FIRST THINGS FIRST

- Since Baker Mayfield's arrival in 2023, Head Coach Todd Bowles and the Tampa Bay Buccaneers have recorded the most wins (11) and highest winning percentage (.846) of any team in Weeks 13-18.
- Dating back to the start of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 71 of the last 85 weeks, winning four consecutive NFC South division titles in that span (2021-24).
- The Buccaneers have won six of the past seven meetings with New Orleans, including three consecutive ... Tampa Bay is looking to win four consecutive games vs. the Saints for the first time in series history.

In Weeks 13-18, Tampa Bay's opponents have a combined 21-40 record (.344 combined win percentage) and are all currently sitting on the outside of the playoff picture.

GOING THROUGH A GAUNTLET

From Week 4-Week 12, 7-of-8 Buccaneers opponents during that stretch currently have winning records (61-25 combined record, .709 combined win percentage). The Buccaneers own the second-highest strength of schedule (.545 opp. win percentage) through Week 13 of any team currently in playoff position and the fourth-best strength of victory (.435 opp. win percentage among teams Tampa Bay beat).

Mayfield has rushed 19 times on third down this season, with 15 going for first downs (78.9% success rate). That is the second-highest first-down rush percentage on third-down attempts among all quarterbacks with 10+ third down carries and the third-highest mark in the entire NFL. Meanwhile, **Rachaad White** ranks third among all running backs in that statistic, and fifth in the NFL.

Chase McLaughlin has reset the Buccaneers single season franchise record for field goal percentage in consecutive seasons, posting a 93.5% clip in 2023 and following that up with a 93.8% mark in 2024. He also set a franchise record by making 30 consecutive field goals from 10/26/23 to 10/21/24 and has made the most field goals made of 50+ yards in team history (24), including going 9-for-9 in 50+ yard field goal attempts this season. His 65-yarder in Week 4 was the longest outdoor field goal in NFL history.

Under Head Coach **Todd Bowles**' direction, the Buccaneers have collected 18 takeaways, with just nine offensive turnovers, giving them a +9 turnover margin — tied for the second-best turnover differential in the NFL this season. Tampa Bay has seven games with multiple takeaways this year, tied for the secondmost in the NFL through Week 13, trailing only Chicago (eight).

- Dating back to the start of the 2021 season, Tampa Bay has held at least a share of the NFC South lead in 71 of the last 85 weeks, winning four consecutive NFC South division titles in that span (2021-24).


