Philip Rivers Named AFC Offensive Player of the Week

Los Angeles Chargers quarterback **Philip Rivers** was named the **AFC Offensive Player of the Week**, the National Football League office announced on Wednesday. The weekly accolade is the 10th of his storied career.

Rivers had a record-breaking performance on Sunday against the Cardinals. Rivers set the NFL single-game record by completing 25-straight passes. His records on the day included the most consecutive completions to start a game, the most consecutive completions in a single game and he tied Ryan Tannehill for the most consecutive passes completed at any point in league history. On top of the completions record, Rivers finished the game with a 96.6 completion percentage, the highest by a quarterback in a single game in league annals (min. 20 att.).

Despite not playing a snap in the fourth quarter, the signal-caller threw for 259 yards and three touchdowns on 28-for-29 passing. Rivers now has 26 touchdowns on the season, extending his streak to 11 straight seasons with 25 or more touchdown passes.

The Chargers prepare for a primetime matchup on the road against the Pittsburgh Steelers as the two teams will clash on NBC Sunday Night Football. Kickoff is scheduled for Sunday, Dec.2, at 5:20 PM PT.
