PLAY 60 GRANT

The Ravens Foundation, Inc. recently awarded \$100,000 in grants to 26 nonprofit organizations around the Baltimore area. Providing up to \$5,000 in financial support to each nonprofit, the Ravens' Play 60 Grant continues to provide for both new and expanding programs that promote physical fitness and/or nutrition education among youth. Since 2006, the Ravens Foundation, Inc. has provided over \$1.2 million towards supporting the fitness and education of youth around the Baltimore area. This year, the Play 60 Grant helped fund a multitude of projects, including interscholastic athletic programs for students with disabilities, like the Maryland School for the Blind (pictured below), running clubs, boxing training and afterschool mentorship programs. 2018 RAVENS SCHOLARS
