— COLLEGE —

- The Big South Offensive Player of the Year in 2019, Bahar played in 48 games (41 starts) over his four-year career (2016-19) for the Hawks, finishing with a 28-12 career record as a starter... Completed 798-of-1,290 passes for 9,642 yards, 70 TDs and 34 INTs, adding 333 rushing yards and 11 TDs... Set all but one career passing record at Monmouth, including passing touchdowns (70), completions (798), attempts (1,290), yardage (9,642), 300-yard games (9), 200-yard games (20) and career total offense (9,975)... Started the second-most games by a quarterback in school history (41)... Finished eighth in the Walter Payton Award voting as a senior... Became the first Monmouth QB to win a playoff game, after guiding the Hawks to a 44-27 victory against Holy Cross in the first-round of the 2019 FCS playoffs... Invited to play in the 2020 Hula Bowl following the 2019 season... Entire 2020 football season was postponed due to COVID-19
- As a redshirt senior in 2019, started all 14 games (11-3 record)... Was named third-team All-American by Hero Sports, first-team All-Big South and first-team All-ECAC... Threw for 3,684 yards and 30 TDs, both single-season school records, on 289-of-448 passes and completed a career-high 64.5% of his attempts... Produced a career high in completion percentage (75.0) after connecting on 27-of-36 throws for 319 yards and tied a career high with 5 TDs vs. North Alabama
- In 2018 as a redshirt junior, started all 11 games (8-3 record)... Completed 207-of-345 attempts for 2,626 yards, 20 TDs and 6 INTs... Named Offensive Big South Player of the Week and FCS National Player of the Week Honorable Mention after throwing for 334 yards and completing a season-best 70% of his passes (28-of-40) and 1 TD, adding 5 rushes for 47 yards in the game at Lafayette... Registered a career-high 407 yards and 5 TDs on 20-of-30 attempts (66.7%) at Gardner-Webb
- Started all 12 games (9-3 record) in 2017, helping guide the Hawks to their first playoff appearance, with a first-round matchup in the FCS playoffs against Northern Iowa, and the most wins since the 2006 season... Produced 2,368 yards on 205-of-331 completions, 16 TDs and 13 INTs... His 197.3 yards per game average ranked second among Big South QBs... Finished with a 130.1 pass efficiency rating, ranking as the second-highest mark in the conference... Named Big South Offensive Player of the Week after passing for 324 yards on 23-of-31 attempts (74.2) and 3 TDs at Holy Cross
- During his true sophomore campaign in 2016, appeared in all 11 games (three starts), including nine at QB... Recorded 964 passing yards on 97-of-166 attempts, 4 TDs and 6 INTs... Started the final three games of the season, with his first-career start coming against Kennesaw State
- Did not see time as a true freshman in 2015
- Majored in business management at Monmouth University

- Prepped at Calvert Hall College (Towson, MD) HS, where he was a two-year starter at QB... Named MIAA-A All-Conference after throwing for 1,900 yards and 18 TDs and completing 68.2% of his passes as a senior in 2014... Named MVP of the annual "Turkey Bowl" vs. Loyola
- Also played varsity basketball for the Cardinals as a junior (2013)
