


2019 ROOKIE FREE AGENTS



Signed by the Titans as an undrafted free agent on May 10, 2019... appeared in 36 games with 25 starts over three seasons at Kansas State... totaled 458 carries for 2,616 yards and 25 touchdowns...finished his career ranked second in yards per carry (5.7) and in 100-yard rushing games (12) in program history...added 25 catches for 223 yards as a Wildcat.
