★ BY THE NUMBERS ★

Quinnen Williams became the fourth defensive tackle in Cowboys franchise history to record an interception in his first five games with the team, joining La'Roi Glover (2002), Bruce Thornton (1979) and Ken Frost (1961).

400

The Cowboys have recorded at least 400 yards of offense in eight games in 2025, most in the NFL. Dallas' 396.9 yards-per-game also lead the league.

1,113

Javonte Williams ranks sixth in the NFL with 1,113 rushing yards. That is the most rushing yards by a Cowboys running back since Ezekiel Elliott (1,357) in 2019.

1,212

George Pickens' 1,212 receiving yards are third in the NFL this season and the most by a Cowboys player through his first season with the team.



★ MAN OF THE YEAR CLUB WINNER ★

The Dallas Cowboys announced that Solomon Thomas has been selected as the team's club winner for the 2025 Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year Award presented by Nationwide.

A well-established veteran in the NFL, Thomas joined the Dallas Cowboys as a free agent in March 2025 with a longstanding dedication to community engagement, particularly through mental health advocacy and youth empowerment already in place. A North Texas native, Thomas was already making an impact in his hometown through his foundation – The Defensive Line. Founded by Thomas and his parents in 2021, The Defensive Line is a nonprofit aimed at honoring his late sister Ella and addressing youth suicide and mental health stigma in communities of color. As a member of the Dallas Cowboys, Thomas has used his platform to host a variety of mental health discussions for communities of need, most recently partnering with Dallas ISD (Texas' largest provider of student mental health services) for a series of conversations that demonstrate to youth the importance of asking for help and stressing that is "OK to not be OK".



★ ONE LOVE ★

Marshawn Kneeland tragically passed away on Nov. 6. To honor him moving forward, the Dallas Cowboys will wear a #94 helmet decal for the remainder of the 2025 season. The Cowboys also honored their beloved teammate with commemorative T-shirts.

★ WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN GAME 15 ★

4

DAK PRESCOTT

- * With 69 passing yards on Sunday, Dak Prescott will reach 4,000 passing yards in 2025. It would mark Prescott's fourth career 4,000-yard season, which would tie Tony Romo for the most 4,000-yard seasons in franchise history.
- * With four passing touchdowns, Prescott will reach 30 touchdown passes in 2025. It would also mark Prescott's fourth career season with at least 30 passing touchdowns, which would tie Romo for the most such seasons in franchise history.
- * Prescott has completed at least 60.0% of his passes in all 14 games in 2025. If he records a 60% completion rate on Sunday, he would tie Tony Romo for the longest such streak in a season in Cowboys history (2014).

JAVONTE WILLIAMS

- * Javonte Williams has averaged at least 6.0 yards-per-carry in four games in 2025. If he averages 6.0 yards-per-carry on Sunday, he will become the third player in franchise history - first since 1970 - to record a rushing average of 6.0-or-higher in five games in a season (min. 10 attempts/game). The other two Cowboys were Amos Marsh (six games in 1962) and Duane Thomas (five in 1970).

DONOVAN EZEIRUAKU

- * Donovan Ezeiruaku ranks second among NFL rookies with nine tackles for loss in 2025. With a tackle for loss on Sunday, Ezeiruaku would become the fourth Cowboys rookie since 1999 to have at least 10 tackles for loss in a season, joining Micah Parsons (20 in 2021), DeMarcus Ware (15 in 2005) and Sam Williams (10 in 2022).

JAKE FERGUSON

- * Jake Ferguson's 77 receptions are the second-most in a season by a Cowboys tight end since Dak Prescott took over as Dallas' starting quarterback in 2016. Dalton Schultz has the most with 78 catches in 2021.
- * Ferguson needs one yard to reach 2,000 career receiving yards. He would join Jason Witten as the only tight ends in franchise history with 2,000 receiving yards in the first four seasons of a career.
- * Ferguson needs two touchdowns to tie Jason Witten (2010) and Billy Joe Dupree (1978) for the most receiving touchdowns in a season (nine) by a Cowboys tight end.

CEEDEE LAMB

- * With 24 receiving yards, Lamb will reach 1,000 yards in 2025 and become the first player in franchise history with at least 1,000 receiving yards in five of his first six seasons. He would also join Michael Irvin (1991-95) as the only two players in franchise history with 1,000 receiving yards in five consecutive seasons.
- * With 22 scrimmage yards on Sunday, Lamb will reach 1,000 scrimmage yards. He would be the third receiver in NFL history with 1,000 scrimmage yards in each of his first six seasons, joining Mike Evans and Randy Moss.
- * Lamb (559) needs six receptions to pass Jarvis Landry (564) for the most receptions in a player's first six seasons in NFL history. (*Justin Jefferson is also at 561 career receptions and could also pass Landry on Sunday.*)



DALLAS COWBOYS

- * Dallas has recorded at least 400 yards in four consecutive games (vs. Phi, 11/23 - vs. Min, 12/14), the longest such streak in the NFL this season. With 400 yards against the LA Chargers, it would mark the second-longest 400-yard streak in franchise history. The longest 400-yard streak was eight games in 2016.
- * The Cowboys have scored 218 points in the first half this season, the fifth most in the NFL.
- * Dallas leads the NFL with 396.9 yards-per-game in 2025. If the Cowboys finish the season as the league's top offense in terms of yards-per-game, it would be mark the eighth time in franchise history that the Cowboys led the league in total offense and just the third time this century (2019 and 2021).
- * Since the Week 11 bye, the Dallas defense has allowed 79.0 rushing yards-per-game, the second-fewest in the NFL. Only Jacksonville (76.6) has allowed fewer rushing yards-per-game than Dallas over the last five weeks.

★ INSIDE THE SERIES HISTORY ★

The matchup between the Dallas Cowboys and Los Angeles Chargers started in 1972 when Dallas headed out west and came home with a 34-28 win. In total, there have been 13 games between the two teams.

In the 13 games of the series there have been:

- * Eight games decided by less than seven points
- * Four games decided by more than 10 points
- * Two season openers (1990 and 2005) - both Dallas wins
- * A 14-point win by Dallas - biggest Cowboys win
- * A 22-point loss by Dallas - biggest Cowboys loss
- * One Sunday night game
- * 296 points scored by Dallas, 295 allowed
- * A 2-3 Cowboys record in home games, including an 0-2 record at AT&T Stadium
- * A 6-2 Cowboys record in away games

★ WILD, WILD WEST ★

By virtue of the NFL schedule, the Dallas Cowboys face the AFC West this season. Dallas is 2-1 against the AFC West this season with wins over the Las Vegas Raiders and Kansas City Chiefs and a loss at the Denver Broncos.

★ PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS vs. LAC ★

CeeDee Lamb - WR

Grabbed 15 receptions for 198 yards in two appearances against the Chargers. Tallied a series-high 117 yards in Dallas' 2023 victory.

Osa Odighizuwa - DT

Recorded nine tackles and seven quarterback pressures in two games against the Chargers.

Dak Prescott - QB

Completed 76.2% of his passes for 688 yards and one touchdown through three games against the Chargers.

Javonte Williams - RB

In four seasons with Denver, played in six games against the Chargers, totaling 238 yards and two touchdowns on 70 carries.

★ HOME COOKING ★

The Cowboys are tied with the LA Rams for the fewest negative plays in the NFL this year at 61. Dallas' 27 rush plays that have resulted in negative yardage are the second-fewest in the league, behind Cincinnati.

Dallas has recorded at least 400 yards in four consecutive games (vs. Phi, 11/23 - vs. Min, 12/14), the longest such streak in the NFL this season. With 400 yards against the LA Chargers, it would mark the second-longest 400-yard streak in franchise history.

★ IRON MEN IN THE TRENCHES ★

On the final day of the 2025 trade deadline, Dallas traded for three-time Pro Bowl defensive lineman Quinnen Williams, who is known across the league for his elite run defense.

According to *Pro Football Focus*, Williams has generated a run stop on 27-of-203 snaps against the run, a 13.7% run stop percentage that is second among NFL defensive linemen that have played at least 100 snaps against the run:

★ THE ROOKIE ★

The Dallas Cowboys selected Donovan Ezeiruaku with their second round pick in the 2025 NFL Draft. He led FBS with 16.5 sacks at Boston College in 2024, and he is off to a fast start in his rookie campaign with Dallas.

Per TruMedia, Ezeiruaku is tied for third among NFL rookies with 22 defensive splash plays in 2025. A splash play includes a sack, tackle for loss, pressure leading to throw away, run and pass stuff, interception, forced fumble, fumble recovery, passes defended and stops on third or fourth down.
