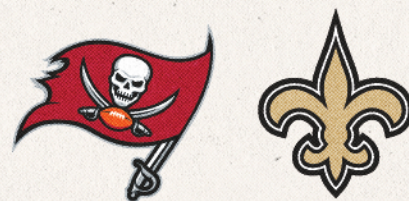

FIRST THINGS FIRST

- Tampa Bay has won three of the past four meetings between the two teams.
- 64th all-time regular season meeting ... New Orleans enters with a 40-24 all-time series advantage ... Tampa Bay won the lone playoff meeting between the two teams.
- The Buccaneers enter Week 6 tied for the best record in the NFC South. Tampa Bay has now held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 48 of the past 56 weeks dating back to Week 4 of the 2021 season.
- The Buccaneers are 1-of-3 teams with 50+ wins since 2020 (including playoffs), alongside the Kansas City Chiefs and Buffalo Bills.

PUTTING ON A SHOW

- Entering Week 6, Baker Mayfield has the highest passer rating by a Tampa Bay quarterback through five games, of any QB who has started each of the team's first five games of a season (112.2).



- Since his arrival in Tampa Bay in 2023, Mayfield ranks third in the NFL in passing touchdowns (39).

EARLY RESULTS FOR NEW OC LIAM COEN



- Under the direction of first-year offensive coordinator Liam Coen, the Buccaneers rank seventh in the NFL in offensive points scored per game (25.4). Tampa Bay's 16.8 offensive points scored per game in the first half alone rank second in the league.

- The Buccaneers also rank tied for fourth in the NFL in fewest giveaways (four).

OFFENSIVE NOTES

A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

• In 2023, Mike Evans reached the 1,000-yard mark for the 10th consecutive season - the longest-such streak to begin a career and the second-longest streak overall in league history. Evans is also the first player ever with 60+ receptions in each of his first 10 career seasons.



• Evans now has five career seasons with 1,000+ receiving yards and 10-or-more receiving touchdowns, which tie him for the fifth-most in NFL history.

• Evans (1,255) and Chris Godwin (1,024) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark in 2023, marking the fifth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past four such occasions.

• Evans and Godwin are 1-of-3 sets of teammates to go over 1,000 yards each in both 2022 and 2023 and the only duo to do so in each of the past three seasons (2021-23).

NEXT MAN UP: TAMPA BAY'S DEFENSE FIGHTING THROUGH ADVERSITY



Lavonte David, in Year 13, put forth another noteworthy performance in Tampa Bay's Week 4 win over the Philadelphia Eagles, notching eight tackles (two for loss), 2.0 sacks, a pass defended and a forced fumble that helped seal the win for Tampa Bay. In the process, David became the second Tampa Bay player in franchise history with 1,500 tackles joining Pro Football Hall of Famer Derrick Brooks, while also tying Khalil Mack (30) for the most forced fumbles among active players.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR

MIKE EVANS



- Needs **44 receiving yards and 1 receiving touchdown** to become just the 10th player in NFL history with 12,000+ receiving yards and 100+ receiving touchdowns in a career. All eight eligible players on the list have been inducted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

- Needs **1 game played** to tie Tony Mayberry (160) for the eighth-most games played in franchise history.
- Needs **44 receiving yards** to become the 18th player in NFL history with 12,000+ receiving yards with one franchise.
- Needs **106 receiving yards** to surpass Derrick Mason (12,061) for the 29th-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs **128 receiving yards** to surpass Hines Ward (12,083) for the 28th-most receiving yards in league history.
- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Hall of Famers Tim Brown and Steve Largent (100) for the ninth-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history and to become just the 11th player in NFL history to reach the 100 receiving touchdown milestone. He would become the fifth-fastest player to reach 100 receiving touchdowns (160 games), trailing only Pro Football Hall of Famers Jerry Rice, Randy Moss, Terrell Owens and Marvin Harrison.
- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Hall of Famers Tim Brown and Steve Largent (100) for the ninth-most receiving touchdowns in NFL history and to become just the 11th player in NFL history to reach the 100 receiving touchdown milestone. He would become just the seventh to record 100 receiving touchdowns with one franchise.
- Needs **1 total touchdown** to tie Hall of Famer Steve Largent (101) for the 22nd-most total touchdowns in NFL history.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR



CADE OTTON

- Needs **6 receiving yards** to reach the 1,000 career receiving yards milestone, becoming the 12th tight end in franchise history with 1,000+ receiving yards for Tampa Bay.
- Needs **9 receptions** to surpass Calvin Magee (114) for the ninth-most receptions by a tight end in franchise history.
- Needs **14 receptions** to surpass O.J. Howard (119) for the eighth-most receptions by a tight end in franchise history.
