Raiders 21, Seahawks 23

- The Raiders dropped their second home game of the preseason by a score of 21-23, bringing their preseason record to 1-3.
- The Seahawks' victory is their second consecutive preseason win over the Raiders and their fifth in the last six years with the lone loss in that span coming in 2014.
- The Raiders' loss gives the Seahawks a seven-game advantage in the preseason series as they now trail 11-4 in the all-time series.

RB George Atkinson III

- **RB George Atkinson III** returned an 82-yard kickoff up the right side of the field for a touchdown with just 1:01 left in the game to cut the Seahawks' lead to two points.
- Prior to Atkinson's big return, he rushed for a 1-yard touchdown, which finished off a seven-play 65-yard drive from **QB Connor Cook**.
- Atkinson finished the night with seven carries for game-high 56 yards with one rushing touchdown, adding two catches for five yards.

RB DeAndré Washington

- **RB DeAndré Washington** made his first preseason start for the Raiders, finishing the night with 11 carries for 14 yards and four catches for 39 yards (9.8 avg.).
- Washington's 32 receiving yards on three catches led both teams in the first half.

QB Connor Cook

- In his first game with extended playing time, **QB Connor Cook** led the Raiders down the field on a 10-play, 34-yard drive lasting 5:10 and culminated in a 27-yard field goal by **K Sebastian Janikowski** in the third quarter.
- The field goal was the Raiders' first offensive points scored in the game and gave the team a 5-0 lead with 7:47 remaining in the third quarter.
- Late in the fourth quarter, Cook orchestrated a 7-play, 65-yard drive lasting 2:57 that culminated in a touchdown on a one-yard rush from **RB George Atkinson III**. The drive was highlighted by a 33-yard pass to **WR Jaydon Mickens**.

September 1, 2016

- Cook, who entered the game in the second quarter, finished the night with 145 yards on 15-of-30 passing with one interception.

RB Jalen Richard

- After the Raiders forced a three-and-out on the opening drive of the third quarter, **RB Jalen Richard** returned a punt for 25 yards, the longest punt return of the 2016 preseason for the Raiders.
- Richard's preseason-long return culminated in the first offensive points of the game, a 27-yard field goal by **K Sebastian Janikowski**.

WR K.J. Brent

- **WR K.J. Brent** was the Raiders' top receiver, recording a game-high 59 yards on four catches (14.8 avg.) with a long of 19 yards.
- With the exception of an 11-yard catch at the beginning of the second quarter, all of Brent's receptions came in the second half of play.

First Safety of the Preseason

- QB Trevone Boykin dropped back into the end zone where he was forced back to his left by **DT Jihad Ward** and then brought to the ground by **DE James Cowser** after intentionally grounding the ball, resulting in the first safety of the preseason for the Raiders defense.
- The Raiders safety were the only points scored amongst both teams in the first half of play.

DL Denico Autry

- On the Seahawks second offensive series, **DL Denico Autry** helped bring the drive to an abrupt stop by taking down RB Thomas Rawls on first down for a 1-yard loss and batting the ball down at the line on third down to force a punt.
- Autry recorded his first sack of the preseason with 10:56 left in the first half as he took down QB Trevone Boykin for a loss of four yards.
- Autry's six tackles tied for the team lead with **LB Korey Toomer**. Both Autry and Toomer recorded five of their six tackles in the first half of the game.

LB Shilique Calhoun

- In his first action as a preseason starter, **LB Shilique Calhoun** amassed three tackles, including a 7-yard sack,
- His sack gave the Raiders back-to-back sacks following **DL Denico Autry's** 4-yard sack the previous play, eventually forcing the Seahawks' fourth punt of the opening half.
- Calhoun's sack was his team-leading second of the preseason.

DT Derrick Lott

- The lone turnover forced by the Raiders' defense came in the fourth quarter when **DT Derrick Lott** recovered a fumble for no gain.

P Marquette King

- **P Marquette King** had one of his best outings of the preseason, turning in eight punts for 391 yards (48.9 yard avg.). Among his eight punts, five were pinned inside the opponent's' 20-yard line.
