LOS ANGELES CHARGERS vs. MIAMI DOLPHINS

The Los Angeles Chargers lost to the Miami Dolphins, 36-34, in Week 1. WR Keenan Allen and S Derwin James Jr., were the game captains for the Chargers. The Bolts won the toss and deferred to the second half.

DL Nick Williams recovered a fumble on the first drive of the 2023 season, marking the first time since 2012 the Chargers defense recovered a fumble on the opening defensive series of a season. The Bolts took the ensuing possession 94 yards in 14 plays, finishing with a one-yard touchdown run by RB Austin Ekeler.

On offense, Los Angeles totaled 433 net yards, 30 first downs and converted 60 percent of its third-down attempts (nine-of-15). The Bolts became the fourth team since 2000 to run for over 230 rushing yards and three touchdowns on Kickoff Weekend, and the first since 2010. Ekeler totaled 164 yards from scrimmage (117 rushing, 47 receiving), the fifth 100-yard rushing performance of his career and fifth with at least 150 scrimmage yars. RB Joshua **Kelley** added 91 yards on the ground, marking the first game for the Chargers with a pair of 90-yard rushers since 2008.

Defensively, Los Angeles broke up a total of 10 passes on the day, tying for the second-most in Week 1 across the NFL and the most by any Chargers defense during Kickoff Weekend since at least 1991. The Bolts also registered a pair of takeaways in the game - Nick Williams' fumble recovery and an interception by CB J.C. Jackson.

HERBERT KEEPS COMP

QB Justin Herbert completed 23 passes on the day, extending his streak of games with 20-plus completions to 28 consecutive games. It's the third-longest streak in NFL history. He also had a 21-game streak earlier in his career.
