



Safety & Security Plan:

2026 Enshrinement Weekend

OUR COMMITMENT: The Pro Football Hall of Fame is dedicated to ensuring a safe and secure environment for all guests at the 2026 Enshrinement Weekend across the Hall of Fame Campus, Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium and surrounding areas.

COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS: We partner with Canton Police, Canton Fire, Stark County Sheriff, K-9 Units, SWAT, FBI, NFL Security and other agencies to maintain a strong security presence. Our team continuously refines safety measures to address potential risks.

HOW YOU CAN HELP:

1. **Stay Vigilant:** Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
2. **See Something, Say Something:** Report suspicious activity, including unattended bags, disorderly conduct, verbal/physical altercations, threats or suspicious behavior. Never assume it's "probably nothing."
3. **Contact Authorities:**
 - **Emergency: Call 911 immediately.** Stay calm, provide details (e.g., location, incident description) and stay on the line until instructed to hang up.
 - **Non-Emergency:** Report to Canton Police, Stark County Sheriff or event staff at street intersections, within Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium, the campus or the Pro Football Hall of Fame Museum.
4. **Medical Assistance:** Visit one of two Canton Fire Department First Aid Stations on campus for medical needs.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES:

- **Call 911** for emergencies, providing your exact location (e.g., street, tent, or landmark).
- **Follow Instructions** from staff, security, or announcements.
- **Evacuate** calmly to the nearest exit and designated assembly point if directed.

Additional Tips:

- Note nearby exits, first aid stations and security personnel.
- Travel in groups when possible and secure belongings.
- Stay hydrated and prepared for weather conditions.
- Report disruptive behavior to ensure everyone's safety.
