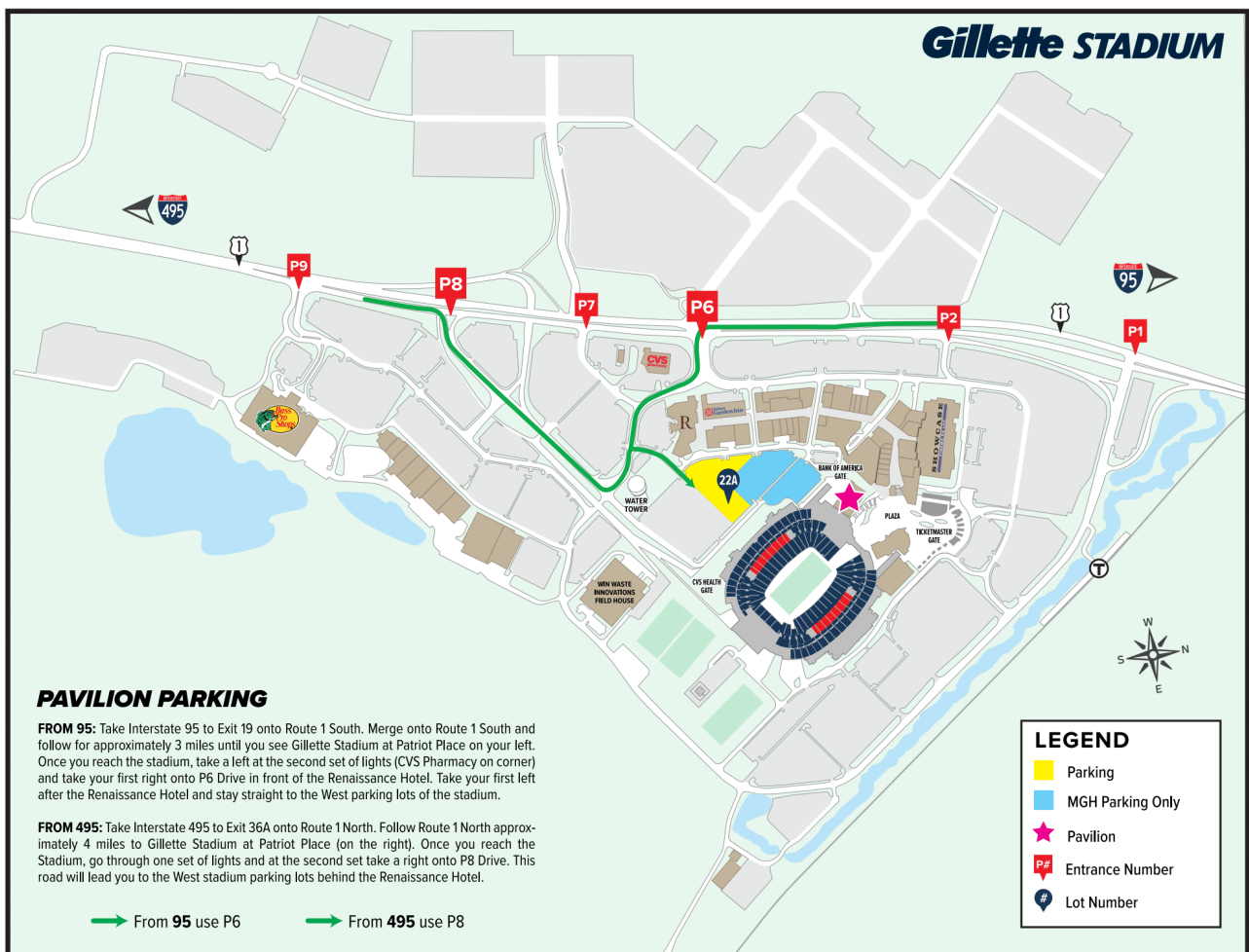


## FAQ on Pet Adoption

- **What time on April 25 should I be there?**
  - Sports Illustrated Pavilion opens to the public at 12 p.m. on Saturday, April 25, 2026. You will be able to meet the dogs and adopt from 12 p.m. until 3 p.m.
- **Where will the adoption area be?**
  - The adoption area will be inside the Sports Illustrated Pavilion following the entrance closest to the stadium. See photo below for the activity map.
- **Where do I park?**
  - Please park in Lot 22.



- **What type of dogs will be there? Are they puppies?**
  - There will be both puppies and adult dogs at the event of various breeds, ages and sizes.

- **What do I need to bring if I want to adopt a dog?**
  - An adoption contract will need to be filled out and signed by someone over 18 years of age. MA residents will be able to complete same day adoptions. Out-of-state adopters may be unable to complete a same day adoption based on their state of residence requirements.
- **How many dogs will there be?**
  - There will be more than 30 puppies and dogs on-site for adoption.
- **How much does it cost?**
  - Fees for adopting a dog vary based on the shelter. See pricing information for the [Animal Rescue League of Boston](#), [Baypath Humane Society of Hopkinton](#), [Potter League of Rhode Island](#), [Second Chance Animal Services](#), and [Vintage Pet Rescue](#).
- **Will the dogs already have all their shots and papers?**
  - Dogs will have their required vaccinations completed, and spay/neuter, and the adoption paperwork will include their medical records.
