★ Cowboys Training Camp ★



The Dallas Cowboys returned to Oxnard, California to open their 66th training camp in 2025 at the Staybridge Suites Oxnard - River Ridge by IHG. The 2025 camp, presented by American Airlines, marked the 46th year that the team prepped for the upcoming season in California and the 19th time that the Cowboys spent all, or a portion of, its camp at the Oxnard location. Dallas came back to the west coast permanently in 2012 after training in the Alamodome in San Antonio prior to the 2011 season.

The Cowboys are one-of-six teams who spent camp away from their home facilities in 2025 - Buffalo, Indianapolis, Kansas City, LA Rams and Pittsburgh. Teams considered to be “staying home” hold the majority of camp at their respective practice facility, home stadium or at a site within 10 miles of their team headquarters. In 2000, only 10-of-31 (32 percent) teams stayed close to home.

Training camp in Oxnard concluded Thursday, Aug. 14, as the team returned to Texas and will wrap up the final portion of Cowboys training camp at Ford Center at The Star in Frisco, Texas, with practices on Aug. 19 and Aug. 20 open to the public, starting at 6 p.m.

★ Training Camp History ★

June 3, 1960 – The newly formed Dallas Cowboys franchise announced that it will train at Pacific University in Forest Grove, Oregon. Rookies reported on July 9.

May 24, 1961 – Due to its proximity to their first exhibition game against Minnesota in Minneapolis, the Dallas Cowboys moved training camp to St. Olaf College in Northfield, Minn. Camp opened on July 9.

June 8, 1962 – The Dallas Cowboys moved their training camp site to the campus of Northern Michigan College on the shores of Lake Superior in Marquette, Mich. Rookies reported on July 13.

July 12, 1963 – Because the team played three of its first four preseason games on the west coast, the Dallas Cowboys moved training camp to California Lutheran College in Thousand Oaks, Calif. This camp, which was the first of 27 at CLC, opened on July 12.

Dec. 6, 1989 – For the first time in the 30-year history of the team, the Dallas Cowboys trained in Texas as the club announced its 1990 training camp would be held at St. Edward's University in Austin, Texas. This camp, the first of eight at St. Ed's, opened on July 22.

Feb. 17, 1998 – The Cowboys began a four-year stay at Midwestern State University in Wichita Falls, Texas, with their 1998 camp. The first camp at Midwestern State University opened on July 16. In 2001, the Cowboys split camp between Midwestern State and the Residence Inn in Oxnard, Calif., spending two weeks at each location.

May 17, 2002 – The Cowboys continued their commitment to fans in the state of Texas by announcing the 2002 training camp will take place at the Alamodome in San Antonio, Texas. The camp, which ran for four weeks, opened on July 26. The Cowboys returned to the Alamodome again in 2003.

Oct. 24, 2003 – The Cowboys announced a return to California for training camp. For the 2004-06 seasons, the Cowboys conducted their entire training camp in Oxnard, Calif., at the Residence Inn at River Ridge, using practice fields provided by The City of Oxnard. The Cowboys opened their first returned camp on July 30, 2004.

May 4, 2006 – The Dallas Cowboys announced a five-year commitment to once again call the City of San Antonio its summer home beginning in 2007. The Alamodome, which played host to Cowboys training camps in 2002 and 2003 was again the site for the team's summer practice sessions.

Summer, 2010 – The Dallas Cowboys held a split camp, spending the first portion in the Alamodome in San Antonio and the second at the Residence Inn at River Ridge in Oxnard.

July, 2012 – The Dallas Cowboys returned to Oxnard, California for all of training camp at the Residence Inn at River Ridge after spending the 2011 training camp in San Antonio at the Alamodome.

August, 2017 – After spending the first four weeks of training camp in Oxnard, California, the Dallas Cowboys returned home to hold their first ever training camp practices at their new practice facility at The Star in Frisco. Six training camp practices were held inside Ford Center and open to the public.

August, 2020 – For the first time in franchise history, the Cowboys spent all of training camp at The Star in Frisco due to COVID-19 restrictions.

July, 2021 – The Cowboys return to Oxnard, California for training camp after spending 2020 training camp in Frisco.



★ BRIAN SCHOTTENHEIMER ★



Brian Schottenheimer was named the 10th head coach of the Dallas Cowboys on Jan. 24, 2025 after spending the last three seasons with the organization, first as a consultant in 2022 and as offensive coordinator from 2023-24. Schottenheimer brings 25 years of NFL coaching experience, including 15 years as an offensive coordinator at the pro level.

Over Schottenheimer's two seasons (2023-24) as the steward of the Cowboys offense, Dallas ranked second in completions (826), third in pass attempts (1,251) and sixth in big pass plays (25-plus yards, 69), points-per-game (25.3) and total first downs (712). In his first year as the Cowboys offensive coordinator, Dallas led the league in scoring offense (29.9 points-per-game), ranked fifth in total offense (371.6 yards-per-game) and third in passing yards-per-game (258.6).

Prior to Dallas, Schottenheimer was the passing game coordinator for Jacksonville during the 2021 season, assisting with the Jaguars No. 1 overall selection, Trevor Lawrence.

From 2018-20, Schottenheimer was the offensive coordinator for the Seattle Seahawks (2018-20), in which he helped lead the Seahawks to three consecutive postseason appearances. Over those three seasons, Seattle ranked third in touchdown passes (106), passer rating (106.8) and rushing yards-per-game (140.2).

Schottenheimer spent three seasons as the offensive coordinator for the St. Louis Rams (2012-14). The Rams tallied 38 touchdowns in 2013, which was then the most in a single season for the franchise since 2006 when they reached the end zone 39 times.

Schottenheimer's first stint as a play caller began with the N.Y. Jets, where he spent six seasons (2006-11) as the offensive coordinator. He assembled an offense that helped the Jets earn back-to-back appearances in the AFC Championship Game from 2009-10 while also leading the NFL in rushing offense (160.3 yards-per-game).

Following a collegiate career that saw him play three seasons for Steve Spurrier at the University of Florida, Schottenheimer embarked on his lengthy coaching career, which included stints working with his father, long-time NFL head coach Marty Schottenheimer, in both Kansas City (1998) and Washington (2001).

★ PRO BOWL COWBOYS ★

Heading into the 2025 season, the Dallas Cowboys currently have 10 Pro Bowlers on their roster. Nine of the 10 players who have made at least one Pro Bowl started their career with Dallas, with Bryan Anger being the lone exception as an unrestricted free agent signing in 2021.

★ 2025 FREE AGENCY ★

At the end of the 2024 season, the Dallas Cowboys had 24 players slotted for free agency, 19 unrestricted.
