FIRST THINGS FIRST

- The Buccaneers are 7-1 (.875) in December/January games dating back to the start of 2023 and 19-5 (.792) dating back to the start of the 2020 season. Tampa Bay's seven-such wins and .875 win percentage since 2023 are each tied for the best in the NFL during that span.
- Dating back to Week 4 of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 52 of the last 65 weeks, winning three consecutive NFC South division titles during that span (2021-23).
- 13th all-time meeting ... Los Angeles enters with a 8-4 series advantage ... The Buccaneers have won the past three meetings and have not suffered a road loss to the Chargers since the 2004 season.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

THE RESURGENCE IN THE RUN GAME

• The Buccaneers have rushed for 100+ yards in 10-of-13 (76.9%) games this season after doing so in 9-of-34 (26.5%) games over the previous two seasons. When rushing for 100+ yards since 2022, Tampa Bay is 14-5 in those contests.



• Tampa Bay currently ranks fourth in the NFL in yards per rush (5.1) after finishing 32nd in that category in each of the previous two seasons. Tampa Bay's 5.1 rushing yards per attempt this season is the team's highest average through 13 games in team history.

• Rookie Bucky Irving ranks fourth in the NFL in yards per touch (6.1) among players with 125+ touches this season, trailing only a trio of Pro Bowl running backs. Irving and Rachaad White are the only running back tandem in the NFL in which both players have three-or-more games with 100+ yards from scrimmage, and 1-of-2 duos with 800+ total yards from scrimmage each on the season.

TURKEY TIME WITH THE O-LINE

On Tuesday, November 26, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers offensive line and Publix Super Markets continued an annual tradition with the 18th annual Turkey Time with the O-Line, supported by Publix.
