## **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS)**

# My organization serves the 18-county Greater Houston Area but is headquartered outside of this region. Am I eligible for funding?

Yes, as long as the funds that are requested will be allocated towards serving the 18-county Greater Houston Area.

#### Can I apply for a general operating support grant?

Yes. The Inspire Change Grant will consider requests for general operating support though we reserve the right to request how funds might be allocated (e.g., staff costs, administrative costs, etc.). Requests must align with the Eligibility Requirements.

## Does the Inspire Change Grant offer funds for capital campaigns?

Yes. We will consider capital campaign requests but will prioritize requests where funding will have a meaningful impact (e.g., last mile funding and instances where an Inspire Change grant can be leveraged to secure other funders, etc.).

#### Can past grant recipients apply again?

Yes. However, past recipients must have completed an impact report for the previous grant prior to being considered.

#### Can I nominate my favorite nonprofit?

The Inspire Change Grant requires representatives from each nonprofit organization to complete the grant application. However, please share information about the Inspire Change Grant with your favorite nonprofit so that they may consider applying for funding.

### How will we be notified if we are selected to receive grant funding?

You will be contacted by a representative of the Houston Texans Foundation in November – December 2024.

#### Who is on the grant selection committee?



An advisory committee composed of community leaders and Texans representatives will select grant recipients.

# How many organizations applied in 2023?

We received more than 300 submissions, and 15 grants were awarded.
