CHARGERS FALL TO STEELERS, 20-10

The Los Angeles Chargers fell to the Pittsburgh Steelers, 20-10, at Acrisure Stadium on Sunday.

QB Justin Herbert completed 12-of-18 passes (66.7 pct.) for 125 yards and one touchdown for a passer rating of 105.1. **QB Taylor Heinicke** was 2-for-2 passing for 24 yards and a passer rating of 116.7.

RB J.K. Dobbins led the Chargers ground attack with 44 yards on 15 carries (2.9 avg.) while also catching three passes for 10 yards.

WR Quentin Johnston scored the Bolts' lone touchdown on a 27-yard reception in the first quarter, marking the first time in his career that he has scored in back-to-back games. Rookie **WR Ladd McConkey** led the chargers in receiving yards with 44 on three receptions (14.7 avg.).

Defensively, **LB Daiyan Henley** led the defense with 12 (nine solo), 1.0 tackle for loss, and one pass defensed. Sunday marked the second-year player's first career 10-plus tackle game. **S Derwin James Jr.** added eight tackles (five solo), 1.0 sack and 2.0 tackles for loss while **OLB Khalil Mack** tallied five tackles (two solo), 1.0 sack and 1.0 tackle for loss. **OLB Bud Dupree**, the 22nd overall pick by the Pittsburgh Steelers in the 2015 NFL Draft, added two tackles (one solo), one interception and one pass defensed.

COMPLETING RECORDS

On his 11th completion of the day, **QB Justin Herbert** reached 1,655 for his career and surpass Ryan Tannehill (1,653) and Matt Ryan (1,654) for the third-most by any quarterback in the first five seasons of a career in NFL history. The completion was a one-yard shovel pass to **RB J.K. Dobbins** in the second quarter. He heads into Week 4 with 1,656 completions.
