


PRESEASON KICKOFF

2023 Signature Project

On Friday, May 19, the Baltimore Ravens hosted an organization-wide volunteer day to build a state-of-the-art playground and provide significant upgrades at Morrell Park Elementary/Middle School and Recreation Center in Baltimore City. The construction and renovation project marks a \$200,000 community investment fully funded by the Ravens Foundation, Inc., in partnership with KABOOM!, Heart of America, Baltimore City Public Schools and Baltimore City Recreation and Parks. Ravens executives, including team president Sashi Brown, along with players, the entire rookie class, and staff, comprise the nearly 175 volunteers to participate in the annual "signature project".
