## OFF AND RUNNING: TODD BOWLES EARNS FIRST WIN IN TAMPA BAY



### WEEK 1 DEFENSIVE NOTABLES

- Held 2021's No. 1 scoring offense to three points - the fewest points allowed by Tampa Bay in Week 1 since 9/8/2003 at Philadelphia.
- Dallas reached Tampa Bay's 31-yard line on its first possession, which was the deepest the Cowboys advanced into Buccaneers' territory on the night. The last time Tampa Bay held an opposing offense out of the red zone for an entire game was 12/26/20 at Detroit.







# DENNIS ALLEN



Now in his 27th year in coaching and 21st in the NFL, Allen has honed his skills on the staff of Super Bowl XLIV champion head coach Sean Payton for 12 seasons and also for Super Bowl participants John Fox and Dan Reeves.

Allen was promoted to head coach after spending the past six-and-a-half seasons as the defensive coordinator of the Saints, during which the team enjoyed five consecutive winning seasons and also captured four-straight NFC South division titles from 2017-20. During his tenure as an assistant under Payton in New Orleans,

Allen has been part of staffs that have qualified for the playoffs seven times, captured the NFC South six times, reached the NFC Championship game three times and won the Super Bowl XLIV championship.

## DENNIS ALLEN AT A GLANCE

- Allen's defenses have ranked in the top 10 in yards per game and in the top five in opponent points per game each of the past two seasons. During his 16 seasons coaching a position, serving as a defensive coordinator and as a head coach, he has coached 10 players to a total of 21 Pro Bowl selections.
- In 2021, Allen's defensive unit ranked first in the NFL in opponent red zone touchdown percentage (43.5), second in opponent first downs (304) and opponent rushing first downs (84), fourth in in scoring defense (19.7 points per game), opponent net yards per play (5.08) and run defense (93.5 yards per game), seventh in total defense (318.2 net yards per game) and eighth in sacks (46). New Orleans' current streak of 22 regular/season postseason contests without allowing a 100-yard rusher is the longest in the NFL. With 25 takeaways and a plus-seven turnover ratio, Allen's defense was instrumental in leading the Saints to their fifth straight winning season.
- Allen served as the head coach of the Oakland Raiders from 2012-14, with an 8-28 (.222) record.
- Prior to Oakland, Allen served as defensive coordinator of the Denver Broncos in 2011. He led a defense that helped the Broncos win the AFC West division crown and advance to the AFC Divisional round with an AFC Wild Card game victory.
- During Allen's previous five-year tenure in New Orleans, he first served as assistant defensive line coach (2006-07) before being promoted to secondary coach (2008-10).
- He was a part of a defensive coaching staff that engineered significant improvement from 2009-10, when the club went 24-8 in the regular season, qualified for the playoffs both times and captured Super Bowl XLIV.
- Allen joined the Saints after a four-year stint with the Atlanta Falcons, where he spent his final two years as defensive assistant/quality control with an emphasis on working with the defensive line. Over the previous two seasons, he was in charge of defensive quality control while helping tutor the secondary.
- A native of Hurst, Texas, Allen earned four letters for Texas A&M as a safety from 1992-95. A highlight was his fourth-quarter interception that clinched an 18-9 victory over Texas in 1993, sending the Aggies to their third-straight Cotton Bowl.
