Consent for Biometric Authentication

To participate in the NFL Credential Card Program, you are consenting to the collection, use, retention, and disclosure of biometric data by and among members of the NFL Family and their credentialing vendors, including Accredit Solutions Inc. and Wicket, LLC.

- Members of the NFL Family may designate certain access zones for biometric authentication, including locker rooms, fields, press boxes, and other areas where sensitive Game Day activities occur or as determined by such member ("Game Day Access Zones"). For information about potential alternatives to biometric authentication, please contact the relevant member of the NFL Family whose stadiums or events you are seeking to access.
- Members of the NFL Family and their credentialing vendors use software to analyze images of you and your facial geometry, including for photos of you that you or an <u>Organizational Admin User</u> submit to the credentialing platform and photos of you captured when you seek to access a Game Day Access Zone or use biometric authentication.
- The credentialing platform may use software to analyze all images that are submitted, even if you initially seek a credential to access a <u>Designated Area</u> other than a Game Day Access Zone. This enables members of the NFL Family and their credentialing vendors to verify the quality and usability of any submitted photo for biometric authentication purposes and to facilitate potential future access to Game Day Access Zones. It also is done for security and safety-related purposes.

To protect your confidentiality, access to and disclosure of your biometric data will be limited to select members of the NFL Family and their credentialing vendors. Except where a shorter period is required by law, measurements of your facial features or geometry will be treated as biometric data and generally will be retained for so long as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out above, including for the NFL Family's ongoing security purposes, or three years following your last interaction with the NFL Credential Card Program. Devices (e.g., scanners, tablets, etc.) used to facilitate biometric authentication typically are not configured to retain biometric data locally. You may have the right under applicable law to request deletion of your biometric data, which you can exercise by contacting nflcredentialing@nfl.com. Such rights are not absolute, and, for example, are subject to the NFL Family's right to continue to retain data for an ongoing security purpose where permitted by applicable law.
