LOS ANGELES CHARGERS vs. INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

CHARGERS FALL TO COLTS

The Los Angeles Chargers fell to the Indianapolis Colts at SoFi Stadium on Sunday, moving to 4-3 on the season.

QB Justin Herbert completed 67.3 percent of his passes (37-of-55) for a career-high 420 yards and three touchdowns with two interceptions, registering a 93.0 passer rating. With 37 completions on Sunday, Herbert passed QB Matt Ryan (2,093) for the third-most completions by any player through the first six seasons of a career in NFL history with 2,178.

WR Keenan Allen hauled in his 70th career touchdown reception during Sunday's game marking 34 touchdowns with QB Philip Rivers and 36 touchdowns with QB Justin Herbert throughout his 13th year in the league. He finished the game with 11 receptions for 119 yards (10.8 avg.) and a touchdown.

The performance marked an NFL-record 17th of his career with 11-plus receptions. It was also the 12th of his career with at least 10 catches, 100 yards and a touchdown, tying for the second-most performances in NFL history. Allen is now eight catches away from passing Hall of Fame **TE Antonio Gates** (955) for the most receptions in team history.

Rookie **TE Oronde Gadsden** turned in a career-best performance, matching his career high in receptions (seven), registering a career-high 164 receiving yards and snagging the first touchdown of his career. The 164 yards are the most by an NFL tight end this season and the most by a rookie tight end in a single game since the 1970 NFL-AFL Merger (N.Y. Giants TE Mark Bavaro, 176 yards on Oct. 13, 1985).

Herbert connected with seven different receivers on the day. Allen and Gadsden were the first pair of Chargers teammates to have 100-plus receiving yards in the same game since Allen and **WR Mike Williams** did so in Week 3 of the 2023 season (at Minnesota).

OLB Khalil Mack returned to action and notched his second sack of the season. Mack now has 109.5 sacks during his 12-year career in the league.

ALLEN HAULS THEM IN

Keenan Allen finished the day with 11 receptions for 119 yards (10.8 avg.) and a touchdown. The game marked the 17th of his career with 11-plus catches, the most in NFL history. His 16 games of 11-plus catches and 100-plus receiving yards is also an all-time high, while his 20 performances with at least 10 receptions and 100 yards is tied for the second-most ever. Allen is also tied for the second-most performances in NFL history with 10 catches, 100 yards and a touchdown.
