FIRST THINGS FIRST

- The Buccaneers are 9-2 (.909) in December/January games dating back to the start of 2023 and 21-6 (.778) dating back to the start of the 2020 season. Tampa Bay's nine-such wins in such games since 2023 are tied for the second-most in the NFL during that span.
- Dating back to Week 4 of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 55 of the last 68 weeks, winning three consecutive NFC South division titles during that span (2021-23).
- 66th all-time regular season meeting ... New Orleans enters with a 40-25 series advantage ... The Buccaneers have won four of the past five meetings, including defeating the Saints, 51-27, in Week 6.

Since joining the Buccaneers in 2023, Baker Mayfield leads the NFL in passing touchdowns (67) and ranks second in passing yards (8,323).

BUCCANEERS OFFENSE IS LIGHTING IT UP UNDER NEW OC LIAM COEN



Tampa Bay has amassed 400+ yards of offense in a game 10 different times this season - the most 400-yard outings in the NFL - and is the only team with three-or-more 500-yard performances in 2024. The Buccaneers also rank tied for first in 20-point games this season (15).

- The Buccaneers are 9-4 this season with Mike Evans active (0-3 without) and 9-2 in games in which Evans has five-or-more targets.

- Despite missing three games, Evans is tied for third in the NFL in receiving touchdowns, with 11.

- Evans needs 85 receiving yards in the final game of the year to keep his 1,000-yard streak alive (10 consecutive

seasons) and tie Pro Football Hall of Famer Jerry Rice for the most consecutive 1,000-yard receiving seasons in NFL history (11).

THE RESURGENCE IN THE RUN GAME

• The Buccaneers have rushed for 100+ yards in 13-of-16 (81.3%) games this season after doing so in 9-of-34 (26.5%) games over the previous two seasons.

• Tampa Bay's 5.2 rushing yards per attempt this season is the team's highest average through 16 games in team history.

• Rookie Bucky Irving ranks second in the NFL in yards per touch (6.1) among players with 150+ touches this season, trailing only Jahmyr Gibbs. Irving (1,430) and Rachaad White (1,006) are 1-of-2 duos with 1,000+ total yards from scrimmage each (Detroit).

THE AGELESS LAVONTE DAVID

At age 34, David is the lone player this season with 100+ tackles, 5.0+ sacks and three-or-more forced fumbles. Over the past 10 seasons, only four players have recorded these numbers in a single season: David (2024), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2023), Shaquille Leonard (2018) and Thomas Davis (2015).

Per the Associated Press, since 1991, David is just the eighth player to record 40+ sacks and 30+ takeaways, including playoffs, joining Karlos Dansby, Ray Lewis, London Fletcher, Julius Peppers, Junior Seau, Jason Taylor and Brian Urlacher. Five of the other seven players in this group are members of the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

Evans would also break a tie with Pro Football Hall of Famer Randy Moss (10) for the second-most total 1,000-yard seasons in league history, trailing only Rice (14).
- Needs **127 receiving yards** to surpass Pro Football Hall of Famer Art Monk (12,721) for the 23rd-most receiving yards in NFL history.

- Dating back to Week 4 of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 55 of the last 68 weeks, winning three consecutive NFC South division titles in that span (2021-23).
