Through donations from Giants home games, approximately 13,000 meals are distributed each year. Since 1991, Rock and Wrap it Up! has fed over one billion people.




LOU RETTINO HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL COACH OF THE WEEK PRESENTED BY GATORADE


HEART OF A GIANT





USA Football's Heart of a Giant award program, presented by Hospital of Special Surgery and the New York Giants recognizes tri-state area high school football players who demonstrate extraordinary character, perseverance and work ethic. Throughout the high school football season, coaches nominate players that exemplify these traits. This year 11 student-athletes were nominated as finalists, each earning a \$1,000 equipment grant for their school, while each winner received an additional \$10,000 grant.




