

Sergeant First Class Daisy Balbuena serves as a Drone Operator with the 2nd Multi-Domain Brigade Combat Team, 82nd Airborne Division, stationed at Fort Liberty, North Carolina. With over 11 years of dedicated service in the U.S. Army, she has been instrumental in advancing aerial reconnaissance and intelligence operations.

VETERAN OF THE GAME - TEACH 5/ CORPORAL RUFUS MCCLURE

Rufus McClure was drafted into the United States Army during WWII when he turned 18. He volunteered as a paratrooper and after completing jump school, he was attached to the 13th Airborne Division training for the invasion of Japan until the Battle of the Bulge, at which time he was shipped to Europe to join the 82nd Airborne Division. While attached to the 82nd Airborne Division, he supported the liberation of the Wobbelin concentration camp. After the Allied Victory in Europe, he boarded a transportation vessel in France destined for the Pacific theater for the invasion of Japan. While he was embarked on the vessel in France, Japan surrendered to the allies and the vessel changed its destination to New York City. He was awarded the American Theater Service Medal, European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Service Medal, Bronze Service Star, Good Conduct Medal, and the World War 2 Victory Medal. After graduating from college, he applied for a position at The Bolles School in Jacksonville and served as a teacher and administrator for over 55 years. Mr. McClure was instrumental in the Bolles transition from a military academy to a private academic school in 1962 and in the transition to a coeducational institution in 1971. Mr. McClure retired from The Bolles School in 2000 and stayed on for an additional 10 years as an advisor.

DIVISION TITLE ON THE LINE

Jaguars secure AFC South title with win/tie
over Titans or Texans loss/tie against the Colts

JACKSONVILLE – The AFC South division championship has come down to Week 18.

The Jacksonville Jaguars (12-4), already holding playoff berth, would secure the AFC South crown with win or tie today against the Tennessee Titans.

The Jaguars would also secure the title if the Houston Texans (10-5) lose or tie against the Colts.

Both games are scheduled for 1:00pm ET in Week 18. If the Jaguars win, it would be the fifth division title in Jaguars' history, and the first since 2022.

The winner of the AFC South is assured of a home game in the Wild Card round of the playoffs.

The Jaguars are currently the No. 3 seed in the AFC Playoffs but could also improve their seeding with help. If both the Broncos and Patriots lose today, and the Jaguars win, then the Jaguars would be the No. 1 seed. If only one of those two teams lose, and the Jaguars win, then the Jaguars would elevate to the No. 2 seed.

The No. 1 seed gets a first-round bye and homefield advantage throughout the playoffs. The No. 2 seed would be at home at least the

first two rounds. The No. 3 seed would be assured only one home playoff game in the Wild Card round.

"We haven't really talked a ton about goals, about the division, playoffs, conference, Super Bowl – like we have not had any of those conversations as a team," Head Coach Liam Coen said after last week's win. "Not really on purpose, more so just because you're really trying to focus on getting better because there's so much to coach off of every week for us and even through a lot of wins, we're able to coach off a lot of stuff and keeping the mindset pretty singular on 1-0 each week.

"That's just been the mindset, a mentality that these guys have had and I've appreciated that, and we've fed off of each other that way."

ABOUT LAST WEEK

The Jaguars overcame early giveaways and shut down the run game on defense in a 23-17 win over the Colts in Week 17.

"You have to enjoy the wins, because you put in all this work to win games," quarterback Trevor Lawrence said. "And it's not always pretty, and I think can be looked at as a positive. The last few weeks, we've been in control of a lot of these games and haven't necessarily had to just go win at the end. And today we had to do that.

"It's a tight game, had to make some plays, defense had to have some huge stops, and they did it. So, I think it's all good for your team to learn and grow, and obviously more fun to learn and grow from wins. So, we'll take that, and we've got to get better."

On the opening possession and already trailing 3-0, the Jaguars moved easily into the red zone, but then a hook-and-lateral play was fumbled and the Colts recovered. Indianapolis drove the field and scored a touchdown to open a 10-0 lead.

Quarterback Trevor Lawrence later threw an interception in the end zone, his first turnover since Week 12 at Arizona. Lawrence also ran

for two touchdowns, his sixth career game with two rushing scores.

"I think he's always had some natural athletic ability," Coen said. "I thought our coaching staff did a really nice job of the quarterback draw today, scheming it up. It was similar to the one that we ran against the Raiders, I believe it was, but little bit different formation. It was actually off of a play we had run against them to Jakobi (Meyers) for a touchdown the first time that we played these guys.

"And kind of felt like they would over adjust to that, and they did, and our guys executed it well."

Wide receiver Parker Washington had 8 receptions for 115 yards, his second straight game over 100 yards. The Jaguars trailed 10-7 at halftime with the missed opportunities, and Washington shared the halftime message.

"Liam (Coen) came in and said, 'With the plays that we're not hurting ourselves, are we winning?' And we were winning, especially a lot of our matchups," Washington said. "He just said continue to be us and we don't have to get it all back right here. Just be us, have fun and just stay together. That's what it's all about."

Jonah Monheim started at center in place of the injured Robert Hainsey, while Walker Little started at right guard for the injured Patrick Mekari.

On defense, the Jaguars held Colts running back Jonathan Taylor to 70 yards on 21 carries, with only 19 second-half rushing yards on 9 attempts.

Colts quarterback Philip Rivers finished 17-of-30 for 147 yards with a touchdown and an interception.

"They played stingy, they played tough," Coen said. "To only allow 17 points in a game like that, that's huge. That was an offense regardless who's playing quarterback, that was rolling for a long time. It was like one of the best offenses in the NFL for a long time, and they got some weapons. So, proud of our guys and the coaching staff for doing a nice job defensively."

Colts wide receiver Alec Pierce was targeted five times and did not record a catch.

Jaguars cornerbacks Montaric Brown and Jarrian Jones each played well, with Brown

posting 2 passes defended and Jones an interception.

"I knew the look that we were giving," Jones said about his interception. "Josh Downs, great receiver. He was in the slot. I know he's kind of like the option route runner. (The pass has) gotta come out fast. Philip (Rivers) can't really throw the ball down the field, so my instincts kind of took over on the play."

THE TENNESSEE TITANS

The Jaguars defeated the Titans 25-3 in Week 13 at Nissan Stadium in Nashville, Tenn. Lawrence threw for 229 yards on 16-of-27 passing with two touchdown passes, one to wide receiver Jakobi Meyers and one to tight end Brenton Strange.

The Jaguars defense held the Titans offense to only 188 total yards, with rookie quarterback Cam Ward throwing for 141 yards on 24-of-38 passing.

Since the plaza level will no longer allow contiguous travel from gate to gate, the concourse level, accessible by ramps from each gate, will provide a 360-degree path around the stadium and will be the best way to navigate all public areas.

For any wayfinding questions, please find a Guest Experience Representative to assist.

WHEELCHAIR ESCORT

Wheelchair escort service is available at all perimeter gates of the stadium. Please find a Mobility Assistance Representative at most gate entries to request an escort when you arrive. This service will bring guests from the perimeter gate to their seats. Wheelchair escort service will return after the game to pick up guests at their seats and return them to their original perimeter entry gate.

Due to high demand, please note the service may come with a wait time.

Please note that if you need a wheelchair for all movements throughout the stadium, it is advised that you bring a wheelchair for your personal use throughout the entire day and contact the Jaguars ticket office at (904) 633-2000 for accessible seating availability. The Jaguars do not offer storage for personal wheelchairs or other accessibility devices in-stadium. The wheelchair escort service is intended to relieve patrons in need of the initial long entry and exit walks.

JTA GAMEDAY XPRESS

Come ride with JTA and say goodbye to driving and parking hassles. Fans can purchase single-game passes onsite at any Gameday Xpress lot on game days or via the MyJTA mobile app. The app runs on iOS and Android systems and is available on Google Play or the Apple App Store.

SECURE DIGITAL TICKETING

Be prepared on game day by downloading the official Jaguars app. Have your ticket barcode ready to scan directly from your mobile phone at the stadium gates. Please note print-at-home PDF tickets are no longer available. Don't wait in line at the box office. Access your tickets through your app or web browser.

To expedite your stadium entry on game day, please make sure to have your game ticket barcode ready to scan before arriving. Email confirmations will not be accepted. You must have your mobile ticket pulled up on your phone with the barcode prior to entering the stadium gate lines.

The Jaguars parking lots and parking passes will continue to be managed digitally for the 2025-2026 season. The Jaguars will not distribute any printed parking passes.

GEICO has you covered by getting you to the game easier with the new GEICO Game Day Shuttle Program! Available for every home game during the 2025 season at: Lot S, Lot X, Lot Z, and Met Park for ticketed fans only. Pick-up areas are located near each lot entrance. The complimentary shuttle service is available for 3 hours prior to kickoff and 1 hour after the end of each game.

Shuttle operations are temporarily suspended at kickoff and until the conclusion of each game. Post-game pick-up for Lot S, Lot X and Lot Z via the Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Wall. Guests parked in Met Park will be able to access post-game pick-up via Lot D.

If you are unable to secure a parking pass for an upcoming Jaguars game, it is strongly encouraged to arrange different transportation, including the JTA Gameday Xpress Service or Rideshare.

NFL BAG POLICY

To provide a safer environment for the public and significantly expedite fan entry into EverBank Stadium, NFL policy limits the size and type of bags that may be brought into the stadium. The Jaguars strongly encourage fans to not bring any type of bags. Fans are allowed to carry a clear bag up to 12" x 6" x 12" or a nonclear bag no larger than 4.5" x 6.5". This policy is strictly enforced.

Any medically necessary items must be pre-approved by the Jaguars. Please call (904) 633-2000 (option 1) or email myExperience@nfl.jaguars.com to be considered for approval. All items will be subject to proper inspection at entry gate.
