FORCING THE ISSUE

With a strip-sack of Broncos QB Drew Lock in the first quarter, **OLB Joey Bosa** registered his fourth strip-sack of the season. Entering the Sunday night game, Bosa's four strip-sacks lead the NFL in 2021.

HERBERT THROWS FOR 300

QB Justin Herbert completed 28 passes on 44 attempts (63.6 pct.) for 303 yards and two touchdowns with two interceptions (80.0 rating). It marked his 14th career 300-yard performance and put Herbert over 7,500 career passing yards in 26 career games, the second-fastest to do so in history.

He added 36 rushing yards on four attempts (9.0 avg.), giving him 243 rushing yards on the season to set the franchise single-season record among quarterbacks.

ALLEN REACHES 700

With a pair of catches on the team's third drive of the game, **WR Keenan Allen** reached 700 career catches, tying Antonio Brown as the fastest to do so in NFL history (111 games).

EKELER CATCHES HIS SEVENTH SCORE

RB Austin Ekeler caught a 12-yard touchdown in the second quarter, giving him seven receiving scores on the year. He now has seven touchdown runs and seven touchdown grabs on the season, marking the fifth time in NFL history a player has done so through their team's first 11 games of a season.

Ekeler ended the game with 99 yards from scrimmage (31 rushing, 68 receiving), putting him over 1,000 on the season and over 5,000 for his career. Ekeler is the third undrafted player in the common draft era (since 1967) to eclipse 5,000 scrimmage yards within the first five seasons of a career, joining Arian Foster and Willie Parker.
