## **RAVENS IN OUR COMMUNITY**



Prior to the Ravens vs. Saints game on Sept. 1, Ravens **RB Justin Forsett** (pictured below) traveled to the city of Baton Rouge, La. The town had recently been devastated by a massive flood, damaging 60,000 homes and leaving residents with no place to go. Forsett teamed up with the Capital Area United Way and the Salvation Army to assist families who had lost everything in the disaster. He not only invested his time, but also donated \$7,500 to help rebuild the city. This year the Purple Friday visit reached more than 2,200 students and 200 staff.
