# **SEASON TICKET HOLDER EXPECTATIONS** Green Bay Packers season tickets are intended for the Season Ticket Holders' personal enjoyment and for that individual or their family, friends, and business associates to attend games and support the Packers. If season tickets are repeatedly resold on the secondary market, the Season Ticket Holders' renewal eligibility may be impacted. Packers Season Ticket Holders are expected to adhere to the Fan Code of Conduct whenever they are on Packers/Titletown property. Our Packers Season Ticket Holders and fans consistently make Lambeau Field one of the greatest home-field advantages in all of sports and our team is stronger with those passionate fans in the stands.

# **SEASON TICKET INFORMATION**

#### **Account Holder Definition**

The first line of your account information (as shown on your invoice) denotes the Season Ticket Holder of record. For your protection we will only accept payments, address changes, transfer requests and other inquiries from the Season Ticket Holder, their spouse or Power of Attorney. Accounts listed in the name of a business should provide us with the name of the individual authorized to make such changes and inquiries. Account owners must be 18 years or older.

#### Season Ticket Invoices

Renewal invoices are typically mailed in early March with full payment due at the end of March each year. Payments can be made by logging into your "My Packers Account" or mailing the remittance slip with payment to our office. Checks bearing a name different than the one shown on the first line of the invoice will not be accepted.

#### **Transferring of Packers Season Tickets**

Season ticket account holders may permanently transfer their account(s) to qualifying family members (up to and including first cousin) by completing the Packers official transfer form, which requires a notarized authorization. Should a season ticket account holder wish to transfer the account at the time of death, the account holder may complete the official transfer form and maintain that form with his or her will to be presented after the time of passing. Transfer requests are processed at the end of the football season through May 1. Transfer requests received after May 1 will take effect the following year. While properly—authorized transfer requests are typically honored, the Packers reserve the right to refuse transfer at their sole discretion. The opportunity to renew or transfer season tickets is a privilege granted by the Packers, which may be withdrawn at the sole discretion of the Packers.

## Relinquishment of Season Tickets/Reimbursement of District Userfee

Green and Gold package Season Ticket Holders who choose to relinquish all or a portion of their season tickets must submit their intent to cancel in writing to the Packers Ticket Office on or before the final season ticket payment due date and prior to making payment for the season. Any user fee money paid toward your seats will be refunded to you through the Green Bay/Brown County Professional Football Stadium District when the funds are replenished by new Season Ticket Holders coming off of the waiting list.

For procedures pertaining to suite and club seat multi-year contracts, contact the premium seating staff at **920.569.7260**.

#### **Seat Upgrades**

Green and Gold package holders can apply for a seat change by submitting their request in writing to the Packers Ticket Office where it will remain a permanent record until we are able to fulfill the request. In the event we are able to accommodate your upgrade request, we will contact you for your approval prior to any changes being made. Please bear in mind that the ticket renewal rate at Lambeau Field is close to 100% and the few cancellations we do receive are rarely in prime locations. Seat upgrades are not available on gameday.



#### **Online Account Management**

"My Packers Account" by Ticketmaster® gives you the ability to access your season ticket account online to make payments, edit your contact information, transfer your tickets to a fan via email and post tickets for resale on the NFL Ticket Exchange. To sign in, go to Packers.com, select the tickets tab and choose My Packers Account. Click on Sign In and enter your email address and password.

Please note: To gain online access, the Ticketmaster system requires each individual account to have its own unique email address. It will not accept the same email address on multiple accounts. If you have multiple accounts of the same package (two Green package accounts, for example) we may be able to combine them under one account/email to improve your online experience.

# **MOBILE TICKETING**

Mobile tickets offer a safe, convenient and flexible way to sell, transfer and manage your tickets while improving protection against fraud. Here's what every Season Ticket Holder should know:

- All guests who attend a game at Lambeau Field will need to enter with mobile tickets. Paper tickets will not be issued.
- Ticket holders will manage their tickets through their online "My Packers Account". Within their online accounts, Season Ticket Holders can use the tickets themselves, transfer the tickets to another fan, donate tickets or post tickets for resale.
- Your mobile barcode, which is scanned at the gate for entry, can be found in your "My Packers Account" by downloading the Green Bay Packers mobile app.
- Your mobile tickets can be shown directly from the Packers app or can be downloaded to your phone's digital wallet if your phone allows. Your mobile ticket will show a moving barcode in the Packers app. In your wallet, for security purposes, you will not see a barcode, but rather the words "Hold Near Reader". Tap this to enter the gate.

We recommend having your smartphone ready to scan prior to entering the gate to allow for quicker entry.

- \*Tickets cannot be transferred from your wallet.
- \*Once a ticket has been scanned for entry it can no longer be transferred.
- \*Screenshots of the ticket will not be accepted for entry to the stadium or for navigating throughout the stadium.
- Don't forget to fully charge your phone's battery before coming to the game.
- See back cover for step-by-step instructions to access your tickets.

#### Safeguard your Tickets & Online Account

To ensure the integrity of your tickets and Packers account, be sure to adhere to the following practices:

- > Do not share your "My Packers Account" login information.
- Do not post or distribute screen shots of mobile tickets.
- igwedge Be sure to relay these security reminders to all with whom you share your tickets.
- Activity that has compromised the validity of the barcodes of your tickets will not be tolerated and may be grounds for revocation of season tickets. We highly recommend you have thoroughly reviewed and understand the online resale, transferring and donation procedures before choosing to utilize them and report any error you may encounter to our ticket office as soon as possible.

#### **Ticket Donation Program**

If you are unable to use your tickets, consider a tax-deductible donation to the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Green Bay. This local organization will accept your donated tickets, sell them for no more than face value and use the proceeds to support youth guidance and development programs. Online donations can be made electronically through your "My Packers Account" as long as your donation is made by 5 p.m., three days prior to the game.

To contact the Boy's & Girl's Club, call **920.494.7090**.

Please know that when you donate your tickets to the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Green Bay, your season ticket account is exempt from the policy on unruly fan behavior.

#### Game Scheduling

This season we will host two preseason games and eight regular–season games at Lambeau Field.

The NFL schedule consists of three preseason games and 17 regular–season games. The dates, times and opponents of the games are determined by the NFL in the spring of each year. On the even numbered years, the Packers (and NFC teams) host one preseason game and nine regular–season games, and the Green and Gold ticket packages will alternate having one preseason game or the last regular–season home game. On odd numbered years, the NFC teams host two preseason games and eight regular–season games.

This year the three–game Gold ticket package will consist of the second and fifth regular–season games played at Lambeau Field along with one preseason game. The seven–game Green ticket package will consist of the first, third, fourth, sixth, seventh and eighth regular–season games played at Lambeau Field, along with one preseason game.

#### **NFL Flexible Scheduling**

This season, "flexible scheduling" for Sunday Night Football may be used up to twice between Weeks 5–10, and in the NFL's discretion during Weeks 11–17; for Monday Night Football in the NFL's discretion in Weeks 12–17; and for Thursday Night Football, it may be used up to twice between Weeks 14–16. During these Flex Scheduling Windows, the games initially scheduled for Sunday Night Football (on NBC), Monday Night Football (on ESPN or ABC), and Thursday Night Football (on Amazon Prime Video) are tentatively scheduled and subject to change. Only Sunday afternoon games (or those listed as TBD) are eligible to be moved to Sunday night, Monday night, or Thursday night, in which case the initially scheduled Sunday/Monday night game would be moved to Sunday afternoon. Sunday afternoon games may also be moved between 12:00 p.m. and 3:05 p.m. or 3:25 p.m. CT.

As in prior seasons, for Week 18, the final weekend of the season, the scheduling of the Saturday, Sunday afternoon, and the Sunday night games is not assigned. In Week 18, two games will be played on Saturday (3:30 PM CT and 7:00 PM CT) with the remainder to be played on Sunday afternoon (12:00 PM CT and 3:25 PM CT) and one matchup to be played on Sunday night (7:20 PM CT). Specific dates, start times, and networks for Week 18 matchups will be determined and announced following the conclusion of Week 17.

#### **Playoff Program**

(GREEN AND GOLD TICKET HOLDERS) Green and Gold Season Ticket Holders who are interested in playoff tickets need to take action before mid-August by registering a credit/debit card for the Pay As We Play program. Here are the key highlights both Green and Gold ticket holders should know:

_	
0	Green package holders have first right of refusal on their season seats but must register by mid–August.
0	Gold package holders who also register by mid-August will be placed in a drawing and, if selected, randomly assign seats. Results of the drawing and seat assignment will be sent in September. Gold package holders will receive the same number of playoff tickets as in their account.
0	No money down required. Just register your credit/debit card which will be charged at the time each home playoff game is clinched.
0	The playoffs could consist of three possible home games. Your commitment is for ALL home playoff games.
0	No cancellations once registered.
0	Must register for playoff tickets to be included in the drawing for Super Bowl tickets.
0	Early entry discount for the Wild Card round applies.
0	Cards will be charged within 48 hours of the time home playoff games are clinched.
If you	have not yet registered for 2025, log into your <b>"My Packers Account"</b> by August 8 to sign up.

#### **Super Bowl Tickets**

If it appears possible that the Packers could advance to the Super Bowl, each season ticket account holder who registered for playoff tickets will automatically be entered into a computer-generated drawing, held in mid-January. Selected accounts will have the opportunity to purchase two Super Bowl tickets. Tickets are not available if the Packers are not participating in the game.

#### Season Tickets as Revocable Licenses & Renewal of Season Tickets

Season tickets are revocable licenses that may be revoked, and admission refused, at the sole discretion of the Packers. The Packers reserve the right to refuse admission or eject any person whose conduct the Packers deem to be disorderly or in noncompliance with the rules and regulations as promulgated by the Packers and NFL from time to time. Season tickets are offered on a one-year basis only. The purchase of season tickets does not entitle a Season Ticket Holder to purchase season tickets in any subsequent year. The opportunity to renew season tickets is a privilege granted by the Packers, which may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Packers.

# GAMEDAY INFORMATION

### Lambeau Field Parking

**Season Parking:** All parking spaces in the lots surrounding Lambeau Field are sold out to holders of season parking passes (with the exception of the two accessible lots, noted below). Season parking passes distributed by the Green Bay Packers are offered on a one-year basis only and may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Packers. The purchase of parking passes does not entitle a pass holder to purchase passes in any subsequent year. All parking passes are mobile. Parking lot location may change. Vehicles must fit into a 9x18 foot parking space. Parking permits can only be used to reserve spaces for vehicles, not empty spaces for tailgating. All Lambeau Field lots open four hours prior to kickoff.

Accessible Parking: Two accessible parking areas are available on a first-come, first-served basis on gameday to accommodate fans with disabilities. The appropriate state-issued placard or license plate is required to gain entrance, and a fee of \$50 will be collected at the gate. Enter from Lombardi Avenue on the stadium's north side (Lot 4) or from Valley View Road on the stadium's south side (Lot 7). These lots also open four hours prior to kickoff and tend to fill up quickly. Lambeau Field's payment systems are entirely cashless, including parking.

Overnight parking is not permitted in any Lambeau Field-operated lot. The Fan Code of Conduct (listed on page II) applies within all parking lot boundaries.

#### **Additional Parking Options**

**Street Parking:** Free parking is available on most residential streets in the vicinity of the stadium. Please obey posted signs.

**Privately Run Lots:** Many homeowners, businesses and owners of vacant lots near Lambeau Field offer parking for a fee. Watch for these parking opportunities as you near the stadium on gamedays.

**Parking for Buses and RVs:** Two privately operated lots located east of Lambeau Field offer parking for buses and RVs. The lots are located at 1007 Tony Canadeo Run (920.544.8367) and on the corner of Bart Starr Road and Mike McCarthy Way (920.265.2341 or 920.471.8199).

PMI Parking: PMI offers parking in nearby lots that can be reserved on an individual—game basis. Visit ticketstaronline.com or call 800–895–0071 for more information.

#### Drop-Off Zone

Due to the traffic congestion around the stadium, we suggest dropping off your passengers on the corner of Shadow Lane and Frank Street. There is a convenient sidewalk and police are there to assist you crossing the street into the Lambeau Field parking lot. Please respect any posted time limitations and heed the instructions from officers directing traffic flow in and out of the area. As this area will be very congested in the immediate hours after the game, it will not be designated as a post–game pick up zone. Drivers should arrange to meet their passengers at an alternate location after the game.

#### Rideshare

Fans who have scheduled a rideshare service can meet their driver for departure at Holmgren Way and Mike McCarthy Way just east of Lambeau Field.

#### **Green Bay Metro**

Green Bay Metro offers free bus service on gamedays along specially designed routes through Green Bay and De Pere. The route network includes Austin Straubel Airport, along with many hotel and business districts throughout the metro area. After the game, buses depart at regularly scheduled intervals from Lombardi Avenue near the Bellin Health Gate. Green Bay Metro gameday route schedules are available at the Guest Services Desk in the Atrium.

#### **Shuttle Cart Service**

A limited number of shuttle carts are available in the main Lambeau Field parking lot to aid those who need assistance. Shuttles will pick up guests along the outer perimeter of the lot and drop them off at locations near the stadium gates. Shuttle service is available during the three hours leading up to kickoff, and will resume for 45 minutes immediately after the game. The service may be reduced or canceled should inclement weather present safety concerns. The shuttle cart service is available on a first-come, first-served basis and is a complimentary service offered by the Green Bay Packers.



#### **Tailgating**

If tailgating in a Lambeau Field-operated lot, your tailgating setup must be contained within the 9x6 foot space directly behind your parked vehicle to allow adequate room for vehicular and pedestrian traffic. No recreational (i.e. wood) fires are allowed, nor are turkey fryers. Grill cooking with charcoal or propane gas is permitted. Grills must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult and be fully extinguished before being left unattended. Separate containers are available in the lots for hot coals, recyclable items and trash. The Fan Code of Conduct (see page 11) applies to all individuals tailgating in any Lambeau Field parking lot. Tailgating setup must be broken down before leaving your vehicle. Tailgating ends at kickoff in all stadium controlled lots.

#### Stadium Gates

All stadium gates open two hours prior to kickoff and all are accessible to fans with disabilities.

To ensure the most direct route to your seat, please enter through the gate indicated on your mobile ticket.

Fans with seats in the South End (sections ending with the letter "s") are especially encouraged to enter through the Invisalign Gate on the south side of the stadium, which offers direct escalator and elevator access to the South End seating areas.

#### Atrium Gameday Hours & Exit/Re-Entry Policy

On gamedays, the Lambeau Field Atrium (and all businesses therein) is only open to ticketed guests until 45 minutes after the game, at which time non-ticketed guests are allowed access.

#### Carry-In & Fan Safety Policy

The following policies may be modified in the event of elevated health and safety conditions. Please visit Packers.com/gameday for the most up-to-date information.

Police officers are stationed at each entrance gate and throughout the stadium to ensure your safety while visiting Lambeau Field. Walk-through metal detectors are utilized at every gate. You and your belongings may also be physically searched, as deemed necessary. By tendering your ticket and entering the stadium, you consent to such searches and waive any related claims that you might have against the NFL, its member clubs, their affiliates and stadium landlords, or their agents. If you elect not to consent to being searched, you will be denied entry.

Please be aware that carry-in policies may be modified from game to game as health and safety levels change, and items permitted into the stadium are ultimately determined at the discretion of each officer. Firearms, knives, switchblades and other weapons are strictly prohibited. Bags, backpacks, duffel bags, large purses, fanny packs and coolers will not be allowed. Additional banned items include food and beverages, strollers, umbrellas, obstructive banners/signs, noisemakers, selfie sticks, video cameras and still photo cameras with lenses over 12 inches. As a general rule, please leave all unnecessary items at home.

#### Will Call & Ticket Issues

Will Call is distributed at the main ticket office, located on the northeast side of the stadium, adjacent to the Miller Lite Gate. Ticket-related issues can also be addressed at the main ticket office, as well as at the auxiliary ticket office located on the south side of the stadium, adjacent to the Invisalign Gate. The auxiliary ticket office is open two hours before game time and closes at kickoff. The main ticket office closes at halftime.

#### **Guest Services & Lambeau Field Staff**

Guest Services can be found in the following locations: Lambeau Field Atrium Guest Services Desk, Section 109 in the main concourse, Section 353 in the upper concourse and at concierge desks located on the club and suite levels. You will also find Lambeau Field staff wearing red vests/jackets stationed throughout the stadium.

#### Ramps, Elevators & Escalators

Lambeau Field has a network of ramps, elevators and escalators to assist fans in accessing the various areas and levels within the stadium. If you are unsure of the best way to get to your section, please ask a Lambeau Field staff member wearing a red vest/jacket, stationed throughout the stadium concourse. The Packers encourage all of our fans to give priority to those with mobility or other accessibility needs when using elevators.

#### Small Children Policy

All individuals, regardless of age (babies included), must have a ticket to enter Lambeau Field.

#### First Aid & Police Assistance

Emergency first aid and police assistance are on call in the stadium at all times. If you require medical or police assistance, contact the nearest security personnel, call the stadium security office at 920.569.7400 or dial 911. First Aid Stations are located underneath Section 133 in the main concourse, near Section 330 in the upper concourse and on Level 4 in the Invisalign Gate lobby.

#### **Emergency Evacuation**

In the unlikely event an emergency situation would require the stadium to be evacuated, instructions will be relayed via the public address system. If such circumstances arise, please remain calm and follow instructions as they are given.

#### Seat Back Rental

Guests with seats in bleacher sections (sections 100–138 and 300–354) may want to rent a seat back. Rentals are available on a first-come, first-served basis at each of the gates that serve the bleacher areas of the stadium.

#### **Fan Code of Conduct**

The Green Bay Packers are committed to providing a safe and enjoyable experience on gameday and every day. Irresponsible conduct will not be tolerated at Lambeau Field, at Titletown or in the parking lots or surrounding campus. In some cases, such conduct may result in ejection from the stadium and Packers/Titletown property and/or arrest. The following will not be tolerated at Lambeau Field, Packers Training Camp, Titletown or any other facility operated by the Green Bay Packers:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal.
- Foul, abusive or obscene gestures, language or clothing, including but not limited to the use of language or gestures concerning a person's race, ethnicity, color, gender, religion, creed, disability, age, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression or national origin; or language or gestures intended to instigate, incite or encourage a confrontation or physical assault.
- Wearing obscene or indecent clothing or displaying obscene or indecent signs.
- > Verbal or physical harassment of other fans or stadium personnel.
- Interference with the purpose of the game (including throwing objects onto the field).

- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol impairment that result in irresponsible behavior.
- Failing to follow instructions of Packers staff and stadium personnel.
- Smoking and electronic cigarettes: Lambeau Field is a smoke-free facility (Smoking in parking lots is allowed).
- Any other conduct deemed to be beyond the bounds of reason.
- While standing and cheering is permitted, please keep in mind that continued standing can interfere with others' ability to enjoy the game or event from their seats. To be courteous to all guests in attendance, we ask fans to stand and cheer when appropriate with the flow of the game or event.

Violations of the above policy may result in permanent revocation of season tickets, regardless of whether or not violators using the tickets are the Season Ticket Holders of record. The version of the Fan Code of Conduct posted on packers.com is always the most current and always governs, regardless of what may be printed on paper or on a sign.

#### **Lost Person Prevention Program**

In an effort to prevent or reduce the chances of a lost child (or person of any age), we offer a Lost Person Prevention program. Upon registration, a coded wristband will be issued. Guests with tickets in the general bowl may register with Guest Services in the Atrium, Guest Services in section 109 (level 1 concourse) and Guest Services in section 353 (level 3 concourse). Suite and club guests may register at the concierge desks.

#### **Designated Driver Program**

Responsible consumption of alcohol is a priority of the Green Bay Packers, Molson Coors, Coca-Cola and Nicolet Water. Therefore we have implemented a Designated Driver program to offer sensible alternatives and educate our guests about the dangers of drinking and driving. Guests may register online via the Packers app or by scanning the QR code displayed at the Atrium Guest Services Desk and at the concierge desks on the club and suite levels. Guests will have the opportunity to win an autographed item and are automatically entered into the Responsibility Has Its Rewards Sweepstakes for a chance to win a trip to the Pro Bowl – sponsored by the NFL and TEAM Coalition. Sign up for the designated driver program ends at the end of the first quarter.

#### **Gameday Sobriety Support Station**

A sobriety support station is located on the level 1 main course near the Kwik Trip Gate, across from section 112. Section Yellow is a group of Packers fans who choose to remain drug and alcohol free. Their simple purpose is to provide fellowship, support and information to those who seek the comfort and camaraderie of other clean and sober people attending the game.

#### **Alcohol**

Alcohol cannot be brought into or out of the stadium. The sale of alcohol is limited to two per customer per purchase, with all sales ceasing at the end of the third quarter. Any person purchasing alcohol who appears to be less than 40 years of age must present a valid I.D. The Packers and Lambeau Field vendors reserve the right to refuse the sale of alcohol. No alcohol will be sold to intoxicated guests.

#### **Smoking**

Lambeau Field is a smoke-free facility as required by Wisconsin state law. This includes the Lambeau Field Atrium, 1919 Kitchen & Tap, stadium bowl and concourses. There are no designated smoking areas inside Lambeau Field, nor is exit and re-entry permitted for smoking. Smokeless and electronic cigarettes are also not permitted. Guests who fail to comply with this policy may be ejected and/or subject to fines.

#### Restroom/Family Restrooms

Restrooms are conveniently located on all levels of the stadium and all are accessible for people with disabilities. In addition, family restrooms can be found on the main level of the Atrium, near Sections 109 and 134 in the main concourse, near Section 109 in the upper concourse, near Section 431 on the Associated Bank Club Level, Premium Levels, Suites and Indoor clubs and on every level in the South End. An adjustable electric changing table for adults/larger children is available inside the family restroom located on level 1 of the Atrium.

#### **Nursing Rooms**

Nursing rooms, designed for comfort and privacy, are located on the main level of the Atrium and on the fourth floor club level near Suite 4003 for premium guests. In addition, the family restrooms mentioned in the previous paragraph can serve as an alternate location for nursing mothers and guests with special needs. Electrical outlets and chairs are provided.

#### **Charging Stations**

Mobile charging stations are located in the Atrium behind the elevators and inside the Johnsonville Tailgate Village. Multiple charging stations are also available in the Verizon Loft on level 3 of the Atrium.

#### **Cashless Payment**

Lambeau Field's payment systems are entirely cashless throughout the stadium on gamedays and non-gamedays. This includes food and beverage stands, the Packers Pro Shop, the Ticket Office, 1919 Kitchen and Tap, the Packers Hall of Fame and Stadium Tours and other points of sale throughout the building.

All Packers-operated businesses at Titletown are cashless. Please check with individual private businesses at Titletown including Lodge Kohler, Hinterland and BelAir Cantina to see whether they accept cash.

Cashless transactions allow for increased efficiency and transactions speeds and shorter lines at Lambeau Field's point-of-sale systems. Renovations to the concourses and concession stands are all aimed at enhancing the Lambeau Field fan experience.

Mastercard is the Official Card of the Green Bay Packers and Lambeau Field. All major credit and debit cards, as well as mobile pay, are accepted throughout Lambeau Field. Checks are not accepted.

Those who do not use credit or bank cards may use free cash-to-card conversion stations, which issue payment cards that can be used at Lambeau Field, as well as at other retailers, restaurants and businesses outside the stadium where Mastercard is accepted. Fans can load between \$5 and \$500 on the cards and funds will be available to users for five years from the last date money was loaded on the card. Conversion stations will be available at various locations at Lambeau Field and Titletown on gamedays and in the Atrium on nongamedays.

#### **ATMs**

Associated Bank ATMs can be found in the following locations: inside the Lambeau Field Atrium (Levels 1, 3 & 4), in the indoor club seat areas near the Bellin Health Gate lobby (Level 4), in the Invisalign Gate lobby (Levels 4 & 7), in the main concourse underneath Section 118 and near the American Family Insurance Gate.

#### Lost & Found

Lost and found items can be reported to Guest Services at the following locations: Lambeau Field Atrium Guest Services Desk, underneath Section 109 in the main concourse, underneath Section 353 in the upper concourse, at the concierge desks located on the club and suite levels.

# 2025-2026 TICKET TERMS & CONDITIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THESE TERMS CONTAIN ARBITRATION AND CLASS ACTION WAIVER PROVISIONS THAT IMPACT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS.

Tickets to Green Bay Packers games at Lambeau Field are revocable licenses that only grant a one-time entry into the stadium and a seat, or if specified on the ticket, a standing location, for the specified game (the "Event") with no right of re-entry. The purchaser and/or bearer of tickets to the Event, and any individual seeking entry to the Event through the use of a hicket, including minors and all other attendees accompanying any ticket bearer (on whose behalf the purchaser and/or bearer represents they are authorized to act for purposes of agreeing to these terms) (each of the foregoing hereinafter a "Holder"), agree that (i) such license is subject to these terms ("Terms"), and (ii) by purchase acceptance and/or use of such license, each Holder is deemed to have read and understood the Terms, and agreed to be bound by them. Failure to comply with the Terms shall result in foreiture of the license and all rights arising under it without refund and entitle the Green Bay Packers and/or, if applicable, the Green Bay Packers (individually or collectively. "Management") to pursue all legal remedies available. Admission may be refused or revoked and Holder may be ejected in Management's sole discretion. All guests, regardless of age, need a ticket to gain entrance. Holders who choose to exit the stadium will not be allowed to reenter. Smoking is not allowed.

ALL TICKET SALES ARE FINAL. NO REFUNDS OR EXCHANGES EXCEPT AS PROVIDED HEREIN. THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY if admission is refused or revoked, stadium capacity limitations result in ticket cancellation, or the Event is canceled and not rescheduled for any reason, or for any breach of the Terms, is a refund of up to the ticket price set by Management ("Face Value"). In No Event shall holder be entitled to any special, consequential, inclobing. Not hold that the ticket price set by Management ("Face Value"). In No Event shall holder be entitled to any special, any amount paid in excess of face value for the ticket.

ANY DISPUTE, CLAIM. OR CAUSE OF ACTION IN ANY WAY RELATED TO THE TICKET OR THE EVENT SHALL BE RESOLVED BY MANDATORY. CONFIDENTIAL, FINAL, AND BINDING ARBITRATION IN GREEN BAY, WISCONSIN REDADLESS OF WHERE HOLDER RESIDES OR FROM WHERE THE TICKET WITH WHICH HOLDER SEEKS ADMISSION WAS PROPERTASED. HOLDER AND MANAGEMENT AGREE THAT ALL DISPUTES SHALL BE ARBITRATED ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS. HOLDER UNDERSTANDS. ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT THEY ARE WAIVING THEIR RIGHT TO A COURT OR JURY TRIAL AND ANY RIGHT TO LITIGATE OR ARBITRATE ANY CLAIM AS A CLASS ACTION. REPRESENTATIVE ACTION. OR CLASS ARBITRATION. IF HOLDER DOES NOT CONSENT TO THIS CLAUSE, HOLDER MUST LEAVE OR NOT ENTER THE STADIUM. THIS CLAUSE IS GOVERNED BY THE FEDERAL ARBITRATION ACT.

The Event date and time (and gate opening) are subject to change at Management's sole discretion, and no such change shall entitle Holder to a refund or other remedy at law or in equity if Holder cannot attend or for any other reason. Please also be aware that there are certain games scheduled during the NFL's flexible scheduling window for which the date and time of the games may be changed from what is originally reflected on the schedule and what may appear on the lickel. For more information about NFL flexible scheduling procedures for the 2025 NFL Season, please visit https://www.nfl.com/schedules/flexible-scheduling-procedures. Holder may also be relocated in Management's sole discretion, and no such relocation shall entitle Holder to a refund or other remedy if Holder is relocated to a seat of commarable face Value.

Holder must comply with all Event policies including without limitation policies addressing security and fan conduct, health and safety, and bags. Holder and Holder's belongings may be searched or assessed. Prohibited items may be confiscated and Holder's admission may be denied or revoked at Management's sole discretion. Holder consents such searches and assessments and waives all related claims. Unauthorized entry into the field of play or other restricted areas, interfering with the progress of any game or event, attempting any physical contact with an event participant, and/or any other disorderly conduct deemed dangerous, inappropriate, or in violation of the stadium code of conduct or any other relevant security policies is strictly prohibited Violators will be removed from the stadium and subject to arrest and prosecution, forfeiture of ticket privileges, and other penalties including up to a lifetime ban. Violators may also be subject to civil penalties and/or fines, as well as financial liability for any damages, costs or injuries incurred as a result of such unauthorized entry or interference. Such conduct constitutes a serious breach of the Green Bay Packers' safety and security protocols, and violators assume any and all risks associated therewith, including the risk of personal injury (including death), and the risk of loss or damage to personal property.

Holder agrees not to create, transmit, display, distribute, exploit, misappropriate or sell [or aid in such activity] [1] in any form, any description or account [whether text, data or visual, and including, without limitation, play-by-play data] of the Event or related events (collectively, "Descriptive Data"] for any commercial or non-personal, purpose; [2] any images, videos, audio or other form of display or public performance or reproduction of any portion of the Event or related events ("Works") for any commercial or non-personal purpose; or [3] livestreams of any portion of the Event or related events ("Livestreams"). Notwithstanding the foregoing, Holder agrees that by causing their ticket to be

scanned upon entry to the Event. Holder shall be deemed to have signed the ticket and granted the NFL an exclusive worldwide. Irrevocable, perpetual, sub-licensable, royalty-free licenses to all rights associated with any Works. Livestreams, and Descriptive Data. Any collection, use, and/or disclosure of Holder data in connection with Holder's use of the ticket license, attendance at the Event, or use of the websites, mobile applications, and other online or offline services of the NFL or the Green Bay Packers, including without limitation use of the stadium Wi-Finetwork, (the "Services"), are subject to the Green Bay Packers Privacy Policy located at https://www.packers.com/fans/privacy-policy, which provides greater detail on how Holder personal information may be used and how to exercise any rights Holder might have under applicable law. By using the Services, Holder acknowledges that they have read and understood the terms of the Green Bay Packers' Privacy Policy.

HOLDER KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUMES ALL RISKS. HAZARDS AND DANGERS incident to the Event and related events, including the risk of personal injury (including death), exposure to communicable diseases, viruses, bacteria or illnesses (including, e.g., COVID-19), or the causes thereof, or lost, stolen or damaged property, whether occurring before, during, or after the Event, however caused, and hereby waives all claims and potential claims relating to such risks, hazards and dangers.

RELEASE. WAIVER & COVENANT NOT TO SUE. Management is not responsible for lost, stolen, destroyed, duplicated or counterfeit tickets and may refuse to honor them. Tickets may not be used for, or in connection with, any form of commercial purposes including, without limitation, advertising, promotions, contests, sweepstakes, giveaways, gambling or gaming, without the express written consent of the Green Bay Packers and NFL. Use of tickets in violation of law is strictly prohibited and will result in seizure, revocation and/or forfeiture of the license without refund.
