



JAGUARS LOOKING FOR REBOUND

Major AFC Wild Card implications in today's matchup with the Los Angeles Chargers

JACKSONVILLE – With eight games remaining, the Jaguars are squarely in the AFC playoff race.

However, how the Jacksonville Jaguars (5-4) respond to a painful 36-29 loss to the Houston Texans (4-5) – a game where the Jaguars blew a 19-point fourth quarter lead – last week will tell the tale of the final two months of this 2025 season.

"That's the whole message in the locker room

just now, Head Coach Liam Coen said after the game last week. "This one is going to sting, and it should, but we've got to move on. We have a big home game this week that we've got to get back up for.

"We had great energy and juice at practice (last) week. It showed with the way we started the game. We weren't able to sustain that for whatever reason in the second half, and we'll definitely have to challenge each other this week to get back on track."

The Jaguars host the Los Angeles Chargers (7-3) in Week 11, a game that has major AFC Wild Card implications.

The Chargers are currently the No. 5 seed in the AFC playoff chase as they chase the Denver Broncos (8-2) for the AFC West title, while the Jaguars (5-4) currently hold the No. 7 seed in the AFC playoffs. The Jaguars are two-and-a-half games back of the Indianapolis Colts (8-2) in the AFC South. The Colts have their bye this week.

The Jaguars already have the head-to-head tiebreaker with the Kansas City Chiefs (5-4), who are on the outside looking in through Week 10, and need to collect as many AFC wins as possible to stay in the hunt.

ABOUT LAST WEEK

The Jaguars carried a 29-10 lead into the fourth quarter, only to see it evaporate as the Houston Texans scored 26 unanswered points to rally for the 36-29 win in Week 10. The 19-point blown lead was the largest in franchise history in a loss.

"The reality is we gave up a 19-point lead to lose the game," Coen said after the game. "Part of winning in the National Football League is sustaining a lead. We just needed one stop; didn't get one. Against a tough defense points were hard to come by.

"You score 29, however the points come, you feel like you're going to have a chance to go win; didn't get it done."

The Jaguars built an early 17-0 lead by scoring 10 points off two Texans turnovers on short fields, including a Cam Little field goal and a Trevor Lawrence-to-Parker Washington touchdown connection to open a 10-0 advantage. In the second quarter, Washington returned a punt 72 yards for a touchdown, for the three-possession lead.

In the fourth quarter, the Jaguars offense had three possessions with two three-and-outs and a three-play final drive that ended with a Texans fumble-return touchdown. The Jaguars logged only nine plays for 11 yards and one first down in the final quarter.

"We were down couple lineman at one point," Coen said. "Anton [Jaguars T Anton Harrison] had to come out, Chuma's [Jaguars G Chuma Edoga] in. We had [Jaguars OL] Patrick Mekari coming out, Monheim [Jaguars C Jonah Monehim] is in.

"We just didn't execute extremely well I don't think on that, specifically that one drive backed up kind of when we punted it when we had the sack I believe on the third down. That's the No. 1 defense in the NFL and that's the reality."

Meanwhile the Texans logged 167 yards on 29 offensive plays with 13 first downs in the fourth quarter and scored touchdowns on their final three possessions of the afternoon. The Jaguars defense logged only two sacks and four quarterback hits on the day against a Texans offensive line that had two backups starting in front of backup quarterback Davis Mills.

"I was on the headset hearing him (defensive coordinator Anthony Campanile) call," Coen said. "You're a little susceptible in the back end when you blitz, and when we four-man rush we're not getting home. That's the reality. That's a hard place as any coach to be in. Players as well at times.

"So got to go watch the tape to see exactly every call but I didn't necessarily think we're putting these guys in really bad positions. You're trying to hold onto a lead and make them earn it. We let up too many explosive plays."

In the fourth quarter, the Texans had key plays of 22 yards with 10:04 remaining, a third-and-10 conversion from their own 7-yard line for 20 yards, and then the go-ahead touchdown scored by Mills on a third-and-goal play from the 14-yard line with :37 left.

The Jaguars were also flagged three times in the fourth quarter for critical penalties: an unnecessary roughness on running back Bhayshul Tuten early in the final quarter, a defensive pass interference on cornerback Jarrian Jones with 1:25 remaining and an illegal use of hands call against right tackle Chuma Edogo on the final Jaguars possession that wiped out a completion that could have given kicker Cam Little a chance for a long-range game-winning field goal attempt at the final gun.

One bright spot for the Jaguars: the play of wide receiver Parker Washington, who logged a receiving touchdown and a punt-return score, the third in his career and second of the season.

"We were trying to get him the rock multiple other ways," Coen said. "There was a critical third down earlier in the second half where we had it settle for three points, and he's wide open again. Ball gets batted down. He's wide open. Cooked the dude on a slant.

"He just keeps doing his thing. He's helping us win every week and I appreciate him for that."

After today's home game the Jaguars hit the road the next two weeks with games at the Arizona Cardinals (3-6) and Tennessee Titans (1-8). The Jaguars return to EverBank Stadium Week 14 for a December 7 matchup with the division-leading Indianapolis Colts (8-2), the start of a month with three of five games at home for the Jaguars as they make a playoff push.

Stadium of the Future construction is underway and will be ongoing until its grand opening in August 2028. This year, fans can expect that the in-bowl game experience will remain unchanged, but parking, stadium entry and how you access your seats may look different - even from week to week.

During the 2025 season, it will be important to enter the gate recommended on your ticket for the most direct access to seat locations. This gate may be adjusted during the season based on progress made on the renovation since the previous game. Since the plaza level will no longer allow contiguous travel from gate to gate, the concourse level, accessible by ramps from each gate, will provide a 360-degree path around the stadium and will be the best way to navigate all public areas.

For any wayfinding questions, please find a Guest Experience Representative to assist.

WHEELCHAIR ESCORT

Wheelchair escort service is available at all perimeter gates of the stadium. Please find a Mobility Assistance Representative at most gate entries to request an escort when you arrive. This service will bring guests from the perimeter gate to their seats. Wheelchair escort service will return after the game to pick up guests at their seats and return them to their original perimeter entry gate.

Due to high demand, please note the service may come with a wait time.

Please note that if you need a wheelchair for all movements throughout the stadium, it is advised that you bring a wheelchair for your personal use throughout the entire day and contact the Jaguars ticket office at (904) 633-2000 for accessible seating availability. The Jaguars do not offer storage for personal wheelchairs or other accessibility devices in-stadium. The wheelchair escort service is intended to relieve patrons in need of the initial long entry and exit walks.

JTA GAMEDAY XPRESS

Come ride with JTA and say goodbye to driving and parking hassles. Fans can purchase single-game passes onsite at any Gameday Xpress lot on game days or via the MyJTA mobile app. The app runs on iOS and Android systems and is available on Google Play or the Apple App Store.

To expedite your stadium entry on game day, please make sure to have your game ticket barcode ready to scan before arriving. Email confirmations will not be accepted. You must have your mobile ticket pulled up on your phone with the barcode prior to entering the stadium gate lines.

GEICO has you covered by getting you to the game easier with the new GEICO Game Day Shuttle Program! Available for every home game during the 2025 season at: Lot S, Lot X, Lot Z, and Met Park for ticketed fans only. Pick-up areas are located near each lot entrance. The complimentary shuttle service is available for 3 hours prior to kickoff and 1 hour after the end of each game.

Shuttle operations are temporarily suspended at kickoff and until the conclusion of each game. Post-game pick-up for Lot S, Lot X and Lot Z via the Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Wall. Guests parked in Met Park will be able to access post-game pick-up via Lot D.
