# **BOLTS OFFENSE LIGHTS IT UP IN WIN**

The Los Angeles Chargers won their third-straight game on Sunday, defeating the Cleveland Browns, 47-42. The Bolts posted nearly 500 yards of offense, while Mike Williams set a single-game career high with 165 yards and two touchdowns on eight catches (20.6 avg.). Williams hauled in 72-yard and 42-yard scores, becoming the first player this season with two touchdown grabs of 40-plus vards in the same game. Los Angeles and Cleveland combined for 41 points scored in the fourth guarter, the most points in a single guarter between two teams in Chargers history.

## CLUTCH IN CRUNCH-1

Justin Herbert threw for a career-best 398 vards and four touchdowns on 26-of-43 passing (60.5 pct.) for a 122.0 passer rating in the victory. He added a rushing score in the third quarter to total five touchdowns on the day. One of Herbert's touchdown passes was on third down, giving him an NFL-best 18 passing scores on third down since entering the NFL in 2020.

The 398 yards marked the 11th 300-yard performance of Herbert's career, good for the most by any player in NFL history in their first two seasons of a career. The game was also the third of Herbert's career with three passing touchdowns and a rushing score in the same game, tying for the second-most performances over the last two seasons.

Herbert orchestrated his third come-from-behind win this season and the fourth of his career. He led the team to four-straight touchdown drives to close out the game, with the exception of a kneel-down as the game's final play. # EKELER CONTINUES TO EXCEL

**Austin Ekeler** totaled 119 yards from scrimmage (66 rushing, 53 receiving on the day, finding the end zone on the ground twice and through the air once. He extended his streak of games with 100-plus scrimmage yards to four consecutive, tying Titans RB Derrick Henry for the longest active streak in football.

The receiving score gave Ekeler 19 for his career, tying for the second-most in the common draft era (since 1967) by any running back through the first five seasons of a career. He's now just one touchdown catch shy of becoming the youngest running back to reach 20 career touchdown grabs over that span.
