A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Each year the Seahawks organization strives to be a championship caliber team both on and off the field. We remain committed to actively making a positive difference in our community and take great pride in our role as a community unifier within the region. Each year we support numerous programs with a focus on key areas including youth empowerment, the military community, social justice, community response, the future of football and supporting our players and legends.

We are humbled by the generous support of the 12s, our corporate partners and the greater Pacific Northwest. Last year, the club supported 245 different community organizations with a total of 37,335 in-kind items and \$2.6M in cash donations. The Seahawks also held more than 200 community events, impacting more than 95,000 individuals, while Seahawks players and legends collectively made over 100 community appearances.

Additional highlights include:

- In its second year, the Seahawks 50/50 Gameday Raffle program raised a staggering \$841,477 for our Spirit of 12 Partners thanks to a generous match by the Paul G. Allen Family Foundation. This represents a 98% year-over-year growth rate for total donations compared to 2022.

- A food drive hosted at our Monday Night Football game on December 18, 2023 raised enough food and funds for 532,000 meals to benefit Northwest Harvest.

- To date, the Seahawks have donated nearly \$370,000 to support the growth of girls flag football across the state, with nearly 100 teams scheduled to play at the middle or high school level for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year.

- The Seahawks achieved 100% CPR/AED Certification for all of the organization's full-time staff and donated \$20,000 to equip local public parks with AEDs and Save Stations.

Mental Health Matters

The Seahawks are committed to destigmatizing the conversation around mental health by spreading awareness on the topic, providing necessary resources, positively engaging with our community, amplifying the voices of experts in this space, and encouraging all people to nurture their mental wellness every day.

Seahawks were proud to partner with **Mindful Therapy Group, Cigna and Muckleshoot Tribe** on a variety of Mental Health Matters events, awareness and fundraising campaigns throughout the year.



Crucial Catch

Throughout the month of October, Seahawks support the NFL's Crucial Catch campaign for cancer awareness and early detection in collaboration with **Virginia Mason Franciscan Health**. Over \$8,000 was raised for the Crucial Cash Fund which helps local patients who cannot cover the incidental costs of cancer treatment.



Home Team Harvest

Home Team Harvest is WA's largest annual food drive with a total of **23.4 million meals** raised to benefit Northwest Harvest. This year, the Seahawks partnered with **KING 5** and **Safeway** to host a special food drive at the Monday Night Football Game vs. Philadelphia, raising **532,022 meals** in one day!



Heart Health Month

Safeway, in partnership with the Seahawks, raised **\$99,242** in their stores and through the sales of Tyler Lockett's heart t-shirts for **Virginia Mason Franciscan Health Foundation** as part of Heart Health Month in February.



Training Camp Powered by Boeing

Community engagement during Training Camp included **27 community groups** through **Boeing Community Corner** and non-profit booths, **150 volunteers** raising over **\$19,000** for the Spirit of 12 program and **250 kids** participating in the Seahawks Flag Football clinic before practice and over **1,600 complimentary tickets** provided to community organizations.

NFL Foundation Grants

The Seahawks, in partnership with NFL Foundation, granted **\$208,000** to various community causes including youth football, digital equity, cancer, military, social justice and more.



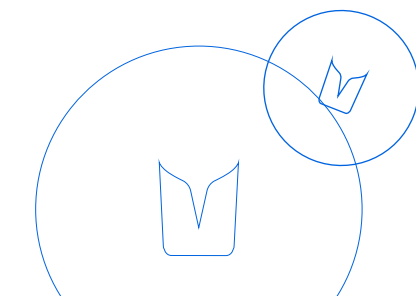


CPR/AED Certification

In June 2023, the Seahawks announced **100%** of the front office staff was CPR/AED certified. The Seahawks also donated a total of **\$20,000** to a variety of organizations, including Project 100, a new local fundraising initiative to equip public parks and areas of physical activity in Washington with AEDs.

The Seahawks held CPR/AED trainings for youth football coaches and partnered with **Virginia Mason Franciscan Health** to purchase AEDs for each of eleven the Seahawks Flag Football league locations.

The Seahawks, Virginia Mason Franciscan Health and Nick of Time Foundation partnered to provide free youth EKG heart screenings and CPR/AED training at the team's facility completing over **525 appointments**, discovering 12 abnormal results which demonstrates how impactful these screenings are in keeping hearts healthy and saving lives.



Delta Community Captain

Seahawks and **Delta Air Lines** partnered to recognize local individuals and organizations who are making a difference in the community by naming them as honorary team captains in the categories of education, military, social justice, and environment.



Team of Champions Powered by Boeing

Seahawks and **Boeing** partnered to recognize **8 community organizations** and impacted **350 individuals** as part of the Team of Champions. Organizations included:

African Community Housing & Development, Compass Housing Alliance, Environmental Coalition of South Seattle, Multicultural Child & Family Hope Center, Neighborhood House, Refugee Women's Alliance, Seattle Clemency Project, and YWCA.

Seahawks Teammate Day of Service

Over **150 Seahawks staff, Rookies and Legends** volunteered at Marra Farms, Ballard VFW, Northwest Harvest, and two different Neighborhood House locations volunteering over **300 hours** during the team's annual day of service.

Seahawks Ticket Donations

Seahawks donated **1,535 tickets** throughout the season to charitable auctions, community groups and local families in need.

Sea Hawkers Community Engagement

The Sea Hawkers, the official booster club of the Seattle Seahawks, with nearly 11,000 members across 40 chapters, donated **\$440K** and volunteered over **25,000 hours** in their communities in the spirit of the 12s.



Seahawks Women’s Association

The Seahawks Women’s Association (S.W.A.) focuses on investing time and efforts to improve the quality of life for individuals who need it most in our community. In 2023, the S.W.A contributed over **\$260,000** to local non-profit organizations.

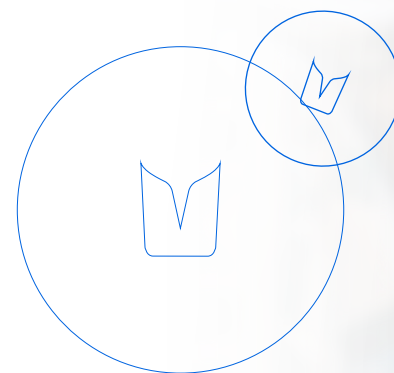


Ben’s Fund

Ben’s Fund, founded in 2012 by Seahawks President of Football Operations / General Manager John Schneider and wife Traci in honor of their son Ben, provides financial support and guidance to children and young adults in the state of Washington who have autism. Over **\$5.1M** has been raised and over **3,480 grants** have been awarded to help cover costs associated with medical bills, therapies and numerous other aspects of supporting a child or young adult on the autism spectrum.

FAST54

Virginia Mason Franciscan Health teamed up with **Bobby Wagner** to create FAST54 and promote awareness for the signs of strokes, raising over **\$250,000** through the Phenia Mae Fund in honor of his late mother who he lost to a stroke. **30,000 comic books** were distributed to the community that has Wagner portrayed as a superhero and educates readers on F.A.S.T., an acronym to help people recall the signs of a stroke (Face drooping, Arm weakness, Speech difficulties and Time to call 911).

Girls High School Flag Football

The Seahawks donated **\$177,000** in girls high school flag football grants in 2023. Since 2021, the team has contributed a total of **\$324,900**, helping over **80 schools** across Washington State launch girls flag football teams.

NFL Flag

Over **400 athletes** competed in the NFL Flag NW Regional Tournament with ten teams winning their divisions. The winning teams represented the Seahawks at the Pro Bowl Games in Orlando and received a special visit from Pro Bowler **Devon Witherspoon**.



International Flag Football

Legend **Neiko Thorpe** and Blitz traveled up to Vancouver, BC for the NFL Flag Canada Regional Tournament where over **140 youth football athletes** competed.

The Seahawks hosted two Flag Football camps in Vancouver and Whistler, spreading the game of football to more than **300 Canadian kids**.



Youth Tackle Takeovers

Supported youth football teams through equipment donations and special appearances by Seahawks players, legends, Blitz, Seahawks Dancers, and Blue Thunder.



Blue Friday Night Lights Presented by Oberto

Blue Friday Night Lights presented by **Oberto** celebrates high school football by bringing Seahawks gameday entertainment elements including DJ SupaSam, Seahawks Dancers, Blue Thunder, Blitz, Boom and Seahawks Legends to **3 high school football matchups** every season.



WIAA High School Football State Championships

The Seahawks were proud to be the title sponsor of the WIAA High School Football State Championships. **Six matchups** took place across two days at Husky Stadium with over **14,500 fans** in attendance. Appearances onsite included Seahawks Dancers, Blue Thunder, Blitz, Legend Randall Morris, and players **Abe Lucas** and **Bryant Koback**.



High School Coach of the Week

Each week during the 2023 high school football season, the Seahawks and the Washington State Football Coaches Association select two high school football coaches as the Coach of the Week winners who receive a **\$500** donation to the school's football program. The 2023 Coach of the Year was Travis Anderson of Anacortes High School who received a **\$2,000** donation.





King County Play Equity Coalition

The Seahawks joined together with other Seattle professional sports teams including Mariners, Sounders, Kraken, Storm, Reign FC and Seattle Sports Commission to make a four-year, \$500,000 commitment to the King County Play Equity Coalition which will help to continue to ensure every child has an equitable chance to play sports in our community.

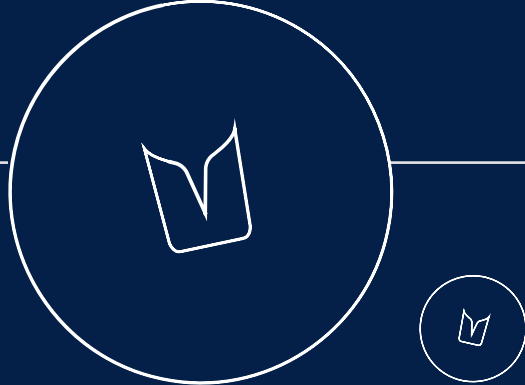


Player Camps

Military Family Day

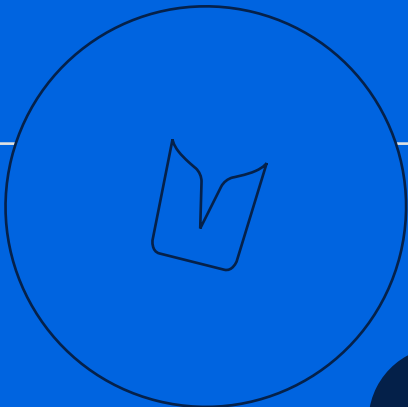
WHOLE Mentoring

BLITZ and his friends scooted across Washington to raise money to support kids and families in need with new pairs of shoes, raising more than **\$160,000** resulting in **3,500 new shoes** donated to the community.

Blitz also received the NFL Mascot Anchor in the Community Award for his on-going commitment to give back to the community.

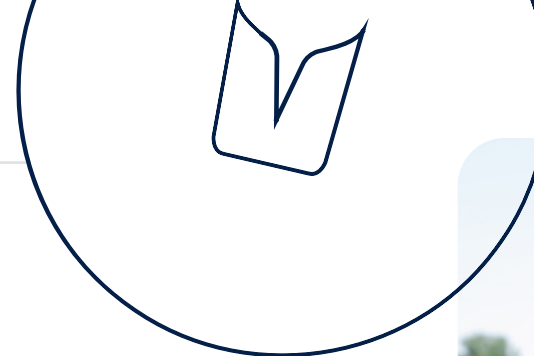

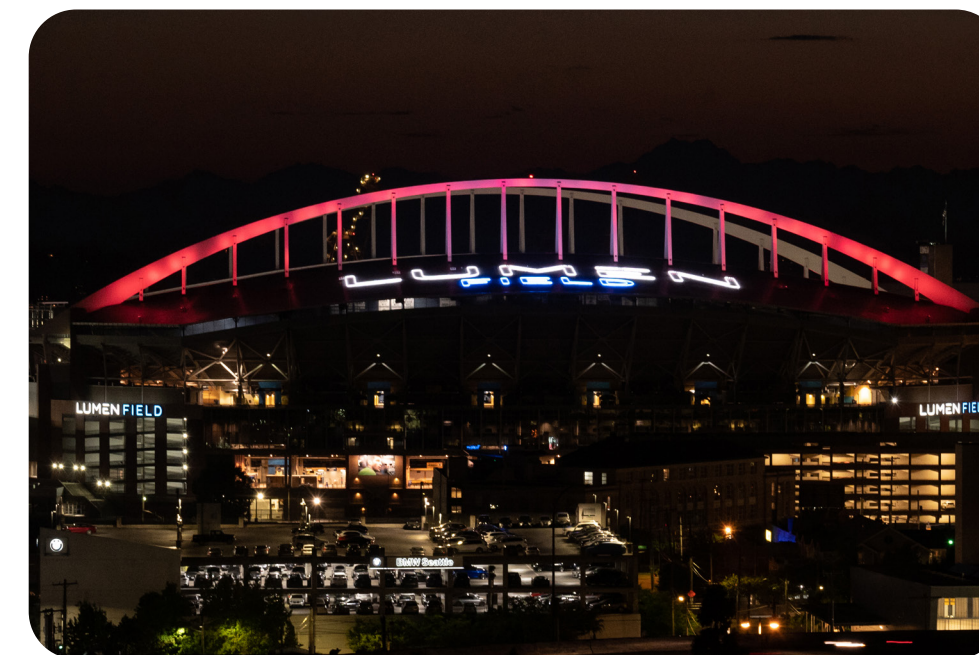
