CHARGERS FALL TO TEXANS

The Los Angeles Chargers fell to the Houston Texans, 41-29. The Bolts record now stands at 8-7. The Bolts closes out their home slate for the 2021 regular season against Denver in Week 17.

With a career day, **RB Justin Jackson** totaled 162 scrimmage yards, the most by a Chargers running back in a game in the last two seasons. He set single-game career highs in scrimmage yards (162), scrimmage touchdowns (two), rushing touchdowns (two), receptions (eight) and receiving yards (98).

K Dustin Hopkins made three field goals on the day. He has made 15-of-16 field goals (93.8 pct.) in his nine games with the team, tying tied for the best in a single season in team history among players with at least 15 field goal attempts (Michael Badgley, 93.8 pct. in 2018).

ALLEN REACHES 95 CATCHES ON THE YEAR

With four catches for 35 yards (8.8 avg.), **WR Keenan Allen** hit 96 catches for the year. The five-time Pro Bowler has topped 95 receptions in each season since 2017, setting the second-longest streak in history.

HERBERT ECLIPSES 8.500 CAREER YARDS

With 336 passing yards on the day, **QB Justin Herbert** the third player ever to eclipse 8,500 yards within the first 30 starts of a career. His 783 career completions are the most ever in a player's first 30 starts, while his 64 passing touchdowns rank No. 4 in NFL history within the first 30 starts to a career.

Herbert's 4,394 passing yards this year are a single-season career high. The performance marked his eighth of the year with 300-plus passing yards, tying for the most in a single season in Chargers history (Herbert in 2020; **QB Philip Rivers** in 2015 and 2019; Hall of Fame **QB Dan Fouts** in 1980).

WHITE TOPS 120 TACKLES

LB Kyzir White totaled 11 tackles (six solo) on the day, giving him 126 for the season — good for the most by a Charger since **LB Donnie Edwards** had 143 tackles in 2006. The game marked White's sixth with double-digit tackles this year, the most by a Charger since **S Eric Weddle** had seven in 2008.
