Head Coach Jon Gruden

Q: Is there any adjustment you make with an early start to the game on Sunday?

Coach Gruden: "Just leaving on Friday. Get down there, get them acclimated the best we can. All you can do."

Q: What have you seen out of Minkah Fitzpatrick?

Coach Gruden: "Good player, yeah. Good player. He's a great slot corner. That's particularly where he's at his best. I've seen him outside, inside, the safety at Alabama. We loved him. [Defensive backs coach Derrick] Ansley has coached him, loves him. He's a real problem for us in the slot."

Q: What have you seen from Marshawn Lynch in the first two games?

Coach Gruden: "He was running the ball good against two really good opponents. We had a long run called back. The stat sheet might be different. We had a holding call. There's always room for improvement."

Q: What's it going to take to get Jordy Nelson going?

Coach Gruden: "I don't know. We're trying to get everybody going. We have a lot of other receivers who are good players. We're trying to win a game."

Q: How is P.J. Hall's progress? Do you think he could play Week 4?

Coach Gruden: "I don't know. I think he's working hard to get it right. Hopefully we have him for next week. We miss him."
