### 2022 Junior:

- AP First Team Preseason All-American
- Named PFF Offensive Player of the Week after allowing no sacks and leading the rushing attack to 224 yards and two TDs against Nebraska (8/27)
- Named to PFF Week 3 Team of the Week for his performance against Southern Illinois (9/17)
- Named to PFF Week 12 Team of the Week for his performance at Purdue (11/19)
- Named to PFF Week 13 Team of the Week for his performance against Illinois (11/26)
- Finished the season with PFF's highest pass-blocking grade in the country at 93.0, (also one of highest of all time), allowed only six pressures on 480 pass-blocking snaps
- Best PFF single-season pass blocking grade recorded over last two years
- Finished with a 79.1 PFF run-blocking grade, ranking 5th among all qualifying Power 5 tackles
- Named Rimington-Pace Big Ten Offensive Lineman of the Year (first ever by an NU lineman)
- First Northwestern OL to earn two All-Big Ten first team awards and third Wildcat to do so under Pat Fitzgerald
- 2022 Unanimous First Team All-American (first ever by an NU player)
- Named to 2022 All-Big Ten First Team by coaches and media
- Finished as a finalist for the 2022 Outland Trophy, recognizing nation's best college interior lineman on both offense and defense

### 2021 Sophomore:

- All-Big Ten First Team (coaches) and All-Big Ten Second Team (media)
- Started all 12 games as a sophomore
- Paved the way for Evan Hull's 1,000-yard season on the ground

### 2020 First-Year:

- All-Big Ten Second Team ... First Northwestern first-year to do so since Paddy Fisher in 2017
- 247Sports True Freshman All-American

- Highest graded true first-year in the Big Ten among all positions
- Started every game for the Wildcats as a first-year
- Helped pave the way for 16 rushing touchdowns and a 162.8 rushing yards per game average
- Helped offensive line allow just 1.29 sacks per game in the Big Ten regular season, the third fewest in the conference and 21st in the nation.

- Four-star prospect committed to Northwestern on May 4, 2019
- No. 4 center nationally and No. 2 player in Illinois (247Sports) ... 0.9468 rating by 247Sports is the fourth highest by an NU signee in program history
- Three-year letter winner and 2019 team captain
- Recorded 173 pancakes in three seasons
- Earned All-State honors in 2018 and 2019
- Three-time All-Conference and All-Area selection
- Led Maine South to back-to-back-to-back CSL conference championships
- Was a member of the 2016 state champion team
- Also lettered three times in basketball and three times in track and field
- National Honor Society member
- Chose NU over offers from Duke, Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, Notre Dame, Penn State and Stanford.
