## LEADERSHIP & OPERATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

**Green Building & Certification:** Undergoing LEED Gold recertification.

**Green Team:** Multi-stakeholder committee (MSA, ABM, Levy, RTS, Reduction In Motion) expanding stadium-wide initiatives.

**“Trash Talk” Training:** Pre-season and event-specific education to ensure proper waste separation by all staff and culinary partners.

**Local Impact:** Partnered with the Mayor’s Office of African American Male Engagement (MOAAME) to engage local youth in zero-waste tailgating.

**Advanced Composting:** Increased service frequency by 334% via Veteran Compost.

**Gameday Efficiency:** Second season of 10-hour hand-sorting operations to maximize landfill diversion.



## POWER & OPERATIONS



**Solar Power** | 435,000 kWh generated annually - enough to power 50 homes and avoid 309 tons of CO<sub>2</sub>.



**LED Efficiency** | Majority of stadium lighting (sports, concourse, offices) converted to LED.



**EV Charging** | 14 charging stations available for fans and staff.



**Green Cleaning** | 100% LEED-certified cleaning products used stadium-wide.

## DIVERSION & CIRCULARITY



**Construction** | 91.5% diversion rate (358.7 tons) for C&D waste.



**Recycling** | 103.6 tons of cardboard and mixed recyclables processed.



**Seat Pilot** | Broken plastic seats recycled into “Resin8” concrete for future construction projects.

## SUSTAINABLE SOURCING



**Local Seafood** | 65% of all seafood sourced directly from the Chesapeake Bay.



**Local Produce** | 38% of produce grown within a 200-mile radius.

## WASTE REDUCTION & RECOVERY



**Water Stations** | 33,000+ single-use bottles avoided since 2024.



**Beverage Recovery** | 1,622 containers captured via Reverse Distribution.



**Composting** | 74.8 tons of food scraps diverted from kitchens, suites, and hospitality areas.

## GAMEDAY HAND-SORTING



**The Operation** | 48.73 tons of bagged waste hand-sorted during 10-hour gameday shifts.



**The Result** | Achieved a 53% diversion rate by separating compost, recycling, and cardboard from trash.
