## LOS ANGELES CHARGERS at LAS VEGAS RAIDERS

### CHARGERS REACH 11 WINS IN LAS VEGAS

The Los Angeles Chargers defeated the Las Vegas Raiders 34-20 at Allegiant Stadium on Sunday. The Bolts finished the regular season with 11 wins, their most since 2018.

**QB Justin Herbert** completed 28-of-36 passes for 346 yards for a passer rating of 125.2. He added 42 yards on four carries (10.5 avg.), including a career long 41-yard rush to set up a touchdown toss to **TE Will Dissly**.

**WR Quentin Johnston** finished with a single game career high 13 receptions for 186 yards (14.3 avg.), including nine catches for 117 yards in first half. The nine first half receptions tied for the third-most in a first half by a Charger since 1991.

**WR Ladd McConkey** recorded his fifth game this season with at least 90 receiving yards, finishing with 95 receiving yards on five receptions (19.0 avg.).

Comeback Player of the Year candidate **RB J.K. Dobbins** reached 1,000 yards from scrimmage on the season with a 4-yard rush in the second quarter. Dobbins finished with 63 yards on 18 carries. **RB Hassan Haskins** found the end zone for a 2-yard score in the fourth quarter and finished with 33 rushing yards.

**K Cameron Dicker** made four field goals and two extra points, bringing him to 150 points scored on the season. Dicker's 150 points are the most in a single season by a kicker in Chargers history and second-most by any player in team history.

**LB Daiyan Henley** recorded his first career interception with 0:38 remaining in the second quarter. Henley's interception set up a 4-play scoring drive that ended with a 6-yard touchdown pass from Herbert to **WR DJ Chark Jr.**

### HERBERT PASSES MANNING & MARINO

Sunday marked **QB Justin Herbert's** 27th game with at least 300 passing yards, passing Hall of Fame QB Dan Marino, QB Andrew Luck and tying QB Jameis Winston for the third-most by any player in their first five seasons.

Herbert finished the 2024 regular season with the second-fewest interceptions by a passer with at least 450 attempts in NFL history.

Herbert became the fifth-fastest player to reach 21,000 career passing yards in just his 79th career game. Herbert had two passing touchdowns for the 44th time in his career, passing Hall of Fame QB Peyton Manning for the sixth-most by a player in their first five seasons in NFL history.

## Q HAD A DAY

WR **Quentin Johnston** concluded the day setting career highs in receptions (13) and receiving yards (186).

His 186 yards on the day were the most by a Bolts receiver in the 2024 season and the most since WR Keenan Allen totaled 183 against Houston in Week 3 of the 2019 season.

In the first half, the second-year receiver hauled in nine receptions for 117 yards (13.0 avg.). Johnston's nine receptions ties for the third highest total in the opening half of a game by a Bolts player since 1991. Sunday also marked the second time he eclipsed the century mark in the first half of a game this season, also doing so against Cleveland in Week 9 when he totaled 118 receiving yards.

Johnston joins WR Keenan Allen (3), WR Tyrell Williams (3) and WR Vincent Jackson (2) as the only Chargers since 1991 to record at least 110 receiving yards in the first half of a game.

## DICKER ADDS ANOTHER RECORD

With 14 points scored against the Raiders, **K Cameron Dicker** totaled 150 in the 2024 season, good for the most by a kicker in franchise history and second only to Hall of Fame RB LaDainian Tomlinson's NFL-record 186 in 2006.
