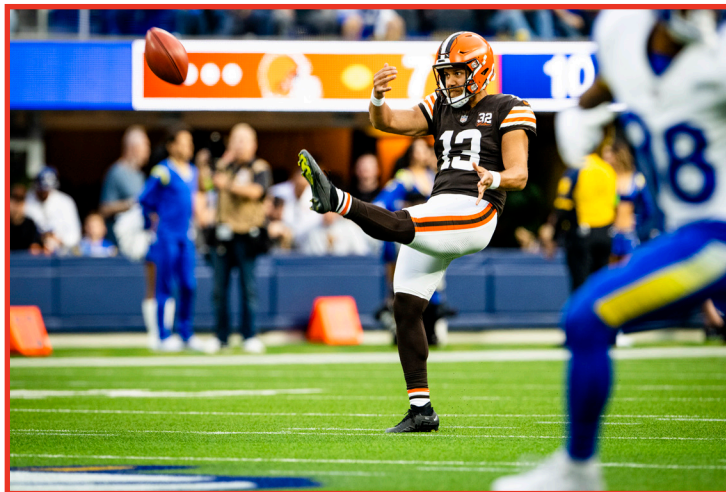

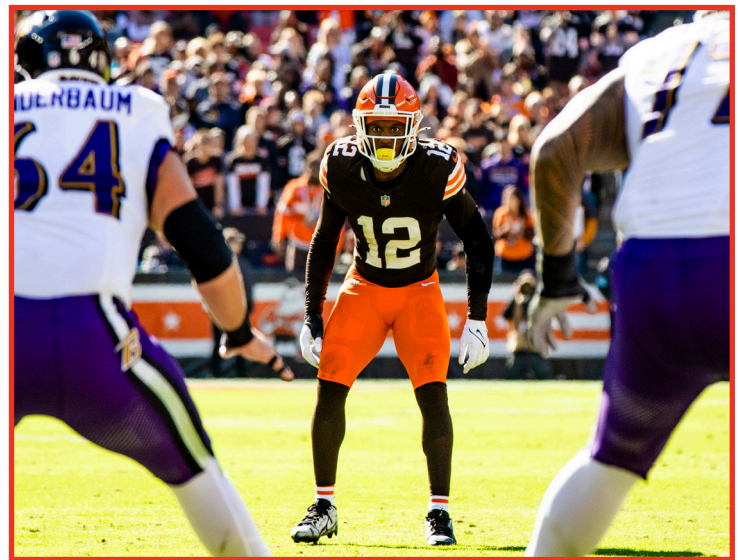

# HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 77-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in all four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are third in the NFL with an average of 139.6 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 24-12 (.666) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

## **BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR**

Ventrone brings 19 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



## **JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR**

Schwartz is in his 16th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



## **KEN DORSEY | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR**

After playing quarterback for the Browns from 2006-08, Dorsey rejoined the Browns with 17 years of NFL coaching and playing experience. Prior to joining the Browns, Dorsey spent five seasons with the Bills in several capacities on offense, coaching QB Josh Allen to several NFL records including becoming the first QB in NFL history with at least 4,000 passing yards, 30 passing touchdowns and eight rushing touchdowns. As the quarterbacks coach for the Carolina Panthers from 2013-17, Dorsey aided QB Cam Newton to be named 2015 NFL MVP. As a player, Dorsey was selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the seventh round of the 2003 NFL Draft after leading Miami (Fla.) to a 38-2 record and a national championship in 2001. He spent the 2003-05 seasons in San Francisco and 2006-08 with the Browns, where he started 13 games.



## **CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS**

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 21st NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2019-18 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
