CAROLINA AT CHICAGO

• The Carolina Panthers open their 2019 preseason on the road against the Chicago Bears. It marks the fourth ever meeting between the two clubs during the preseason.

• Carolina is 4-6 all-time versus Chicago in the regular season, and 2-1 in the preseason. The clubs last met in Week 7 of the 2017 season (10/22/17), when the Bears defeated the Panthers 17-3.

• The Panthers look to bounce back after missing the playoffs last season with a 7-9 record, finishing third in the NFC South.

• The Bears clinched the NFC North title last season after going 12-4, but fell in the first round of the playoffs to Philadelphia.

CAROLINA-CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Pro Connections

• Carolina head coach **Ron Rivera** (1984-92) played for the Chicago Bears for all nine years of his playing career at linebacker. Rivera was a member of the historic 1985 Bears team led by Mike Ditka that would go on to win Super Bowl XX over the New England Patriots. Rivera returned to Chicago following his playing days, serving as defensive quality control coach (1997-98) and defensive coordinator (2004-06). As defensive coordinator, Rivera's defense helped Chicago punch a ticket to Super Bowl XLI against the Indianapolis Colts.

• Panthers TE **Greg Olsen** (2007-10), DE **Mario Addison** (2011) and WR **Rashad Ross** (2014) played for the Chicago Bears. While Olsen was in Chicago, he spent time with current Carolina defensive coordinator **Eric Washington**, who served in multiple roles in Chicago, including defensive assistant (2008-09) and defensive line coach (2010).

• Panthers tight ends coach **Pete Hoener** (2004) and secondary coach **Perry Fewell** (2005) served on the Chicago Bears staff as the offensive line and defensive backs coaches, respectively. It was during this time that they first overlapped with Ron Rivera, who was the Bears defensive coordinator.

• Carolina LB/DE **Bruce Irvin** (2012-15) played for the Seattle Seahawks with Chicago LB Kevin Pierre-Louis (2014-16) and TE Bradley Sowell (2016). Irvin (2016-19) also played in Oakland with Chicago DE Khalil Mack (2014-17) and WR Cordarelle Patterson (2017).

• Panthers DT **Dontari Poe** (2012-16) spent time with the Chiefs alongside Bears QBs Chase Daniel (2013-15) and Tyler Bray (2014, 17) and DT Nick Williams (2016). Panthers DT **Kyle Love** (2013) also overlapped with Daniel in Kansas City.

• Carolina DE/LB **Bruce Irvin** (2018), DT **Dontari Poe** (2017) and WR **Aldrick Robinson** (2016) and Chicago WRs Taylor Gabriel (2016-17) and Marvin Hall (2017-18) all played for the Atlanta Falcons.

• Panthers DT **Gerald McCoy** (2010-18) played with Bears OL Ted Larsen (2010-13) for the first four years of their careers with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers.

• Carolina C Matt Paradis (2014-18) and CB Lorenzo Doss (2012-15) played for the Denver Broncos with Chicago LB Danny Trevathan (2012-15).

• Panthers WR **Jarius Wright** (2012-17) and Bears WR Cordarelle Patterson (2013-16) played together for the Minnesota Vikings. Patterson (2018) also played with Panthers WR Chris Hogan (2016-18) for a season in New England, a season that concluded with a victory in Super Bowl LIII in Atlanta.

• Carolina DE **Mario Addison** (2011, 2012) played for the Indianapolis Colts with Chicago TE Bradley Sowell (2012) for one season.

• Carolina Wide Receivers Coach **Jim Hostler** (2015-17) served multiple roles on the offensive staff for then-Indianapolis head coach Chuck Pagano (2012-17). Pagano is about to begin to first season as defensive coordinator in Chicago. Hostler (2008-13) and Panthers run game coordinator **John Matsko** (2008-11) served on the Baltimore Ravens staff alongside Pagano (2008-11), who had a number of roles with the Ravens culminating in a season as defensive coordinator (2011).

• Panthers LB **Antwione Williams** (2016) played his rookie season for the Detroit Lions alongside Bears OL Cornelius Lucas III (2014-16), who was in his third and final season on the Lions roster.

• Carolina DT **Destiny Vaeao** (2016-18) and G **Dillon Gordon** (2016) played with Chicago TE Trey Burton (2014-17) and QB Chase Daniel (2016) for the Philadelphia Eagles. Panthers WR **Torrey Smith** (2017) also played alongside Vaeao (2016-18) and Burton (2014-17) for the Eagles the year they won Super Bowl LII in Minnesota.

• Bears head coach Matt Nagy served as the quarterbacks coach (2013-15) and offensive coordinator (2016-17) in Kansas City while Panthers DTs **Dontari Poe** (2012-16) and **Kyle Love** (2013) played on the defensive line for the Chiefs. Bears inside linebackers coach Mark Deleone (2013-17) also served on the Kansas City staff at that time, first as defensive quality control coach and then as linebackers coach.

College Connections

• Carolina runnings back coach **Jake Peetz** (2013) was an offensive assistant on Nick Saban's Alabama staff while Panthers WR **DeAndrew White** (2011-14) and Bears S **Eddie Jackson** (2013-16) played in Tuscaloosa.

• Panthers S Eric Reid (2010-13), G Dillon Gordon (2012-15), G Trai Turner (2013) and CB Donte Jackson (2015-17) all played as LSU, as did Bears DB Kevin Toliver II (2015-17).

• Carolina S **Cole Luke** and Chicago rookie OL **Alex Bars** and **Sam Mustipher** played together for head coach Brian Kelly and the Notre Dame Fighting Irish.

• Panthers P Michael Palardy (2010-13) and Bears QB Tyler Bray (2010-12) spent three seasons together as part of the Tennessee Volunteers football program. Bears WR Cordar-relle Patterson (2012) also spent a season with Palardy and Bray at Tennessee.

• Four players in Thursday's game, Panthers G **Greg Van Roten** and Bears DL Daryle Banfield, TE Ben Braunecker and TE Jesper Horsted attended lvy League Schools before joining the NFL ranks. Van Roten played Penn, while Banfield, Braunecker and Horsted played at Brown, Harvard and Princeton, respectively.

• Panthers G **Parker Collins** (2013-16) overlapped for one year at Appalachian State with Bears DB and Charlotte-area native Clifton Duck (2016-18).

• Carolina All-Pro LB Luke Kuechly (2009-11) played for two seasons at Boston College on the same linebacker unit with Chicago LB Kevin Pierre-Louis (2010-13).

• Panthers DE **Bryan Cox Jr.** and rookie RB **Jordan Scarlett** played for the Florida Gators with Bears K Eddie Pineiro and DE Jonathan Bullard. Bears TE Trey Burton also played with Cox Jr. at Florida.

Area Connections

• Bears QB Mitchell Trubisky and DL Jalen Dalton played their college football at North Carolina and RB Mike Davis and K Elliott Fry played at South Carolina. Dalton played his high school football in-state at West Forsyth High School in Clemmons, NC.

• Bears RB Tarik Cohen played college football at North Carolina A&T where he majored in sports medicine. Cohen hails from the state, as well. He grew up in Bunn, NC, and played high school football and was a state champion in track and Bunn High School.

• Panthers defensive coordinator **Eric Washington** spent four seasons (2004-07) as the defensive line coach at Northwestern.

• Panthers TE Jason Vander Laan grew up just outside of Chicago in Frankfort, III. He played his high school football at Chicago Christian, where he played QB at the time.

• Chicago LB Jonathan Bullard is a native of Shelby, NC and played at Crest High School in the Shelby area.

• Carolina LS JJ. Jansen, S Cole Luke and Chicago OL Alex Bars and OL Sam Mustipher all played at Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, about 100 miles from Chicago.

• Bears DB Clifton Duck is from Mathews, NC, just south of Charlotte and played his college football in his home state at Appalachian State. While growing up in Mathews, Duck attended and played at David W. Butler High School in Mathews, located just 13 miles from Bank of America Stadium.

• Chicago WR Cordarrelle Patterson played high school football at Northwestern High School in Rock Hill, SC, about 30 miles south of Charlotte.

• Bears defensive coordinator Chuck Pagano has spent time coaching in the Carolinas. He spent three seasons (1992-94) as the defensive backs coach and linebackers coach at East Carolina University, and the 2007 season as the defensive coordinator at the University of North Carolina.

THE HEAD COACHES



Ron RIVERA

Ron Rivera became the fourth coach in Carolina Panthers history on January 11, 2011. In eight seasons, Rivera has guided the team to a Super Bowl appearance, an NFC Championship and three NFC South titles. He is a two-time (2013 and 2015) Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award winner.

Rivera inherited a 2-14 Carolina team as a rookie head coach in 2011 and guided it back to relevance with four playoffs appearances since 2013, the second-most playoff berths in the NFC over that six-year period. In that span, the Panthers recorded 58 wins, tied for the most in any six-year period in franchise history, and fifth-most in the NFL.

In 2015, Rivera led the Panthers to the second Super Bowl appearance in team history following a franchise-best 15-1 record and their third consecutive NFC South championship. In the process, Carolina became the fourth team in the Super Bowl era to start a season 14-0, joining the 1972 Miami Dolphins, 2007 New England Patriots and 2009 Indianapolis Colts.

Carolina's 18-game regular season winning streak was the longest in NFC history. In 2014, the Panthers became the first team since 1970 to overcome a six-game losing streak and win their division. In 2013, Rivera directed Carolina to 12 wins, the NFC South title and its first playoff appearance since 2008. Before joining the Panthers, Rivera coached the San Diego Chargers (2007-2010), Chicago Bears (2004-06, 1997-98) and Philadelphia Eagles (1999- 2003). In 2006, the Bears defense led the NFL with 44 takeaways, helping propel Chicago to an appearance in Super Bowl XLI. He is just the third Latino head coach in NFL history, joining Tom Flores with the Oakland Raiders (1979-1987) and Seattle Seahawks (1992- 94) and Tom Fears with the New Orleans Saints (1967-1970). A second-round draft choice in 1984 by Chicago, Rivera played nine seasons with the Bears. Primarily an outside linebacker, he was a member of the 1985 Super Bowl XX winning team.

Rivera played linebacker at California (1980-83), where he finished as the school's all-time leader in sacks (22) and tackles (336).

Born January 7, 1962 in Fort Ord, Calif. He and his wife, Stephanie, have two children—Christopher and Courtney.

Matt Nagy was named the sixteenth head coach in Chicago Bears history on January 8, 2018. In his inaugural season, Nagy guided the Bears to their first playoff appearance since 2010.

Nagy joined the Bears with 10 seasons of coaching experience in the NFL with the Kansas City Chiefs (2013-17) and Philadelphia Eagles (2008-2012). Promoted to offensive coordinator in 2017 after spending 2016 as a co-offensive coordinator with Brad Childress. Chiefs' quarterbacks coach (2013-15).

In Philadelphia, Nagy served as Eagles' offensive quality control coach (2011-12) and was a coaching assistant (2010). Started as a coaching intern with Eagles (2008-09).

Nagy played quarterback collegiately at Delaware (1997-2000). Played six seasons in the AFL for the New York Dragons (2002), Carolina Cobras (2004), Georgia Force (2005-06) and Columbus Destroyers (2007-08).


Nagy began coaching career at the high school level, as an assistant coach at Manheim Central (2001), quarterbacks coach at Cedar Crest (2002-03) and offensive coordinator at Palmyra Area H.S. (2008-09).

Nagy was born April 24, 1978 in Plainfield, N.J. He and his wife, Stacey, have four sons: Brayden, Tate, Jaxon and Jett.

ROUND 1 • 16TH PICK (16TH OVERALL)

The Panthers' 2019 first round selection finished his collegiate career **ranked fifth in school history** with **24.D** sacks. In his final season at Florida State, Burns was named to Phil Steele's All-America team, All-ACC First Team and Bednarik Award semifinalist

ROUND 2 • 5TH PICK (37TH OVERALL)

Little was a three-year player at Ole Miss with 29 career starts at left tackle, including all 24 in his sophomore (2017) and junior seasons (2018). According to Pro Football Focus, Little allowed just **26 total pressures** and three sacks in **993 pass-blocking snaps** over his final two seasons

ROUND 3 • 37TH PICK (100TH OVERALL)

Though he only played two seasons at West Virginia, Grier finished career with **71** touchdown passes and **7,354** career passing yards with the Mountaineers, ranking second and third in both categories in program history. He finished the 2018 season as the NCAA active leader in passing yards per game (305.6) and ranked fifth in the NCAA in career pass efficiency (165.1).

ROUND 4 • 13TH PICK (115TH OVERALL)

Carolina selected Miller in the fourth round after he played four years at Alabama. In his final season with the Crimson Tide, he tallied 36 tackles, including **11.5** for loss, **8.5** sacks and a team-high 12 quarterback hurries.

ROUND 5 • 16TH PICK (154TH OVERALL)

Scarlett played three years with Florida prior to being the Panthers' fifth round draft selection. In his three years with the Gators, he racked up **1,846** yards and **12** touchdowns.

ROUND 6 • 40TH PICK (212TH OVERALL)

Daley played two seasons at South Carolina after transferring from Georgia Military College. He started **23** of the last **24** games with the Gamebooks. Daley played left tackle in 2018 and the second half of 2017 after beginning season at guard.

ROUND 7 • 23 RD PICK (237 TH OVERALL)

A four-year receiver at Georgia, Godwin finished his career with **1,800** receiving yards and 11 receiving touchdowns on **134** receptions. In his final collegiate season in 2018, he recorded 23 receptions for 385 yards and three touchdowns

2019 KEY FREE AGENT ACQUISITIONS

CHRIS HOGAN // WR #15

Hogan joined the Panthers in 2019 after three years in New England, where he played in three Super Bowls, winning two championships - LI and LIII. In those three games, he tallied 10 receptions for 185 yards and one touchdown.

Over the last three seasons, Hogan ranks second among all NFL wide receivers in postseason receiving yards with 542 yards on 34 catches.



GERALD MCCOY // DT #93

McCoy spent the first nine years of his career with Tampa Bay. He is the **only defensive tackle in the NFL** to tally at least six sacks every year since 2013.

Since entering the NFL in 2010, he ranks fourth among all defensive tackles with 54.5 sacks.

BRUCE IRVIN // LB/DE #55

Irvin comes to Carolina with **43.5 career sacks**, 15 forced fumbles and three interceptions. He's racked up at least 5.5 sacks in **each of the last five** seasons.

Irvin played with two teams in 2018, the Raiders and Falcons, playing eight games with each club. He recorded 3.0 sacks with Oakland and another 3.5 sacks with Atlanta.



MATT PARADIS // C #61

After spending five years with the Broncos, Paradis joined the Panthers in the 2019 offseason.

According to Pro Football Focus last season, Paradis **ranked second among all NFL centers** in his offensive grade as he allowed just one sack and three hurries on 569 snaps.



MILESTONES IN REACH IN 2019



Carolina needs 10 wins to reach 200 regular season wins in franchise history. Dating back to the Panthers' first season in 1995, the team has an overall record of 190-193-1 during the regular season.



Ron Rivera needs three wins in the regular season to pass John Fox (73 wins; 2002-10) as the winningest coach in franchise history. Rivera's career record is 71-56-1 (.559) in the regular season.





Cam Newton needs 121 rushing yards to pass Randall Cunningham (4,928) for the second-most rushing yards by a quarterback in league history. Cam Newton has totaled 4,808 rushing yards in his career. Newton can also become the first quarterback to ever rush for 700+ yards in four seasons.



Christian McCaffrey needs 292 yards from scrimmage to break the franchise record for scrimmage yards by any Panther through his first three seasons. His 3,051 yards only trail DeAngelo Williams (3,342 yards; 2006-08).



Greg Olsen can move into sixth place all-time in touchdowns by a tight end in NFL history by scoring six times. Olsen currently has 57 touchdowns, trailing Vernon Davis and Shannon Sharpe, who are tied for sixth with 62 touchdown catches.





According to press box stats, **Luke Kuechly** (948) needs 52 tackles in 2019 to hit 1,000 career tackles. He also needs just 19 tackles to pass Brian Urlacher (966) for the most through a player's first eight seasons in NFL history.



Mario Addison (45.5 sacks) needs 10 sacks in 2019 to tie Mike Rucker (55.5 sacks) for the third-most sacks in franchise history.



J.J. Jansen has played in 160 career games with Carolina, the fifth most by any Panther player. He can tie Thomas Davis (176; 2005-18) for the third-most games played in franchise history by playing in 16 games this season.



TEAM NOTES // OFFENSE

A RUNNING HISTORY

Carolina has boasted a top-10 rushing offense in seven of the last eight seasons, including ranking fourth in 2018. Under **Ron Rivera**, the Panthers have gone 64-36-1 when rushing for over 100 yards in a game in the regular season.

In 2018, the Panthers first- and second-year players totaled 3,875 total scrimmage yards and 27 of Carolina's 46 total touchdowns.

Led by the Cat Pack - **Christian McCaffrey, DJ Moore** and **Curtis Samuel** - Carolina ranked second in the NFL in scrimmage yards and second in offensive touchdowns by first- and second-year players.



MOORE LIFE

Wide receiver DJ Moore had a standout rookie season in 2018. He posted the **most scrimmage yards** (960) and secondmost receiving yards (788) by **any rookie wide receiver** in the NFL. He also had the second-most scrimmage yards by a rookie wide receiver in franchise history (Kelvin Benjamin, 1,008 - 2014).

Moore led all wide receivers on the team with 55 receptions and 788 receiving yards, averaging 14.3 yards per catch. He also averaged 7.7 yards after the catch, which **topped the league** among qualifying receivers.

A dual threat, Moore also racked up 172 yards on the ground, the second most among all NFL wide receivers.



SUPER MARIO

Addison started as an undrafted free agent out of Troy, signing with the Chicago Bears in 2011 and landing on the Panthers in 2012.

He has 45.5 career sacks which ranks **third in the NFL** among active players that were undrafted free agents. Addison now ranks **fourth in franchise history** in sacks.

ACTION JACKSON

Jackson finished his rookie campaign tied for seventh in the NFL with four interceptions. This marked the **second most interceptions** by a rookie in team history, only trailing Chris Gamble's six picks in 2004.



On Monday Night Football in Week 15 last season vs New Orleans, Jackson picked off a pass on a two-point conversion attempt and returned it the length of the field for two points, giving Carolina its first ever two-point defensive return.

SHORT STANDS TALL

Since the start of 2015, Kawann Short has 27.5 sacks, tied for **third in the NFL** by a defensive tackle over the past four seasons. 
