When can I purchase tickets?

If I signed up to fundraise, do I automatically get tickets?

If you create a fundraising page during the VIP Registration between *Wednesday, January 29^{th-} Tuesday, February 4^{th,}*, and commit to fundraising \$250, you will receive six complimentary tickets for your family to attend Huddle Up for Autism! Tickets will automatically be sent to the email address used to create the fundraising page **3 weeks prior to the event.**

Please note, if you fundraise for incentive levels but did not register for the VIP Registration and commit to the \$250 minimum, you will still need to purchase tickets.

Can I purchase additional tickets for my family?

Absolutely! Additional tickets may be purchased during the general sale starting Tuesday, February 4th. **Please make sure you purchase tickets with the same email used to create your fundraising page.**

When is the fundraising deadline?

The fundraising deadline is Friday, March 21st, 2025, at 11:59 pm. All incentive levels and top fundraisers will be finalized at that time. If you participated in the VIP Registration or committed to raising \$250, your card will be charged on that date if you have not met your \$250 fundraising minimum.

When will I receive my fundraising incentives?

Day of event fundraising incentives will be mailed to the address supplied when you registered your fundraising page during the week of March 24th.

ABOUT THE EVENT

Where is the event being held?

The event will take place at Lincoln Financial Field, 1 Lincoln Financial Field Way, Philadelphia, PA 19147.

Can I take public transportation to Lincoln Financial Field?

How much are tickets?

Tickets are \$10 per person and are required for every individual attending the event.

Does it cost money to park at the event?

No. K-lot will be open for free to all Huddle Up for Autism attendees. Hall of Fame+ and Hall of Fame fundraisers will receive communication noting a separate parking lot and event entrance.

Will food be available for purchase?

Concession stands will be open, and a variety of items will be available for purchase. Gluten-free food options will also be available.

Will the Philadelphia Eagles Pro Shop be open on event day?

Will you postpone or cancel Huddle Up for Autism if it rains?

No. The event will take place rain or shine. Many of the activities will be held on the club level or service level of the stadium, which are both entirely closed and climate controlled.

Players will **not** be announced until the day of the event. **Ticketed autograph opportunities with Eagles players and Legends will be reserved exclusively for registered fundraisers at the Pro Bowl Level and above.**
