CHARGERS FALL TO PATRIOTS

The Los Angeles Chargers fell in Sunday's matchup with the New England Patriots, 27-24. The rushing offense posted 163 yards, the second-highest output of the season. Rookie **WR Joshua Palmer** caught a 24-yard score in the fourth quarter for his first career NFL touchdown catch.

On the opening drive of the game, the Chargers went 75 yards in eight plays, capping off the possession with a five-yard touchdown run by **RB Austin Ekeler**. It was the team's third opening-drive touchdown of the season.

JAMES FORCES THE ISSUE

S Derwin James Jr., forced his third fumble of the season in the third quarter. He became the first Chargers defender to force three fumbles in the team's first seven games of a season since **DE Marcellus Wiley** in 2001.

JACKSON BREAKS OFF A LONG RUN

In the second quarter, **RB Justin Jackson** broke free a 75-yard run to set up the team's second touchdown of the day. It was the second-longest run by a Charger in the last decade (Melvin Gordon, 87-yard touchdown at New England in 2017). The play was also the second-longest non-scoring run in franchise history.

GRAIINN-ANN-PAIINN

The Los Angeles rushing attack finished the day with 163 rushing yards, the team's second-best output of the season.

In the first half, the Bolts posted 122 rushing yards, good for the fourth-most by a Chargers offense in the first half in the last decade. It's also the most in the first half of a home game over that same span.

EKELER SHOWS HIS VERSATILITY

For the fifth time this season, **RB Austin Ekeler** topped 100 yards from scrimmage, finishing the day with 124 (64 rushing, 60 receiving). His five performances of 100-plus scrimmage yards trail only Tennessee's Derrick Henry and Indianapolis' Jonathan Taylor this season (each with six).

Ekeler punched in a five-yard rushing score to cap off the game's opening drive, his career-best fifth touchdown run of the season.
