- Led all Stanford receivers with 63 receptions for 831 yards
- Recorded six receiving touchdowns, tied for the most by a Cardinal wideout
- Tabbed three 100-yard receiving games (vs. TCU, Aug. 30, at NC State, Nov. 2 vs. San Jose State, Nov. 29)
- Was the Cardinal's leading receiver in seven of the 2024 season's 12 games
- Totaled three of his touchdown receptions in a three-game stretch to begin ACC play, becoming the first Cardinal to record receiving touchdowns in three straight games since Brycen Tremayne in 2021
- Finished seventh in the ACC in receptions (63) and tied for ninth in receiving touchdowns (6), while ranking third in pass-blocking (72.7, per Pro Football Focus)
- Named the team's Tommy Vardell Award winner, awarded to an academic junior or senior player who best epitomizes excellence in both academics and athletics and Stanford's Deswarte-Eller Award winner, awarded to the team's most outstanding sophomore player

- Paced the Stanford offense with 62 receptions for 1,013 yards and six touchdowns
- Ranked seventh in the Pac-12 in receiving yards and yards per catch (16.3), while ranking fifth in yards per game (84.4)
- Posted the seventh most receiving yards in the NCAA from Oct. 11 through the end of the season (806)

- First Cardinal to get 1,000 receiving yards in a season since J.J. Arcega-Whiteside in 2018
- His 1,013 receiving yards on the eighth most in a single season in Stanford history
- Topped the 100-yard mark three times (294 at Colorado, 146 vs. No. 5 Washington, 122 at No. 12 Oregon State)
- Scored the first touchdown of his collegiate career vs. Sacramento State on Sept. 16
- Set the Stanford program record for receiving yards in a game (294), besting the mark from Troy Walters in 1999 in the double overtime victory at Colorado ... Second most single-game receiving yards in Pac-12 history (Marquise Lee, USC, 2012, 345) ... Most receiving yards by an FBS player since Ohio State's Jaxon Smith-Njigba in the 2022 Rose Bowl (347) ... His 13 receptions are tied for the second-most in Stanford history, trailing only Simi Fehoko (16) at UCLA in 2020 ... First player in the Pac-12 with multiple touchdown receptions of 60+ yards since Washington's John Ross III on November 5, 2016 (Oct. 16)
- Named the team's Irving S. Zeimer Award recipient, given to the team's offensive most valuable player
