Signed by the Titans as an undrafted free agent on May 14, 2021... appeared in 26 games with 17 starts over four seasons at Iowa (2017-20) and made starts at right guard (16) and left guard (one).



As a graduate student (2017), tallied a 29-2 record including a perfect 14-0 dual-meet record and a 9-0 mark in Big Ten duels...added 12 falls, two technical falls and six major decisions...was the runner up at the NCAA Championships (4-1 record) and the runner up at the Big Ten Championships (2-1 record)...captured the heavyweight titles at the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational (6-0 record) and the Michigan State Open (3-0 record)...earned NCAA All-American heavyweight recognition... as a senior (2016), redshirted due to injury...as a junior (2015), posted a 23-3 record with nine falls, three technical falls and four major

Signed by the Titans as an undrafted free agent on May 14, 2021... appeared in 54 games with 21 starts at tight end over five seasons at Alabama (2016-20) and caught 44 passes for 505 yards and five touchdowns...rushed once for one yard...was a member of two National Championship winning teams.
