

Led the team in tackles in the Rose Bowl and Pac-12 Championship Game ... Totaled 20 tackles, including 15 solo, two pass breakups, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery for TD in the Rose Bowl and Pac-12 Championship Game ... Three defensive TDs tied for the most in the nation ... One of six FBS players with a pick-6 and fumble recovery for a TD ... Just the eighth FBS player since 2000 with two fumble returns for a TD and a pick-6 ... Played in 14 games ... Started four of the last five contests ... Led the team in tackles three times which tied for the most ... Tied for fourth on the team with 62 tackles with 43 solo stops ... Made seven or more tackles in four of the last six games ... Finished tied for second nationally with four fumble



recoveries ... Had two interceptions ... **at USC (Nov. 2):** Led the team with seven tackles and had a 32-yard interception return for a TD in the second quarter ... Also recovered a fumble in the second quarter ... One of 39 FBS players with an INT and fumble recovery in the same game ... Named Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week ... **vs. No. 5 Utah (Dec. 6):** Delivered a fourth-down stop on Utah's first drive of the game ... Picked off a pass at the end of the first quarter ... Led the team with nine tackles ... **vs. No. 8 Wisconsin (Jan. 1):** Set a career high for tackles for the second consecutive game with 11 stops ... Returned a fumble 31 yards on a muffed punt for a TD in the third quarter ... Forced a fumble in the fourth quarter that led to Oregon's game-winning TD ... First FBS player since 2000 with 10-plus tackles, a fumble return TD and a forced fumble in a bowl game.

As A Sophomore (2018)

» Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention

Saw time in all 13 games ... Played primarily on special teams ... Made 10 total tackles, including seven solo ... Had a tackle in nine games.

As A Redshirt Freshman (2017)

» Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention

Played in 11 games ... Made 23 tackles, including 15 solo, and had one interception ... Had a tackle in 10 of 11 games played ... vs. California (Sept. 30): Made a season-high five tackles ... Played a season-best 35 snaps ... at No. 12 Washington (Nov. 4): Registered first career interception and had three solo tackles.

As A Freshman (2016) Utilized a redshirt.

High School

Rated a four-star prospect and the top player in Oregon by Rivals ... Tabbed the No. 162 overall prospect in the class and the No. 9 safety by Rivals ... Finished as the No. 2 player in Oregon and No. 288 overall recruit in the 247Sports composite rating ... PrepStar All-American ... Advanced to The Opening Finals on the Nike campus ... One of 50 high school players selected to play for the U.S. Under-19 National Team in the 2016 International Bowl and was voted team captain ... Two-time first-team all-state defensive back (The Oregonian) ... Back-to-back Mt. Hood Conference Defensive Player of the Year ... Helped lead Central Catholic High School to an 8-3 record his senior year, a pair of Mt. Hood Conference titles and the Oregon 6A state championship in 2014 ... Had 58 tackles (31 unassisted), two fumble recoveries, and one interception as a senior while tallying 458 rushing yards (7.6 avg.) and six touchdowns ... Also caught 10 passes for 179 yards and two more scores in addition to throwing for one TD ... Accumulated 42 tackles and three interceptions his junior year in addition to contributing 175 rushing yards and 172 yards receiving ... Earned second-team all-conference honors as a sophomore at South Medford High School while recording 79 tackles and five interceptions before transferring to Central Catholic prior to his junior season ... Committed to Oregon as a junior in 2014 ... Chose Oregon over Oregon State and Washington State.
