DOLPHINS SEE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM AROUND THE ROSTER

- **LB Jackson Woodard** recovered a fumble by New York's Tyrone Tracy Jr. at the Dolphins 10-yard line in the first quarter, ending a promising red-zone drive for the Giants.
 - Miami's defense held the Giants to two touchdowns on six trips to the red zone.
 - The Dolphins have now recorded at least one takeaway in each of their last five preseason games dating back to Aug. 10, 2025, at the Chicago Bears – the streak is tied for the second-longest streak in the NFL.
 - Woodard, who led the team in tackles against Washington in Week 1 of the Preseason, totaled four stops (three solo), the fumble recovery and a solo tackle on special teams.
- **EDGE Seth Coleman-Lyles** and **DL Cam Rice** combined on a sack of Giants QB Brandon Allen in the third quarter, bringing him down for a loss of nine yards to force a 3rd-and-17 that led to a punt.
 - In addition to the half-sack, Rice totaled two tackles (one solo), a pass defended and three quarterback hits.
 - Coleman-Lyles added three tackles (one solo) in addition to his half-sack.
- **LB Cam Riley** had a game-high 10 tackles (six solo) including a tackle for loss in the fourth quarter.
 - Riley is one of five Dolphins players to record 10 tackles in a preseason game in the past decade, joining Chase Allen (12 – Aug. 31, 2017 at Minnesota), Channing Tindall (12 – Aug. 23, 2024 at Tampa Bay), Sam Eguavoen (11 – Aug. 21, 2021 vs. Atlanta and Tre Watson (10 – Aug. 22, 2019 at New Orleans).
- **LB Willie Gay Jr.** added eight tackles (five solo) and a tackle for loss.
 - He leads the Dolphins in tackles through Miami's two preseason games with 12 (nine solo).
- After signing with the Dolphins yesterday, **LB Stephen Dix Jr.** totaled three tackles (one solo) in his team debut.
- **QB Cam Miller** completed 6-of-11 pass attempts for 60 yards (54.5 pct.) and added two carries for 18 yards (9.0 avg.) on the ground.
 - On Miami's second drive of the game, Miller connected for a 30-yard completion to **WR Kevin Coleman Jr.** to move the chains on 3rd-and-5.
 - Coleman Jr., a fifth-round round pick by Miami in the 2026 NFL Draft, caught two passes for 31 yards (15.5 avg.) in his first action at the NFL level.
- **K Riley Patterson** knocked through a 53-yard field goal in the second quarter, adding his first field goal of the 2026 preseason and the longest field goal of his preseason career.
 - Patterson is coming off a season in which he converted 27-of-29 field goals (93.1 pct.), setting the Dolphins' single-season field goal percentage record.

- 60,836 tickets were distributed for today's game.
- Miami won today's coin toss (tails) and elected to receive.
- Today's temperature at kickoff was listed as 94°F – it tied the Dolphins' win over the New York Jets on Sept. 3, 1995 for the third-hottest game in franchise history and tied the record for the hottest Dolphins' home game ever.
