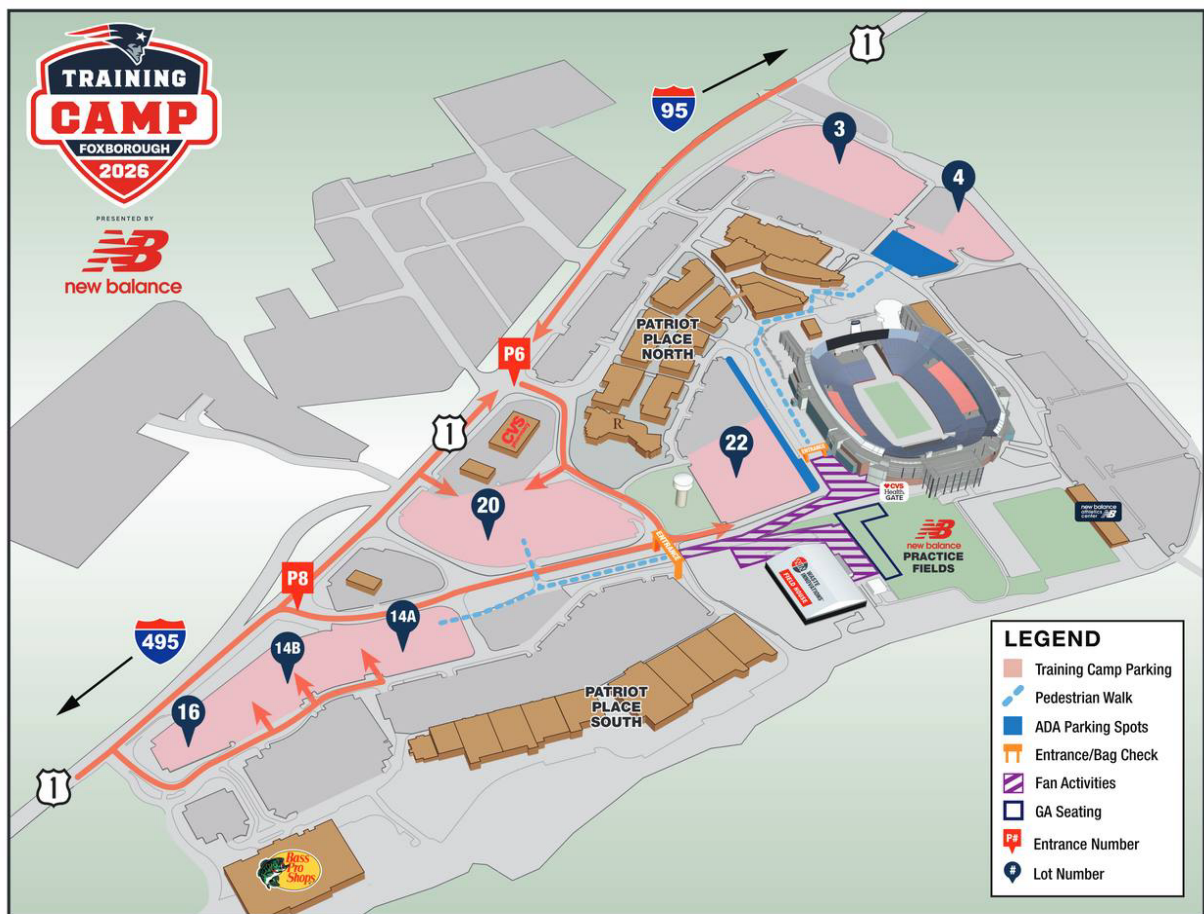


## **FAQ on Pet Adoption**

- **What time on July 25 should I be there?**
  - Training Camp is open to the public at 9:15 a.m. on Saturday, July 25, 2026.  
You will be able to meet the dogs and adopt from 10 a.m. until 12 p.m.
- **Where will the adoption area be?**
  - The adoption area will be next to the Training Camp fields near the CVS plaza right outside of the stadium and adjacent to the security gates where fans enter and exit Training Camp. See photo below for the activity map.
- **Where do I park?**
  - Parking is available in any of the lots see in the map.



- **What type of dogs will be there? Are they puppies?**
  - There will be both puppies and adult dogs at the event of various breeds, ages and sizes.
- **What do I need to bring if I want to adopt a dog?**

- An adoption contract will need to be filled out and signed by someone over 18 years of age. MA residents will be able to complete same day adoptions. Out-of-state adopters may be unable to complete a same day adoption based on their state of residence requirements.
- **How many dogs will there be?**
  - There will be 40-45 dogs on-site for adoption.
- **How much does it cost?**
  - Fees for adopting a dog vary based on the shelter. - **Will the dogs already have all their shots and papers?**
  - Dogs will have their required vaccinations completed, and spay/neuter, and the adoption paperwork will include their medical records.
