### LOS ANGELES CHARGERS vs. LAS VEGAS RAIDERS





#### RAIDERS AT SOFI STADIIN

The Los Angeles Chargers defeated the Las Vegas Raiders, 24-17, on Sunday to move to 2-2 on the season. WR Keenan Allen and DL **Sebastian Joseph-Day** were the game captains for the Chargers. The Bolts lost the toss and received the opening kickoff.

The Chargers offense totaled 155 rushing yards on the day, the second-most of the season and the fourth game above 150 rushing yards over the last two years. The team recorded 95 of those rushing yards in the first quarter, the most by a Bolts offense in a first quarter since posting 102 at New England in 2017.

QB Justin Herbert threw for a touchdown and ran for two more, marking his 10th career game with at least one passing touchdown and one rushing touchdown. He is the fifth player ever to top 100 passing scores and 10 rushing scores within his first four pro seasons. WR Derius Davis had a 51-yard carry on the opening drive, the second-longest run by any non-running back in Chargers history.

Defensively, the Bolts held the Raiders to just one third-down conversion on 11 attempts (9.1 pct.). Entering Sunday Night Football, Los Angeles' 15 third-down conversions allowed in 2023 is tied for the sixth-fewest in the NFL. The Chargers are one of six teams this season to allow four or fewer third-down conversions in three or more games.

The defense was led by the historic performance of **OLB Khalil** Mack, who set a single-game career high and franchise record with six sacks. It's the first performance of at least six sacks since 2017 and just the sixth time a player has totaled six or more sacks in a single game since the stat began being tracked in 1982.

Mack is the second player in NFL history to record multiple games of five-plus sacks in his career (Hall of Fame LB Derrick Thomas). He is also first NFL player since 2021 and first AFC defender since 2019 to post 10 tackles and four quarterback hits in a single game.

**OLB Khalil Mack** turned in a historic performance, leading all players with 10 tackles (eight solo), five tackles for loss, four quarterback hits and a pass breakup. He set a career high with a single-game franchise-record six sacks, including a pair of strip-sacks.

The performance by Mack was the sixth by any player of six-plus sacks since the stat began being tracked in 1982, and the most since Adrian Clayborn in 2017. Mack is the only player since at least 2000 to have six sacks and at least 10 tackles in a single game.

Sunday marked Mack's second career game with at least five sacks, joining Hall of Famer Derrick Thomas as the only players to do so since the stat began being tracked in 1982.

Mack now has 21 career strip-sacks, the second-most since he entered the NFL in 2014. His two strip-sacks on Sunday tied a team record.

### HERBERT RESPONSIBLE FOR THREE SCORES

**QB** Justin Herbert threw a touchdown and added two on the ground, marking his 10th career game with at least one touchdown passing and one rushing.

He now has 101 career passing scores and 11 rushing touchdowns, becoming the fifth player in NFL history with at least 100 passing scores and 10 touchdown runs within the first four seasons of a career.

The pair of rushing touchdowns made Herbert the first Chargers quarterback with multiple rushing scores in the same game since Hall of Famer Doug Flutie in 2003.

#### DAVIS POSTS A 51-YARD CARRY

On the game's opening drive, **WR Derius Davis** took a handoff 51 yards. It was the second-longest carry for the Bolts this season and the longest by any non-running back for the Chargers since 2001, when WR Curtis Conway ran 67 yards for a touchdown.
