## LOS ANGELES CHARGERS at PHILADELPHIA EAGLES

### CHARGERS WIN IN PHILADELPHIA

The Los Angeles Chargers defeated the Eagles in the City of Brotherly Love on Sunday, 27-24, to become the top-ranked team in the AFC West. The team won both road games against NFC opponents in a season for the first time since 2017.

Los Angeles converted its fourth two-point conversion of the season, the most by an AFC squad this year and the second-most by a Chargers team in a single season (six in 2018).

The Chargers' offense did not allow a sack for the first time since 2019 and totaled 445 net yards, good for the most on the road this season. **WR Keenan Allen** had 12 catches for 104 receiving yards to register his 30th career 100-yard performance.

On defense, **DL Linval Joseph** tied for the team lead with a season-high nine tackles. Meanwhile, **OLB Joey Bosa** reached 4.5 sacks for the season after posting a seven-yard drop on Sunday.

### HERBERT LEADS THE COMEBACK

**QB Justin Herbert** put forth one of the more impressive performances of his career, completing 32 passes of 38 attempts (84.1 pct.) for 356 yards and two passing touchdowns for a 123.2 passer rating, while also adding a rushing score. The 84.1 completion percentage marked a single-game career high, as the signal-caller logged two stretches of 11 or more consecutive completions on the day.

The second-year passer became the only player in NFL history to eclipse 600 completions within the first 25 starts of a career, doing so in his 23rd start.

Sunday marked Herbert's fifth career fourth-quarter comeback win and his sixth game with multiple passing scores and a rushing touchdown, tying Kyler Murray and Cam Newton for the most through a player's first two seasons in NFL history.
