SAINTS AT PANTHERS

- Carolina will play host to the New Orleans Saints for a Week 2 matchup at Bank of America Stadium.
- The Panthers are coming off a season opening victory against the New York Jets by a score of 19-14. It marked the first Week 1 win for Carolina since 2018. Carolina has not started a season 2-0 since 2017.
- New Orleans won its Week 1 matchup with the Green Bay Packers in a home game played in Jacksonville, Fla. The Saints defeated the Packers 38-3.
- This week will mark the first NFC South divisional matchup for either team. The clubs will meet again in Week 17 at New Orleans. The Saints have won each of the last four games between the divisional foes.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM WEEK 1

QB Sam Darnold made his Carolina debut and recorded 279 passing yards and 1 touchdown, while completing 24-of-35 attempts.

RB Christian McCaffrey returned to the lineup for the first time since Week 9 of 2020. He racked up 187 yards from scrimmage (98 rushing, 89 receiving) and led the team with 9 receptions.

Carolina's defense tallied 6 sacks against the Jets. Six different Panthers players contributed to the team's sack total. The defense added 8 passes defended and allowed just 2.65 yards per rush.

SACK ATTACK

- Carolina's defense put pressure on New York's offense, finishing with 6.0 sacks, 9 QBHs and 6 TFLs.
- The Panthers 6.0 sacks were the most in a single game since Week 6 of the 2019 season (7.0 vs. Tampa Bay in London, 10/13/19).
- Six different players logged sacks in Sunday's game taking down Jets QB Zach Wilson for a combined loss of 51 yards. 51 sack yards is tied for the ninth-most sack yards in a single-game in franchise history and the most since Week 14 of the 2015 season (59 vs. Atlanta, 12/13/2015).
- Carolina's sack count by player:
 - OLB Haason Reddick – 1.5 sacks
 - DT Derrick Brown – 1.0 sack
 - DE Brian Burns – 1.0 sack
 - DE Marquis Haynes – 1.0 sack
 - LB Shaq Thompson – 1.0 sack

SHAQ SHINES IN OPENER

- LB Shaq Thompson recorded 10 tackles, 1.0 sack, 1 INT, 1 TFL, 1 QBH and 3 passes defended against New York.
- Thompson recorded an interception off of Jets QB Zach Wilson in the second quarter, marking his second-career interception.
- Thompson tipped the Wilson throw with one hand before securing the interception and returning the ball 29 yards to New York's 32-yard line. Carolina K Ryan Santos made a 22-yard field goal attempt on the ensuing drive.

DARNOLD'S DEBUT

- In his first game with Carolina, QB Sam Darnold totaled 279 passing yards and one passing touchdown, while completing 24-of-35 attempts (68.6%).
- His 279 passing yards were the 7th most in a single game in his career.
- Darnold added one rushing touchdown on a five-yard score before the end of the first half, marking his sixth-career rushing touchdown.



ROBBY OVER THE TOP

- WR Robby Anderson scored his 10th career touchdown of 40+ yards, ripping off a 57-yard catch-and-run in the second quarter.
- His 10 receiving touchdowns of 40 or more yards ranks in the top five in the NFL since entering the league in 2016.

THE MAC IS BACK

- RB Christian McCaffrey played his first game since Week 9 last year at Kansas City (11/8/20).
- McCaffrey recorded his 28th career game with 100+ yards from scrimmage, finishing with 98 rushing yards and 89 receiving yards for a total of 187 scrimmage yards.
- McCaffrey tallied nine receptions in the game, eight of which came in the first half.
- His performance Sunday marked the seventh game in his career with 75+ rushing yards and 75+ receiving yards, the third most such performances by any player in the Super Bowl era (Marshall Faulk 11, Priest Holmes 9).

The Panthers selected Jackson in the 2nd round of the 2018 NFL Draft out of LSU. Jackson was a two-sport standout for the Tigers as he was part of LSU's SEC Championship 4x100 relay team in the spring of 2017. He played in 37 games with 24 starts in the secondary for the Tigers. Jackson compiled 116 career tackles, 4.0 tackles for loss and 4 interceptions.

Curry also began his coaching career at Mooresville Christian Academy (Mooresville, NC) as the school's head coach from 2010-12...Saints run game coordinator/tight ends coach Dan Roushar was on staff at Northern Illinois when Panthers offensive pass game coordinator/wide receivers coach Frisman Jackson played for the Huskies from 1997-99...Saints offensive line coach Brendan Nugent and Panthers offensive line coach Pat Meyer were on staff together for the Montreal Alouettes in 2012 and the Chicago Bears from 2013-14...Saints offensive line coach Brendan Nugent was on staff at William & Mary while Panthers offensive coordinator Joe Brady played for the Tribe from 2009-11...Saints senior defensive assistant Peter Giunta was on staff at the New York Giants with Panthers head coach Matt Rhule (2012), quarterbacks coach Sean Ryan (2007-14), and defensive run game coordinator Al Holcomb (2009-12). Marshall was one of Carolina's two 2nd round selections in 2021. He appeared in 32 games during his LSU career, starting 20 contests from 2018-20. He helped LSU win 2019 National Championship. Marshall had 106 career receptions for 1,594 yards and 23 TDs, tying for No. 4 in school history in career TD receptions. He is one of only six players in LSU history with 1,500 receiving yards and 20 TDs to his credit.

Matt Rhule enters his second season as head coach of the Carolina Panthers after being named the franchise's fifth head coach in franchise history on January 8, 2020. Rhule has spent 23 years as a coach in the college and NFL ranks.

Despite a 5-11 record during his first season with Carolina, the Panthers were competitive in nearly every game, playing 11 games decided by eight points or fewer which tied for second-most in the NFL.

In 2020, the Panthers led the NFL with 15 fumble recoveries and tied for the league lead with three fumble recovery touchdowns. Offensively, Carolina became the fifth team in the Super Bowl era to have four different players (DJ Moore 1,215, Robby Anderson 1,111, Curtis Samuel 1,051 and Mike Davis 1,015) record over 1,000 scrimmage yards.

Rhule joined Carolina after three seasons (2017-19) as the head coach at Baylor University, where he helped rebuild the Baylor program, guiding the team from a 1-11 finish in his first season to a 7-6 record and a bowl berth in 2018 to an 11-3 record and appearance in the Big 12 Championship and the Sugar Bowl in 2019. Baylor's appearance in the Sugar Bowl was just the second-ever in school history, and under Rhule's leadership the Bears became the first Power 5 program to go from 11 losses (2017) to 11 wins (2019) within two seasons. Rhule was only the second coach in Baylor history to make bowl trips in two of his first three seasons.

Rhule went to Baylor after four seasons as head coach at Temple University. In his head coaching debut at Temple, (2013-16), Rhule took the Owls from a 2-10 mark in his first season to a 6-6 record in 2014 and two consecutive 10-win seasons in 2015 and 2016. He guided the Owls to the school's first-ever back-to-back 10-win seasons. Rhule led Temple to the 2016 AAC championship with a 34-10 victory over Navy in the title game and earned a bid to the Military Bowl.

Rhule returned to Temple after coaching with the New York Giants under head coach Tom Coughlin in 2012.

Prior to his stint in the NFL, Rhule spent six seasons as an assistant at Temple under head coaches Al Golden and Steve Addazio.

From 2002-05, Rhule was an assistant at Western Carolina, serving as assistant head coach during his last three seasons. He also was part of the staffs at UCLA (2001), Buffalo (1999-2000) and Albright College (1998).

A native of New York City, Rhule played linebacker at Penn State from 1994-97. He holds a master's degree from Buffalo. Rhule and his wife Julie have three children, Bryant, Vivienne and Leona.

Named the 14th head coach in Saints history on Jan. 18, 2006, Sean Payton has led the team to nine playoff appearances, seven NFC South titles, three NFC Championship berths and the Super Bowl XLIV title.

In 2020 the Saints won the NFC South for the fourth straight season, posting a 12-4 record. They became the only team since the start of the NFC South in 2002 and since that season's divisional realignment, only the third NFL franchise to capture four straight division titles.

Payton earned unanimous NFL Coach of the Year honors in his first season in 2006 and received the same honors from several outlets in 2009. Considered one of the NFL's brightest offensive minds, Payton has had the Saints ranked among the league's top 10 offenses each season from 2006-19, including finishing first in the NFL six times and putting up an NFL-record 7,474 net yards in 2011. Defensively, the club has ranked fourth in the league in 2010, 2013 and 2020.

With the Dallas Cowboys (2003-05), Payton served as the assistant head coach/passing game coordinator in 2005 after spending his first two seasons as assistant head coach/quarterbacks. Prior to Dallas, Payton spent four years with the New York Giants (1999-2002), the last three seasons as offensive coordinator, and was quarterbacks coach for the Philadelphia Eagles (1997-98).

He earned a degree in communications at Eastern Illinois, where he departed with a school record 10,665 passing yards, then the third-highest total in NCAA Division I-AA history. A three-time All-American, Payton had brief playing stops with Chicago of the Arena League, the CFL's Ottawa Rough Riders and the Chicago Bears in 1987. Payton coached collegiately at San Diego State (1988-89 and 1992-93), Indiana State (1990-91), Miami (Ohio) (1994-95) and Illinois (1996).

Payton was born Dec. 29, 1963 in San Mateo, Calif., and raised in Naperville, Ill. He has a daughter, Meghan, and a son, Connor.

RETURN OF THE MAC

- In the 2021 season opener against the Jets, McCaffrey recorded his 28th career game with 100+ yards from scrimmage, finishing with 98 rushing yards and 89 receiving yards. His 187 yards from scrimmage were the third-most in the NFL in Week 1.

RECORD RECEIVING NUMBERS

- In his five NFL seasons, McCaffrey has totaled 329 receptions for 2,761 yards (8.4 avg.) and 16 receiving touchdowns.
- McCaffrey's 116 catches in 2019 are an NFL record by a RB, bettering his own single-season record of 107 (2018).
- Between 2017-19, McCaffrey recorded 303 receptions, the most by any NFL RB in NFL history through the first 3 seasons of a career, and 2nd most by any player ever. He is the only RB in NFL history with multiple 100-reception seasons.
- In 2019, McCaffrey joined Michael Thomas as the only two players in NFL history with 300+ receptions through their first 3 career seasons.

DJ MOORE

- Since Week 1 of the 2019 season, WR **DJ Moore** has totaled 2,448 receiving yards, 4th most in the NFL over that span.

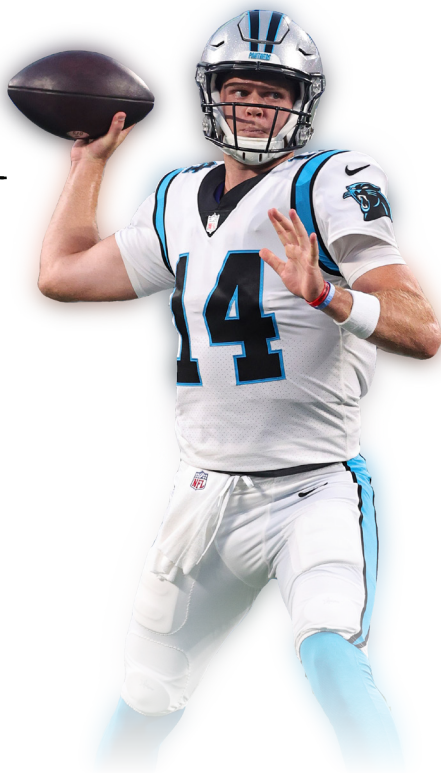

WELCOME TO CAROLINA

- In his first game with Carolina, QB Sam Darnold totaled 279 passing yards and one passing touchdown, while completing 24-of-35 attempts (68.6%) against the Jets. His 279 passing yards were the 7th most in a single game in his career. Darnold added one rushing touchdown on a five-yard score before the end of the first half.
- Darnold joined Carolina this offseason following three years with the Jets. The Panthers traded New York three picks in exchange for the new starting QB: a 6th-round pick in the 2021 draft (which New York traded away to Kansas City), along with a 2nd-round pick and 4th-round pick in 2022.
- Darnold started all 38 games played for the Jets from 2018-20. His best season came in 2019 when he threw for 3,024 yards and 19 touchdowns, while completing 61.9% of his passes.
- Darnold became the 11th different QB to start in Week 1 for Carolina in team history.

Darnold was traded to Carolina after three seasons with the New York Jets (2018-20). Last year, he threw for 2,208 yards and nine touchdowns, while completing 217-of-364 passes (59.6%). In 2019, he posted his best season with 13 starts and 3,024 passing yards with 19 passing touchdowns and 13 interceptions. Averaged 232.6 passing yards per game and registered a passer rating of 84.3. Led the Jets to a 6-2 record over the final eight games, tied for the most quarterback wins in the NFL during that span, while also ranking in the top 10 in touchdown percentage, interception percentage and passer rating over those games. Originally a first-round selection by the Jets, Darnold set a Jets franchise record for highest passer rating by a rookie quarterback (77.6). In 2018, at just over 21 years old, he was the youngest quarterback to start a season opener since the 1970 merger.

CAMERON ERVING

Erving came to the Panthers following one season with Dallas (2020) after spending three years with Kansas City (2017-19) and two years with Cleveland (2015-16). In 2020, started five games with six appearances at tackle for Dallas while battling injury with two stints on IR with knee injuries. Played in 13 games with eight starts at left tackle for Kansas City in 2019 and was part of an offensive line that allowed just 25.0 sacks, third-fewest in the NFL. He appeared in 29 games, starting 17, in his first two seasons in Cleveland in 2015 and 2016. Saw action at center and both guard positions.



In 2016, he helped Cleveland rank second in the NFL with a 4.89 rushing average.

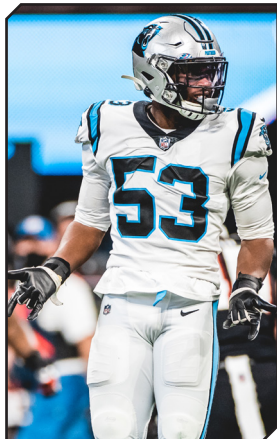

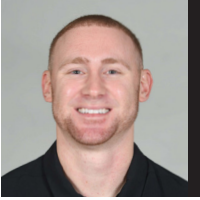

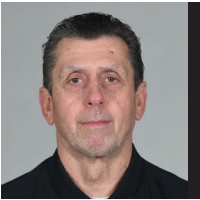

OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Joe Brady orchestrated a 2020 Panthers offense that returned just two starting offensive linemen from 2019 and possessed a new starting quarterback and wide receiver. Additionally, star RB Christian McCaffrey played in just three games due to injury.

Despite the circumstances, Brady still managed to accomplish many feats, including helping Carolina become the fifth team in the Super Bowl era to have four players total 1,000+ scrimmage yards apiece in a single season - WR Robby Anderson, RB Mike Davis, WR DJ Moore and WR Curtis Samuel. Anderson and Moore became the fourth Panthers duo to record 1,000+ receiving yards in the same year. Davis posted career bests in rushing yards, rushing touchdowns and scrimmage yards. Samuel also had a career year, posting single-season highs in receptions, receiving yards and yards from scrimmage.

Brady helped new starting QB Teddy Bridgewater post career highs in passing yards and passing touchdowns. Bridgewater also completed 340-of-492 attempts in Brady's offense, totaling a 69.1 completion percentage, a new Panthers franchise record.

DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

In 2020, Phil Snow oversaw a young defense, that possessed a league-high 11 rookies who recorded defensive snaps, with six starting at least one game. Carolina's 3,498 snaps and 287 tackles by rookies led the entire NFL in 2020.

Carolina's defense made improvements in numerous categories in comparison to 2019, including total net yards allowed per game (2020: 360.1, 2019: 374.5), rushing yards allowed per attempt (2020: 4.75, 2019: 5.16), rushing yards allowed per game (2020: 121.0, 2019: 143.5) and points allowed per game (2020: 25.1, 2019: 29.4).

Panthers LB/S Jeremy Chinn and DT Derrick Brown earned postseason honors, being named to the PFWA All-Rookie Team. Chinn became the first player in franchise history to earn NFL Defensive Rookie of the Month honors twice in the same season (October and November).

The Panthers tied for 10th in the NFL with 22 total takeaways in 2020, including a league-best 15 opponent fumbles recovered.

Hickory Ridge, Nation Ford and West Mecklenburg High Schools each held their own private practices on the new stadium field Aug 3-4.

In addition to practicing on the Panthers game field, each team received autographed Panthers footballs awarded to each team's offensive and defensive practice player of the day, as well as receiving tickets to the August 21st Baltimore Ravens vs. Panthers pre-season home game.



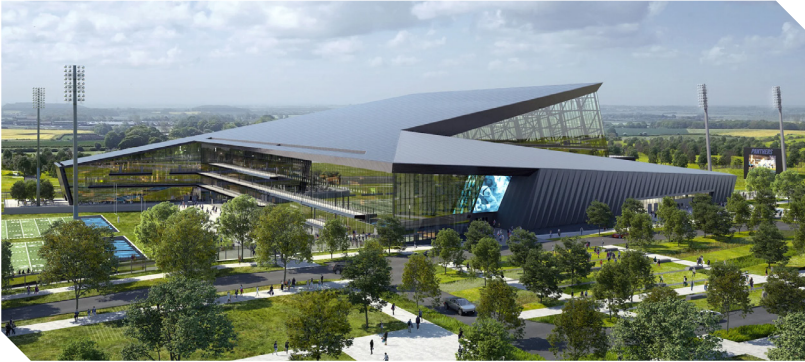
BIG FRIDAY HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL AT MEMORIAL STADIUM

The Carolina Panthers are bringing high school football back to the newly-renovated American Legion Memorial Stadium with the "Carolina Panthers Big Friday High School Football" series. The three-game package features a powerhouse line-up of highly-ranked teams and anticipated match ups.

Panthers team partners WSOC-TV, Gatorade and GMC are supporting Big Friday with game promotion, game day assets for teams, and the GMC Youth Football Players of the Game, which will provide a special game day experience for local youth football teams, game promotion and coverage. Carolina Panthers Charities will provide a \$2,500 grant to the school with the best student section at each game. Each Big Friday game will also feature Panthers personalities and other special Panthers game elements.



PANTHERS ROCK HILL DEVELOPMENT



The Carolina Panthers, York County and the city of Rock Hill, S.C. have joined in a community partnership to transition the team's headquarters to Rock Hill. The new site will not only include a world-class sports complex, but also be a true destination site for the entire region, offering entertainment, dining, retail, athletics and medical care.

Groundbreaking for the site commenced in June 2020 with the first phase opening planned for 2023. Constructed on a 240-acre site adjacent to I-77, the facility and development will ultimately include:

- The Panthers new HQ offices
- An indoor practice facility
- Outdoor practice fields which can also be utilized to host multiple high school football games.
- Indoor facility to host athletic events and games, concerts and corporate events
- A premier orthopedic sports medicine facility
- Corporate offices
- Residential space
- Retail stores

The headquarters will also mean significant infrastructure improvements for the region. An interchange off I-77 will be part of additional road improvements, including more than 13,000 feet of new public streets, 2,600 parking spaces, sidewalks and trail networks for cyclists and pedestrian walkers and runners.

DESIGN OVERVIEW

The Carolina Panthers Rock Hill Development is an innovative mixed-use, pedestrian friendly community anchored by the practice facility, headquarters offices, and sports/entertainment venue with emphasis on retail/entertainment/media productions, hospitality, employment, research and development, residential dwellings, indoor and outdoor recreation, and open space uses. Constructed on a 200+ acre site adjacent to I-77, the Panthers organization is investing to develop and build the facility and development infrastructure, which will initially include: new headquarters offices; an indoor practice facility; outdoor practice fields; scalable small stadium to host high school sports, concerts, festivals, etc.; an indoor facility to host games, concerts and corporate events; and a premier orthopedic sports medicine facility.

Inspired by the quarries of South Carolina and the city of Rock Hill, Populous introduced its design with the following fundamental principles:

- To think football and beyond
- To be smart and state-of-the-art
- To be authentically Panthers

As guests arrive at the training facility, the entrance greets everyone with a moment of significant impact - a series of canted glass walls, articulated metal panels and LED displays are choreographed to captivate visitors upon entry, culminating at one of the building's peaked rooflines which rises toward the southeast. The west lobby serves as the team entry and opens up to a one-of-a-kind commons area that serves as a social gathering space for café style dining, impromptu meetings, and multi-purpose events – each offering the ability to enjoy expansive views of the surrounding landscape.

Once arriving to the athlete facilities, the team locker room and training and recovery programs organize themselves around the primary length of the building and open themselves up to natural light and the outdoor practice fields to the south. Elevated office environments, lounges, and a café provide open views to the south and a direct relationship to the pavilion to the north which houses the facility's indoor playing field. Beyond the pavilion to the north lies an outdoor playing field, spectator seating, and bermed viewing areas, which will serve as a unique outdoor canvas for live events. For increased capacities and integration of indoor and outdoor space, the pavilion's two 90-foot wide by 80-foot tall operable glazed doors will open to transform the complex into a spectacular event space for concerts and live events.
