LOS ANGELES CHARGERS vs. NEW ORLEANS SAINTS

CHARGERS DEFEAT SAINTS, 26-8

The Los Angeles Chargers defeated the New Orleans Saints, 26-8, at SoFi Stadium on Sunday.

Sunday's win was headlined by a career performance from rookie **WR Ladd McConkey**, who totaled 111 yards and two touchdowns on six receptions (18.5 avg.) including a 60-yard receiving touchdown — the longest scoring play by the Chargers this season.

QB Justin Herbert completed 20-of-32 passes for 279 yards and two touchdowns with no interceptions for a 111.3 passer rating. He also totaled 49 yards on four carries, including a career-long 38-yard scamper.

WR Joshua Palmer added a season-high 72 receiving yards on two receptions (36.0 avg.) while **TE Will Dissly** notched five receptions for 41 yards (8.2 avg.).

RB J.K. Dobbins paced the Bolts on the ground, rushing for 57 yards and one touchdown on 17 carries (3.4 avg.).

FB/DL Scott Matlock was effective on both sides of the ball, recording one reception for nine yards offensively and adding 1.0 sack. The Boise State product is the first Charger since 1982, when sacks became an official stat, to record both a reception and sack in a single game. He is the first player since Christian Wilkins in Week 16 of the 2019 season to accomplish the feat.

Three Chargers — **OLB Bud Dupree**, **OLB Tuli Tuipulotu** and **Matlock** — recoded a sack on the day. Dupree added four solo tackles and a quarterback hit while Tuipulotu recorded two solo tackles, 1.0 tackle for loss, one quarterback hit and one pass defended.

LB Daiyan Henley led the team with 10 tackles (six solo) and one pass defended. Sunday marked his second game with at least 10 tackles this season. **DB Ja'Sir Taylor** added one tackle and matched a single game career high with two passes defended.

McCONKEY TOPS CENTURY MARK

WR Ladd McConkey had a career day against the Saints, totaling 111 yards and two touchdowns on six receptions (18.5 avg.) including a 60-yard receiving touchdown — the longest scoring play by the Chargers this season.

The rookie receiver is one of seven players this season to top 100 receiving yards and record multiple receiving touchdowns. McConkey joins Arizona WR Marvin Harrison Jr. as the only rookies to accomplish the feat in 2024.

McConkey is the fourth Chargers rookie since the 1970 merger to top the century mark and score two receiving touchdowns and the first to do so since Seyi Ajirotutu on Nov. 7, 2010 at Houston.
