LOS ANGELES CHARGERS vs TENNESSEE TITANS

CHARGERS DOWN TITANS, 27-17

The Los Angeles Chargers defeated the Tennessee Titans, 27-17, at SoFi Stadium on Sunday.

QB Justin Herbert completed 14-of-18 passes for 164 yards and one touchdown for a 123.1 passer rating while adding 32 yards and one touchdown on nine carries (3.6 avg.). Herbert has completed 1,772 career passes is now the NFL's leader in pass completions in a player's first five seasons. Sunday's outing for Herbert also marked his 11th career game with both a passing and rushing touchdown.

RB Gus Edwards led the Bolts on the ground, totaling 55 yards on 10 carries (5.5 avg.) while **RB J.K. Dobbins** added 50 yards on 15 carries (3.3 avg.).

WR Ladd McConkey tallied 52 receiving yards on two receptions (26.0 avg). **WR Quentin Johnston** added two receptions for 24 yards (12.0 avg.) and one touchdown. **TE Will Dissly** led the Bolts in receptions with five for 30 yards (6.0 avg.).

Defensively, the Chargers totaled 7.0 sacks and limited the Titans to a 33.3 third down percentage. The Bolts 7.0 sacks are the most in a single game since Week 9 of the 2023 season and marks just the 11th time since 2000 the defense has sacked the quarterback seven times in a single game.

LB Dayian Henley led the Chargers with 13 tackles (10 solo), 1.0 sack, 1.0 tackle for loss, one quarterback hit and one special teams tackle. He is the first Chargers player to compile 10 tackles, a sack and a special teams tackle in a single game since at least 2000.

OLB Tuli Tuipulotu recorded his second-career multi-sack game, totaling 2.0 along with five tackles (three solo), 2.0 tackles for loss and three quarterback hits. **OLB Bud Dupree** also added 2.0 sacks. while **OLB Joey Bosa** added 1.0 sack. Bosa moves to second in Chargers history with 70.0 career sacks. **DL Poona Ford** also recorded 1.0 sack.

THE MOST THROUGH FIVE

With his second completion in the first quarter, **QB Justin Herbert** passed QB Derek Carr (1,759) and set the record for the most completions (1,760) by a player through their first five pro seasons. He connected with **TE Will Dissly** for 14 yards and a first down. Herbert concluded the game completing 14-of-18 passes for 164 yards and one touchdown for a 123.1 passer rating.

Herbert now ranks fourth in passing yards in a player's first five seasons with 19,112, passing Indianapolis QB Andrew Luck (19,078).

Sunday marked the Oregon product's 11th career game with at least one passing and rushing touchdown. He passed QB Jack Kemp (10) for the second-most of such games in Chargers history.

HENLEY FILLS STAT SHEET

LB Daiyan Henley wrapped up the game with 13 tackles (10 solo), 1.0 sack, 1.0 tackle for loss, one quarterback hit and one special teams tackle. It is the first time since Nov. 20, 2022 that a player has recorded at least 10 tackles, a sack and a special teams tackle in a single game and it is just the seventh occurrence since 2020. Henley becomes the first Charger to accomplish the feat since 2020.

OLB Tuli Tuipulotu concluded Sunday's contest with five tackles (three solo), 2.0 sacks, 2.0 tackles for loss and three quarterback hits. It marks the first time in his career that he has recorded multiple sacks in consecutive games and is the first Charger to do so since **OLB Khalil Mack** recorded three-consecutive multi-sack games last seasons from Weeks 11-13.

The second-year player joins Kyle Van Noy, Dante Fowler Jr. Trey Hendrickson, Patrick Jones II and Will McDonald IV as the only players to record multiple sacks in consecutive games this season.
