



THIS IS WHEN SOMEONE USES THEIR HANDS TO HURT SOMEONE ELSE.

ACTIONS INCLUDE HITTING, KICKING, PINCHING, TRIPPING, AND PUSHING.

STAY-OUT BULLYING

THIS IS WHEN SOMEONE HURTS SOMEONE ELSE BY LEAVING THEM OUT OF THE GROUP ON PURPOSE.

CYBER BULLYING

THIS IS WHEN SOMEONE USES ANY FORM OF TECHNOLOGY TO MAKE FUN OF SOMEONE ELSE OR SPREAD RUMORS ABOUT THEM.
